Peter Tymus has been associated with Long Island University (LIU) since September 2002. During his time with LIU, he has been involved with projects on the University's Campuses in Brooklyn, Brookville, Purchase and Southampton, New York. Currently ranking as the Nation's eighth largest private university, LIU is the academic home to approximately 30,000 students.

Among the projects Peter has had involvement with for Long Island University are the Brooklyn Campus Wellness, Recreation and Athletic Center, Kumble Theater for the Performing Arts, Main Campus Plaza Restoration and Rehabilitation, Barnes and Noble Campus Bookstore and Cyber Café. At the CW Post Campus in Brookville, NY projects include the expansion and renovation of the Tilles Center for the Performing Arts, Conversion of the former Conolly Hall Gymnasium building to the state of the art Kahn Discovery Center Academic Building as well as the restoration and rehabilitation of the 80 year old former Marjorie Meriwether Post mansion, now campus Administration building and MBA Classroom Center at the Palmer Library Building. At the former Southampton Campus, Peter was involved with the 'Green' construction of the Library Learning Center and the concept redesign of the Marine Science Center. At the University Center campus, Peter has been involved with many reconfiguration and relocation projects involving officers and staff from year to year.

Peter is also presently an Adjunct Professor at New York Institute of Technology, School of Architecture and Design. In this role since 2004; courses taught include Construction Management, Computer Assisted Construction Management, Building Construction and Construction Contracts.

Prior to joining Long Island University, Peter spent twenty two and one half years at Turner Construction Company, headquartered in New York. After joining Turner at an entry level position, Peter eventually became the General Manager of the New York Academic Facilities division, responsible for Academic sector work throughout New York State.

In addition to the education sector experience with Turner, past project experience includes work for the American Bible Society; Bank of America; Bank of Credit and Commerce International; Chase Bank (now JP Morgan Chase); Coopers and Lybrand; Deloitte and Touché; Dewey, Ballantine, Bushby, Palmer and Wood; the European Common Market; General American Investors; the International Center for the Disabled; the Jewish Home and Hospital for Aged; Lord and Taylor; Mercedes Benz Corporation; Nabisco Corporation; NYNEX; the Research Foundation for the City University of New

York; Symbol Technologies (now Motorola); Westbury Hotel and Winthrop Financial Corporation.

Peter attended Stevens Institute of Technology and Brooklyn Technical High School. He currently resides with his family on Long Island, NY.
