## PROSPECT COMBINES

Recently, the NCAA staff confirmed the following regarding hosting, sponsoring, conducting or evaluating portions of events that include activities devoted to agility, flexibility, speed or strength tests for prospective student-athletes:

- a. Only in football, it is not permissible for coaches to attend **any portion** of a scholastic or nonscholastic event that includes activities devoted to agility, flexibility, speed or strength tests for prospective student-athletes regardless of whether or not the coach observes the portion of the event devoted to such activities.
- b. A member institution or conference may not host, sponsor or conduct any portion of an event that also includes agility, flexibility, speed or strength tests for prospective student-athletes conducted at a separate location in any sport. For example, an institution is not permitted to host the competition portion of an event that also includes flexibility, speed or strength tests for prospective student-athletes that take place at an off-campus location.

## CAMPUS VISITS AND POWER PARK

With Marshall playing its Conference USA games at Charleston Power Park it can be utilized for recruiting purposes. This list is NOT all-inclusive so please talk to Compliance if you plan on using Power Park for visits.

Permissible:

- \* Providing transportation to view practice/competition sites off-campus for both official and unofficial visits.
- \* Providing complimentary admissions to prospects to attend baseball games.
- \* Interacting with the prospect who is using the complimentary admission will NOT constitute an off-campus contact, provided no contact takes place away from the facility.

Impermissible:

- \* Cannot give transportation to a prospect to attend a competition.
- \* Cannot provide any other entertainment or any other expenses besides the tickets.
- \* Cannot reserve additional tickets for an **unofficial visit**. Additional tickets must be purchased in the same manner as the general public.
- \* No personalized recruiting aids can be used.
