Simon Fraser (B.C.) Leads the Second Fall NAIA Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings

CLEVELAND – Simon Fraser (B.C.) takes the lead in the second fall NAIA Learfield Sports Directors' Cup Standings. In the most recent championships, the Clan finished third in men's soccer and 17th in women's soccer. Simon Fraser also finished fourth in women's cross country and sixth in men's cross country bringing their total to 260 points.

Azusa Pacific (Calif.) breaks into the top five with 231 points after finishing third in the women's soccer and fifth in the women's volleyball tournaments. The Cougars also finished fifth in women's cross country in the previous standings.

Biola is in third place after tallying 129.33 points with a fifth place finish in men's soccer and a 13th place finish in women's volleyball. The Eagles previously placed second in women's cross country, giving them a grand total of 219.33 points.

Embry Riddle Aeronautical is in fourth place with a total of 212 points, scoring 70 points with a fifth place finish in men's soccer and 25 points with a 17th place finish in women's soccer. Previously, the Eagles finished fifth in men's cross country and 16th in women's cross country.

Lee (Tenn.) enters into the Learfield Sports Directors' Cup rankings in fifth place. The Flames scored 208 points after capturing the women's soccer title, finishing third in women's volleyball and 17th in men's soccer.

Five of the six fall NAIA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: Cal State San Marcos (women's cross country); Malone (Ohio) (men's cross country); Lee (Tenn.) (women's soccer); Lindsey Wilson (Ky.) (men's soccer); and Fresno Pacific (Calif.) (women's volleyball).

The Learfield Sports Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.

The final fall NAIA standings will be released Wednesday, December 23.
