## GVSU Leads Division II Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings with a Winter-High 330.50 Points

**CLEVELAND** – In the final set of winter standings, **Grand Valley State (Mich.)** remains atop the overall Learfield Sports Directors' Cup standings with 710.50 points.

The Lakers of Grand Valley State tallied a winter-high of 330.50 points, after placing second in women's track and field, fourth in men's swimming, eighth in women's swimming, 17<sup>th</sup> in men's basketball and 29<sup>th</sup> in men's track and field.

**Adams State (Colo.)**, remains in second with 463 points after recently placing 33<sup>rd</sup> in women's basketball. The Grizzlies also captured the men's track and field title, finished fifth in women's track and field and 13<sup>th</sup> in wrestling for a total of 263 winter points.

In third place with 418 points, including 210 points this winter is **Colorado School of Mines**. The Orediggers finished 33<sup>rd</sup> in both men's and women's basketball, as well as recording points in men's and women's swimming and men's and women's track and field.

**Minnesota State Mankato** debuts in the top-five with 394.50 total points. The Mavericks recorded 319.50 winter points by finishing sixth in wrestling, eighth in men's track and field, 17<sup>th</sup> in men's basketball, 18<sup>th</sup> in women's track and field and 26<sup>th</sup> in both men's and women's swimming.

**Shippensburg (Pa.)** drops to fifth with 386.25 total points, including 182.25 this winter. The Raiders recorded finishes in men's and women's track and field, women's swimming and wrestling.

The seven winter Division II championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: Emporia State (Ka.) (women's basketball), Cal Poly Pomona (men's basketball), Adams State (men's track and field), Lincoln (Mo.) (women's track and field), Drury (Mo.) (men's and women's swimming) and Nebraska Omaha (wrestling). Minnesota Duluth captured the National Collegiate (NC) women's ice hockey title, and Alaska Fairbanks and Alaska Anchorage had the highest finishes for Division II institution in the NC sports of rifle (second) and skiing (seventh), respectively.

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.

The first Division II spring standings will be released Thursday, May 27, 2010.
