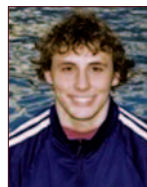

NJCAA RESULTS

The 2009-10 academic year began with some incredible performances by NJCAA student-athletes. Gillette College (Wyo.) sophomore Kipkorir Mutai was the overall individual champion in the men's half marathon, finishing the 13.1 mile course in a championship record time of 1:07:49.8. The All-American broke the previous record of 1:08:21, set in 2007 by Stephan Dak of Iowa Central.

On the women's side, the Tyler Junior College (Texas) (TJC) women's soccer team won the 2009 Division I Soccer Championship by a 3-0 margin. After just launching their program in 2008, these student-athletes and coaches molded a team in one year that took home the first women's soccer title in TJC history. As tournament hosts, it was icing on the cake to win it in front of a friendly crowd on their home field. The Lady Apaches finished their second season with a 10-0-1 record. Adding to the celebrations on campus, the TJC men's program captured the Division I Soccer Championship in New Jersey.
