## Azusa Pacific Remains in First in the Final Fall NAIA Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings

**Cleveland, Ohio** – Azusa Pacific (Calif.) remains atop the final fall NAIA Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings with 324 points. The Cougars have recorded four top-10 finishes, including a national championship in women's cross country. The Cougars also finished second in men's cross country, fifth in women's soccer and ninth in women's volleyball.

Concordia (Ore.) remains in second with 238 total points in the final fall standings. The Cavaliers finished second in women's soccer, ninth in both men's soccer and men's cross country and 21<sup>st</sup> in women's cross country.

Lindenwood jumped from 20<sup>th</sup> to third after recording 83 points for its third place showing in football to increase its total to 204 points. The Lions also finished 13<sup>th</sup> in women's volleyball, 17<sup>th</sup> in men's cross country and 22<sup>nd</sup> in women's cross country.

Indiana Institute of Technology dropped to fourth place with 195 points. The Warriors tallied 75 points in men's cross country, 69 points in women's cross country and 51 points in women's volleyball.

Cal State San Marcos holds onto fifth place with a total of 192 points, scoring 85 points in women's cross country, 54 points in men's cross country and 53 points in women's soccer.

All six fall NAIA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: Azusa Pacific (Calif.) (women's cross country); Malone (Ohio) (men's cross country); Lee (Tenn.) (women's soccer); Bethel (Tenn.) (men's soccer); Fresno Pacific (Calif.) (women's volleyball); and Sioux Falls (S.D.) (football).

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 12 sports – six women's and six men's.

The first winter NAIA standings will be released Thursday, March 12, 2009.
