### CCC Player of the Week

**Nathan Menefee of Evergreen**, a 5-10 sophomore guard from Lacey, Wash., was named CCC Player of the Week for Dec. 3-9. In helping Evergreen to road wins at Lewis-Clark State and Whitman College, Menefee totaled 60 points, eight assists and six steals as the Geoducks improved to 6-1. He had 32 points vs. L-C State and followed with 28 vs. Whitman. In the two games, Menefee shot 61% from the field (20 of 33), 64% from 3-point range (7 of 11) and 93% from the free throw line (13 of 14). Evergreen defeated L-C State 92-85 and Whitman 88-73.

### Cascade Collegiate Conference Men's Basketball Notes

**Cascade:** The Thunderbirds begin the week with a 5-4 record, matching last year's win total ... Tayo Cotton moved into ninth place on the school's career rebounding list (305) last week ... the Thunderbirds will play a pair of NCAA Division I opponents in the coming weeks, traveling to Eastern Washington this Friday and playing at University of Portland Dec. 29.

**College of Idaho:** The Yotes went 1-1 last week in their own Wendy's Classic ... more than \$10,000 was raised and donated to a local adoption agency through the tournament ... Bryan Champ leads the CCC with an average of nearly 3.3 steals per game.

**Concordia:** Through eight games, the Cavaliers have had six different players lead the team in scoring ... sophomore Desmond Meray leads the team in scoring (15 ppg) while senior Cody Aker holds the team lead in rebounding (7.5 rpg) ... senior point guard Jesse Alvarez has recorded only 15 turnovers while dishing out 39 assists.

**Corban:** Freshman Ian Logan has led the Warriors in scoring in each of Corban's last three games, including a career-high 21 vs. Montana State-Northern ... in Corban's 97-89 victory over Walla Walla last Saturday, the Warriors' final 21 points came at the free throw line as Corban shot 21 of 27 at the stripe over the final 3:38 of the game ... for the first time all season, sixth-year head coach Justin Sherwood used a different starting lineup in Friday's game vs. MSU-Northern.

**Eastern Oregon:** The 8-1 Mountaineers earned the highest national ranking in school history last week, climbing to the No. 9 spot in the NAIA Division II national poll ... the Mountaineers share first place in the CCC with Northwest University ... senior wing Mark Carollo, who is averaging 18 ppg, needs just 36 points to become Eastern Oregon's all-time leading scorer.

**Evergreen:** Sophomore guard Nathan Menefee earned CCC Player of the Week honors after scoring 60 points as the Geoducks posted road wins over Lewis-Clark State and Whitman College ... Evergreen went 2-0 last week to improve to 6-1 ... Evergreen's lone loss was an 83-77 CCC setback to Concordia Dec. 1.

**Northwest:** Freshman Greg George continues to lead the Eagles in field goal percentage, shooting a team-best 54.8% (57 of 104) ... junior Eddie Coulson leads the team in scoring (14.8 ppg). Coulson scored 19 points in last Saturday's loss to George Fox University.

**Northwest Christian:** Josh Jarrett has led the Beacons in scoring six times this season and is just 18 points away from breaking into NCC's top 10 single-season scoring list ... entering this week's action, Jarrett ranks fourth in the CCC in scoring (19.5 ppg) and second in rebounding (8.1 rpg) ... the Beacons are shooting 75% from the free throw line as a team, tops in the Cascade Conference ... individually, Michael Van Loon leads the team at the charity stripe (86%).

**Oregon Tech:** The Owls were ranked No. 14 in the nation in last week's NAIA Division II Top 25 poll (new polls are released each Wednesday) ... Ryan Fiegi, last week's CCC Player of the Week, ranks ninth on OIT's all-time scoring list with 1,387 points entering the week ... he begins the week averaging 19.1 ppg (sixth in the CCC) and 6.5 assists per game (No. 1 in the CCC) ... former Oregon Tech honorable mention All-American Josh Garrett has signed a professional contract to play basketball in New Zealand.

**Southern Oregon:** The Raiders were idle last week after dropping a pair of CCC games on the road Nov. 30 and Dec. 1 at College of Idaho and Eastern Oregon ... the Raiders host Dominican Dec. 11 before returning to CCC action Dec. 18-19 vs. Evergreen and Northwest.

**Warner Pacific:** The Knights, ranked sixth nationally in last week's NAIA Division II Top 25 poll, split a pair of non-conference games last week, defeating Walla Walla 82-57 before being upset by Montana State-Northern 82-79 ... Scott O'Gallagher, who leads the CCC in scoring (22.4 ppg), had 27 in the loss to MSU-Northern ... Josh Jackson, the CCC leader in 3-point field goals made (20), led WPC with 20 points in the win over Walla Walla ... the Knights are averaging 87.0 ppg and rank second in the CCC in 3-point field goal percentage defense.
