Prospective Student-Athlete: A prospective student-athlete is a prospect even after he or she signs a National Letter of Intent. The prospect is also governed by NCAA recruiting rules and regulations until the student-athlete reports for practice, and/or enrolls for classes at Florida State University or any other college or university.

NCAA Bylaw 13.02.9: An individual remains a prospective student-athlete until one of the following occurs (whichever is earliest):

- a. The individual officially registers and enrolls in a minimum full-time program of studies and attends classes in any term of a four-year collegiate institution's regular academic year (excluding summer); or
- b. The individual participates in a regular squad practice or competition at a four-year collegiate institution that occurs before the beginning of any term.
