Stanford Takes Lead in Second Fall Division I U.S. Sports Academy Directors' Cup Standings

Cleveland, Ohio – With five NCAA championships completed, 13-time U.S. Sports Academy Directors' Cup champion **Stanford** has taken the lead in the second set of Division I fall standings. The Cardinal, who were second in the first standings, now lead all institutions with 225 total points after placing ninth in women's soccer.

Overall, Stanford has captured the women's cross country title, was ninth in women's field hockey and 19th overall in men's cross country.

Florida State trails Stanford by 16 points, with 209. The Seminoles jumped four spots after finishing second in women's soccer. FSU has also scored in women's cross country (3rd) and men's cross country (20th).

In third, with 192 points, is California. The Bears, who were 39th, broke into the top-three after placing first in the national collegiate sport of men's water polo and 17th in women's soccer. Previously, California had tallied 42 points in men's cross country.

After leading the first set of standings, Oregon dropped to fourth place with 190 points. The Ducks captured the men's cross country title and finished second in women's cross country.

Rounding out the top-five is North Carolina with 184 points. The Tar Heels placed ninth in the most recent NCAA championship, women's soccer. North Carolina has also captured the women's field hockey title and were 27th in women's cross country.

To date, five of the nine fall NCAA championships have been completed with Southern California and California capturing the most recent championships, women's soccer and the national collegiate sport of men's water polo, respectively. The following institutions have also captured titles: women's cross country (Stanford), men's cross country (Oregon) and women's field hockey (North Carolina).

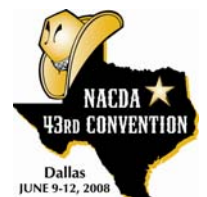
The next Division I standings will be released Thursday, December 20th and will include Football Championship Subdivision football, women's volleyball and men's soccer, while the final fall release will be published on January 10, 2008, which will include the Football Bowl Subdivision Football standings.

The Sports Academy Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. The United States Sports Academy, based in Daphne, Alabama, is the program's sponsor. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 20 sports – 10 women's and 10 men's.
