Adams State (Colo.) Lead the First Fall Division II U.S. Sports Academy Directors' Cup Standings

Cleveland, Ohio – Adams State (Colo.) leads the first set of U.S. Sports Academy Directors' Cup fall standings. The Grizzlies have accumulated 187.5 total points after a first place finish in women's cross country and a tie for second place in men's cross country.

UMASS Lowell is trailing the Grizzlies by 12 points (173 total points), after finishing second in women's field hockey, 13th in men's cross country and 21st in women's cross country.

Abilene Christian (Tex.) is in third with 169 points after capturing the men's cross country national championship and finishing seventh in women's cross country.

Defending champion Grand Valley State (Mich.) is fourth overall, finishing third and fourth overall in women's and men's cross country, respectively. The Lakers have 165 points.

Western State (Colo.) rounds out the top-five with 159.5 points. The Mountaineers tied second in men's cross country and sixth overall in women's cross country.

Four of the seven fall NCAA championships have been completed with the following institutions capturing titles: women's cross country (Adams State), men's cross country (Abilene Christian) and women's field hockey (Bloomsburg, Pa.).

The Sports Academy Directors' Cup was developed as a joint effort between the National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) and *USA Today*. The United States Sports Academy, based in Daphne, Alabama, is the program sponsor. Points are awarded based on each institution's finish in up to 14 sports -- seven women's and seven men's.

The next Division II standings will be released Thursday, December 6.
