## National Title Boosts Florida in Final Winter Division I #LSDC Standings; @bigtenconf with Five Institutions in the Top 10

**CLEVELAND** – **Stanford** maintains its lead in the final winter standings for the Division I Learfield Sports Directors' Cup. The Cardinal finished seventh in women's gymnastics and end the winter with 1,151 total points.

**Penn State** remains in second place with 924.25 points after placing seventh in women's gymnastics. **Florida** moves into third place with 727 points. The Gators won a split national championship in women's gymnastics. With 718.25 points, in fourth place, is **Michigan**. The Wolverines finished seventh in women's gymnastics. Rounding out the top five is **Wisconsin** with 705 total points.

The **Big Ten** finishes the winter outpacing the other Division I conferences with five institutions ranked in the top 10. Penn State is second, Michigan is third, Wisconsin is fourth, Minnesota is seventh and Nebraska is ninth.

Fifteen winter Division I championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: *women's gymnastics* – **Florida & Oklahoma**; *men's gymnastics* – **Michigan**; *men's ice hockey* – **Union (NY)** (DIII); *women's bowling* – **Sam Houston State**; *women's basketball* – **Connecticut**; *men's basketball* – **Connecticut**; *fencing* – **Penn State**; *women's ice hockey* – **Clarkson** (DIII); *women's swimming & diving* – **Georgia**; *men's swimming & diving* – **California**; *rifle* – **West Virginia**; *skiing* – **Denver**; *women's indoor track & field* – **Oregon**; *men's indoor track & field* – **Oregon**; *wrestling* – **Penn State**.

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 20 sports -- ten women's and ten men's.

The first Division I spring standings will be released Thursday, May 29.
