## WALK-ON REMINDER

The Compliance Office needs to be aware of all walk-on candidates and clear them prior to any type of tryout taking place.

You must submit a Change of Status Form within seven (7) days of the tryout if you desire to keep this prospective student-athlete.

## Student-Athlete Employment Reminder

It is the coaches responsibility to know if their student-athletes are employed and where they are employed. The Compliance Office cannot rely solely on the student-athletes to inform us of their employment status. If student-athletes are currently working anywhere they must submit the appropriate paperwork to the Compliance Office. If coaches or student-athletes have any questions regarding employment feel free to contact the Compliance Office.

### NCAA Bylaw 15.2.7 Employment

Earnings from a student-athlete's employment that occurs at any time is exempt and not counted in determining a student-athlete's cost of attendance or the institutions financial aid limitations, provided:

1. The student-athlete's compensation does not include any remuneration for the value or utility that the student-athlete may have for the employer because of the publicity, reputation, fame, or personal following that he or she obtained because of athletics ability.
2. The student-athlete is compensated for work actually performed; and
3. The student-athlete is compensated at a rate commensurate with the going rate in that locality for similar services.
