CCC Player of the Week

Cora McVey of Oregon Tech, a 5-9 senior forward from Dexter, Ore., has been named the Cascade Conference Player of the Week for Dec. 3-9. It is the second CCC honor of the season for McVey, who scored 30 points, pulled down 18 rebounds, dished out six assists and totaled four steals in helping lead the Owls to wins over Kwantlen University and Willamette University last week. McVey shot 53% from the field and 50% from 3-point range, as the Owls captured the tournament title of the Oregon Tech Classic in Klamath Falls.

Cascade Collegiate Conference Women's Basketball Notes

Cascade: The Thunderbirds defeated Walla Walla for the third time this season in last Saturday's 85-52 victory at a tournament at Whitman College ... Te Awhina Aranui is among the career statistical leaders at Cascade, ranking fourth in rebounding (402) and seventh in scoring (412) ... Cascade is averaging 78.9 points per game, a school-record pace.

College of Idaho: The Yotes dropped a pair of games at the Wells Fargo Invitational in Lewiston last week, falling to Carroll College 70-66 and L-C State 93-63 ... Denise Hill was named to the all-tournament team ... College of Idaho takes this week off to prepare for final exams.

Concordia: Freshman Danielle Clauson has led the Cavaliers in scoring in six of the team's first nine games ... sophomore center Ann Snodderly is ranked No. 2 in the CCC in field goal percentage (58%) ... Concordia ranks third in the Cascade Conference in blocked shots per game (3.22).

Corban: Entering this week's action, Corban has won four of its last six games and outscored the opposition in those four wins by an average of 12.3 points per game ... senior Jessica Steigleman has scored 20 or more points in four consecutive games, including a season-best 23 vs. Northwest University. She is averaging a team-high 16.6 points per game, sixth in the CCC ... sophomore Emily Goette has led the Warriors in scoring in five of nine games this season and pulled down a team-high in rebounds three times.

Eastern Oregon: The Mountaineers, who moved into the NAIA Division II Top 25 last week at No. 23, are off to the best start in school history (6-0) ... last weekend, Eastern defeated Linfield College 47-45 ... EOU shares first place in the Cascade Conference with Northwest Christian, both with 2-0 league marks.

Evergreen: The Geoducks dropped a pair of non-conference contests to NCAA opposition last week, falling 73-53 to Seattle University and 60-49 to Pacific Lutheran ... Evergreen hosts another NCAA opponent, Division II member Western Oregon, this Friday.

Northwest: Junior Brittany Bowsher scored a season-high 33 points in the Eagles' 83-82 loss to Whitworth last Friday ... Bowsher ranks fourth in the Cascade Conference in scoring (17.7 ppg) ... Northwest shot 52.6% (10 of 19) from 3-point range in its game vs. Whitworth.

Northwest Christian: Junior center Emily Gray leads the CCC and ranks 13th in the NAIA in scoring average (20.4 ppg) ... Gray also leads the league in blocked shots (21, 1.9 bpg) ... Gray also ranks eighth nationally in double/doubles (4) ... last Tuesday at Simpson College, Gray scored 21 points to eclipse the 1,000-point milestone. She needs just seven rebounds to reach 500 for her NCAA career ... Gary and junior forward McKenzie Gambee are tied for sixth in the CCC in rebounding (8.1 rpg) ... the Beacons recently won five times in a six-game stretch.

Oregon Tech: With a 56-51 non-conference victory Monday night at Linfield, the Owls have now won three straight and are 7-2 on the season ... the Owls won both of their games in last weekend's OIT Classic, defeating Kwantlen University 73-41 and Willamette University 73-44 ... Cora McVey had 20 points and 13 rebounds in the win over Kwantlen, while Jenna Ball had 13 points and 10 boards vs. Willamette ... McVey went on to be named CCC Player of the Week.

Southern Oregon: Southern Oregon (6-2) is off to its best start since the 2002-03 season. That year, the Raiders won the CCC regular season and tournament titles and played in the NAIA national tournament in Sioux City ... the Raiders lead the Cascade Conference in six team categories: scoring, scoring margin, field goal percentage, field goal percentage defense, 3-point field goal percentage and offensive rebounding ... sophomore Jacki Speer is averaging a double-double through eight games (10 ppg, 10 rpg).

Warner Pacific: The Knights fell to George Fox 71-30 in their only contest last week ... Warner Pacific ranks third in the Cascade Conference in scoring defense, allowing an average of 61.3 points per game ... the Knights are on the road this week to face St. Martin's (Friday) and Linfield (Saturday) ... the game vs. St. Martin's was re-scheduled from Dec. 7 due to the recent storms that caused the closure of parts of I-5.
