**Grand Valley State (Mich.) Secures Top Spot in the
 Final Division II Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings;
 GLIAC Places Two Institutions in the Top 10**

CLEVELAND – Grand Valley State (Mich.) secured its eighth straight Learfield Sports Directors' Cup, finishing with a total of 1057.50 points after winning the women's outdoor track & field national championship. The Lakers also turned in finishes of seventh in baseball, ninth in softball and 16th in men's outdoor track & field.

Central Missouri finished in the runner-up spot, its highest-ever finish in Directors' Cup history, with 779.75 total points. The Mules finished sixth in women's outdoor track & field, seventh in baseball and eighth in men's outdoor track & field.

Augustana (S.D.) finished in third place with 761.50 points after earning additional points through finishes of ninth in softball, 10th in women's outdoor track & field, 12th in men's outdoor track & field and 37th in baseball.

In fourth place with 718.00 points is **Abilene Christian (Tex.)**. The Wildcats took home the men's outdoor track & field national crown, while also finishing 29th in women's outdoor track & field.

Rounding out the top five is **UC San Diego** by a mere half point over **Adams State**. The Tritons took home the softball national championship, finished fifth in women's outdoor track and field, seventh in women's water polo, ninth in men's tennis, 28th in men's outdoor track and field and 50th in baseball.

The **Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC)** closes out the year with two of its member institutions in the top 10. GLIAC institutions in the top 10 include first place Grand Valley State (Mich.) and ninth place Ashland (Ohio).

All 11 spring NCAA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: baseball – West Florida; women's golf – Nova Southeastern (Fla.); men's golf – Cal State Monterey Bay; women's lacrosse – Adelphi (N.Y.); men's lacrosse – Mercyhurst (Pa.); women's rowing – Western Washington; softball – UC San Diego; women's tennis – Barry (Fla.); men's tennis – Valdosta State (Ga.); women's outdoor track & field – Grand Valley State (Mich.); men's outdoor track & field – Abilene Christian (Tex.).

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.
