Top Two Spots Remain the Same in the Second Fall NAIA U.S. Sports Academy Directors' Cup Standings

Cleveland, Ohio – Azusa Pacific (CA) and Simon Fraser (B.C.) remain in first and second, respectively, in the second fall NAIA U.S. Sports Academy Director's Cup Standings.

Azusa Pacific has recorded four top-20 finishes, including a national championship in men's soccer for a total of 333.5 points. The Cougars finished second in women's soccer, sixth in women's cross country and 14th in men's cross country. Azusa Pacific tallied 25 points in the most recent NAIA championship, volleyball.

Simon Fraser continues its hold on second place with 300.5 points, after winning the women's cross country title. The Clan was also third in men's soccer, fourth in men's cross country and 21st overall in women's soccer.

With its 83 points scored in volleyball with its third place finish in the championship, Concordia (CA) took over the third place spot in the standings. The Eagles also finished second in men's soccer, 11th in men's cross country, 18th in women's cross country and 57th in women's soccer.

Embry Riddle Aeronautical (FL) and Malone (OH) are currently fourth and fifth in the overall standings, respectively.

The Eagles of Embry Riddle placed 31st in women's volleyball to increase their point total to 251.5 points. Prior to the volleyball championship, the Eagles finished fifth in men's soccer, seventh in men's cross country, 17th in women's soccer and 26th overall in women's cross country.

The Pioneers of Malone tallied 50 point in the most recent NAIA championship, volleyball, and moved from sixth to fifth with 230 total points. Malone also captured the men's cross country title and finished fourth in women's cross country.

In the most recent NAIA championship, women's volleyball, Fresno Pacific took home the title. To date, five of the six fall NAIA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: women's cross country (Simon Fraser), men's cross country (Malone), women's soccer (Martin Methodist), men's soccer (Azusa Pacific).

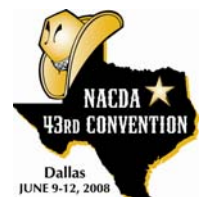
The final NAIA standings will be released Thursday, December 20 and will include the football championship.

The Sports Academy Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. The United States Sports Academy, based in Daphne, Alabama, is the program sponsor. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 12 sports – six women's and six men's.
