Virginia Maintains Lead of Division I Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings

Cleveland, Ohio – With six NCAA championships completed, Virginia maintains the lead in the second set of Division I fall standings. The Cavaliers lead with 337 points after capturing the men's soccer title and placing ninth in women's soccer.

North Carolina jumped from 11th to second place, with a total of 283 points. In the most recent NCAA Championships, the Tar Heels won the women's soccer title and placed third in men's soccer. In the previous standings, North Carolina captured the women's field hockey title.

Stanford moved into third place after finishing sixth in the previous standings. The Cardinal finished second in women's soccer and ninth in men's soccer scoring 154 points in the most recent championships bringing their total to 281. Stanford also finished ninth in women's field hockey, 10th in men's cross country and 16th in women's cross country.

Rounding out the top-five are Princeton and Maryland. The Tigers placed third in men's water polo and 33rd in men's soccer bringing their total up from 158 points to 230.50. With 227 points, Maryland entered into the top five from 15th place. The Terps scored 137 points by finishing fifth in the men's soccer and ninth in women's soccer. Maryland previously scored 90 points after finishing second in women's field hockey.

Six of the eight fall NCAA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: Villanova (Pa.) (women's cross country); Oklahoma State (men's cross country); North Carolina (women's field hockey); North Carolina (women's soccer); Virginia (men's soccer); and Southern California (men's water polo).

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.

The final Division I fall standings will be released Wednesday, December 23.

Please note, standings published midseason are unofficial. Official standings will be published upon the completion of the spring season. Complete standings and the scoring structure can be found on NACDA's Web site at www.nacda.com.
