NAVY FOOTBALL GAMEDAY PARKING GUIDE

PLEASE READ THIS GUIDE CAREFULLY

Welcome and thank you for your support of the 2008 Naval Academy football team. There have been major renovations to Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium the past six years. As such we have updated our game day parking policies.

Purchasing a season parking pass will make your experience enjoyable. Once you purchase your 2008 season parking pass, you will be GUARANTEED a spot in the Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium (Blue and Gold) lot.

Individual game day parking will be very limited in the stadium (Blue and Gold) lot and only available on a pre-sold basis through the Navy ticket office. Parking will not be sold for the stadium (Blue and Gold) lot on game day. Individual game day parking is available at Germantown Elementary for \$15 per car, as well as shuttle services from nearby offsite lots (See map on reverse).

These changes have been made to make your game day experience at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium easier and more enjoyable. Please review the enclosed information and call the Navy ticket office at 1-800-US4-NAVY to reserve your parking spot for the 2008 season.

IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A PARKING PASS, DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PARK AT THE STADIUM. ALL STADIUM PARKING IS PRESOLD THROUGH THE NAVY TICKET OFFICE.

4 IF YOU ARE A SINGLE GAME TICKET HOLDER (I.E. VISITING FAN)

WITHOUT A PARKING PASS YOUR OPTIONS ARE:

- Park in one of the offsite parking lots in downtown Annapolis available on game day and take Annapolis Transit to the stadium (See map). **OR ...**
- Park at Harry Truman Park-and-Ride (located on Riva Road) and take the free shuttle to the stadium (See map). **OR ...**
- Park at Germantown Elementary located on Cedar Park Dr. for \$15 per car (Get there early). Remember that march-on will occur one hour prior to the game and Taylor Avenue will be closed from Rowe Blvd to Gate 6.

TO CHECK ON SINGLE-GAME PARKING AVAILABILITY AT OR NEAR THE STADIUM.

FOR THE OCTOBER 18TH GAME AGAINST PITTSBURGH, ALLOT EXTRA TIME TO GET TO THE STADIUM, AS THE BOAT SHOW WILL ALSO BE TAKING PLACE IN ANNAPOLIS. TRAFFIC WILL BE HEAVY SO ARRIVE EXTRA EARLY TO YOUR DESTINATION.

5 IF YOU ARE A FAN WITHOUT A TICKET OR A PARKING PASS YOUR

OPTIONS ARE:

- Park in one of the offsite parking lots in downtown Annapolis available on game day and take Annapolis Transit to the stadium (See map). **OR ...**
- Park at Harry Truman Park-and-Ride (located on Riva Road) and take shuttle to the stadium (See map). **OR ...**
- Park at Germantown Elementary located on Cedar Park Dr. for \$15 per car (Get there early). **THEN ...**
- Purchase or pick up game tickets at Will Call at the new North endzone ticket booth behind the Class of '53 Pavilion.

TO CHECK ON SINGLE-GAME TICKET AND PARKING AVAILABILITY AT OR NEAR THE STADIUM.

1 IF YOU ARE A SEASON TICKET HOLDER WITH A PRE-PAID SEASON PARKING PASS

FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Read the back of your parking pass for proper instructions and lot regulations.
- Follow posted traffic directions on game day.
- Avoid delays by arriving at the stadium as early as possible. (Our best advice.)
- Display parking pass from rearview mirror. Remember that march-on will occur one hour prior to the game and Taylor Avenue will be closed from Rowe Blvd to Gate 6.

2 IF YOU HAVE AN OVERSIZED VEHICLE YOUR OPTIONS ARE:

- An oversized vehicle is any vehicle that is larger than one standard parking spot.
- Oversized vehicle parking passes are available for \$270 for a season pass or \$45 for an individual game pass (if available).
- All oversized vehicles will be required to enter the stadium through Gate #1 and park in the Gold lot (Northeast corner).
- Must be purchased prior to game day.

6 IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR HANDICAP PARKING YOUR OPTIONS ARE:

Handicap parking spots are available for sale in all Stadium lots on a first-come basis.

A handicap courtesy shuttle is available from the Harry S. Truman Park-and-Ride on Riva Road.

To order a handicap parking permit the following must be submitted to the Navy ticket office:

- 1) copy of a valid state-issued handicap parking placard or license plate,
- 2) copy of valid state-issued handicap parking registration card; **and**
- 3) copy of photo ID of the handicap permit holder (the photo ID must match the handicap parking permit card).

Handicap permit holders will be required to park in the spaces reserved for handicap parking only. You must have this pass prior to game day.

3 IF YOU ARE A SEASON TICKET HOLDER WITHOUT A SEASON PARKING PASS YOUR OPTIONS ARE:

- Park in one of the offsite parking lots in downtown Annapolis available on game day and take Annapolis Transit to the stadium (See map). **OR ...**
- Park at Harry Truman Park-and-Ride (located on Riva Road) and take the free shuttle to the stadium (See map). **OR ...**
- If you already have your game ticket in hand you may obtain a free ride on City of Annapolis buses as long as it is to and from the stadium. **OR ...**
- Park at Germantown Elementary located on Cedar Park Dr. for \$15 per car (Get there early). Remember that march-on will occur one hour prior to the game and Taylor Avenue will be closed from Rowe Blvd to Gate 6.

TRUMAN PARK AND RIDE SHUTTLE SERVICE

Shuttle service begins 5 hours prior to kick-off and drops riders off in front of the Navy Ticket office at the Class of 1953 Pavilion. This is a free shuttle service provided on game day. Shuttles will run approximately every 20 minutes.

Post game shuttle pick up will be in the same location where the drop off occurred (the Navy Ticket office at the Class of 1953 Pavilion). Shuttle runs will begin at the beginning of the 4th quarter and last until 2 hours after the game ends.

GENERAL PARKING INFORMATION

All vehicles will require a paid parking pass for Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium (Blue and Gold) lots.

Parking permits must be displayed on the rearview mirror at all times. Vehicles without visible passes may be considered unauthorized. Remember that march-on will occur one hour prior to the game and Taylor Avenue will be closed from Rowe Blvd to Gate 6.

Cars may enter and park in the stadium lot for which they hold a pass any time after 7 a.m. on the day of the game. Cars must be removed from the lots no later than 2 and a half hours after the game.

Failure to comply with any regulation will result in removal from the lot at the owner's expense. The Naval Academy and the Naval Academy Athletic Association are not liable for loss or damage to any vehicle or its contents. The Naval Academy Athletic Association reserves the right to revoke a parking permit at any time.

DIRECTIONS TO THE STADIUM

FROM THE NORTH

- Take I 97 South to US 50 East
- Exit US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (exit #24) and bear to the right
- Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right
- Right on Farragut Road gives access to gates 1&2
- Right on Taylor (second right) gives access to gates 5&6

FROM WASHINGTON (WEST)

- Take US 50 East
- Exit US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (exit #24) and bear to the right
- Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right
- Right on Farragut Road gives access to gates 1&2
- Right on Taylor (second right) gives access to gates 5&6

FROM THE SOUTH

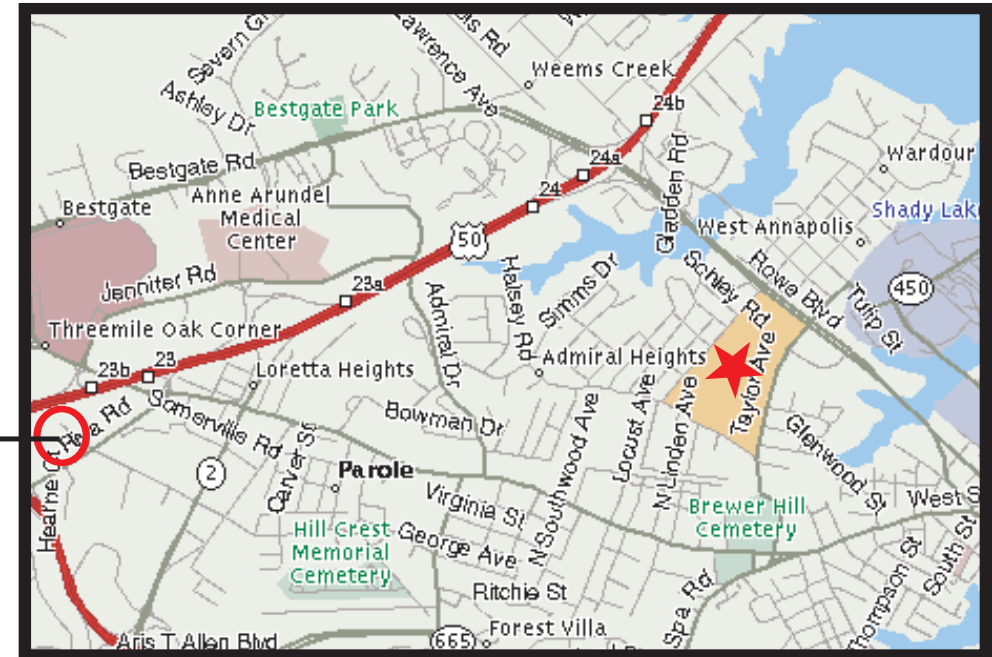
- Take I 95 North to 495 East
- Take I 495 East to 50 East
- Exit US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (exit #24) and bear to the right
- Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right
- Right on Farragut Road gives access to gates 1&2
- Right on Taylor (second right) gives access to gates 5&6

FROM THE EAST

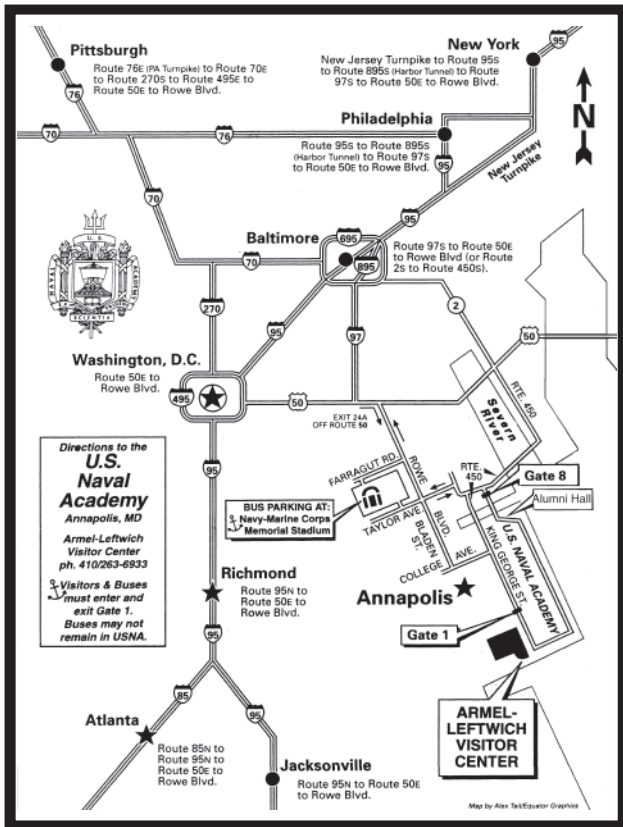
- Take US 50 West across the Bay Bridge
- Exit US 50 at Rowe Blvd. (South)
- Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium is on your right
- Right on Farragut Road gives access to gates 1&2
- Right on Taylor (second right) gives access to gates 5&6

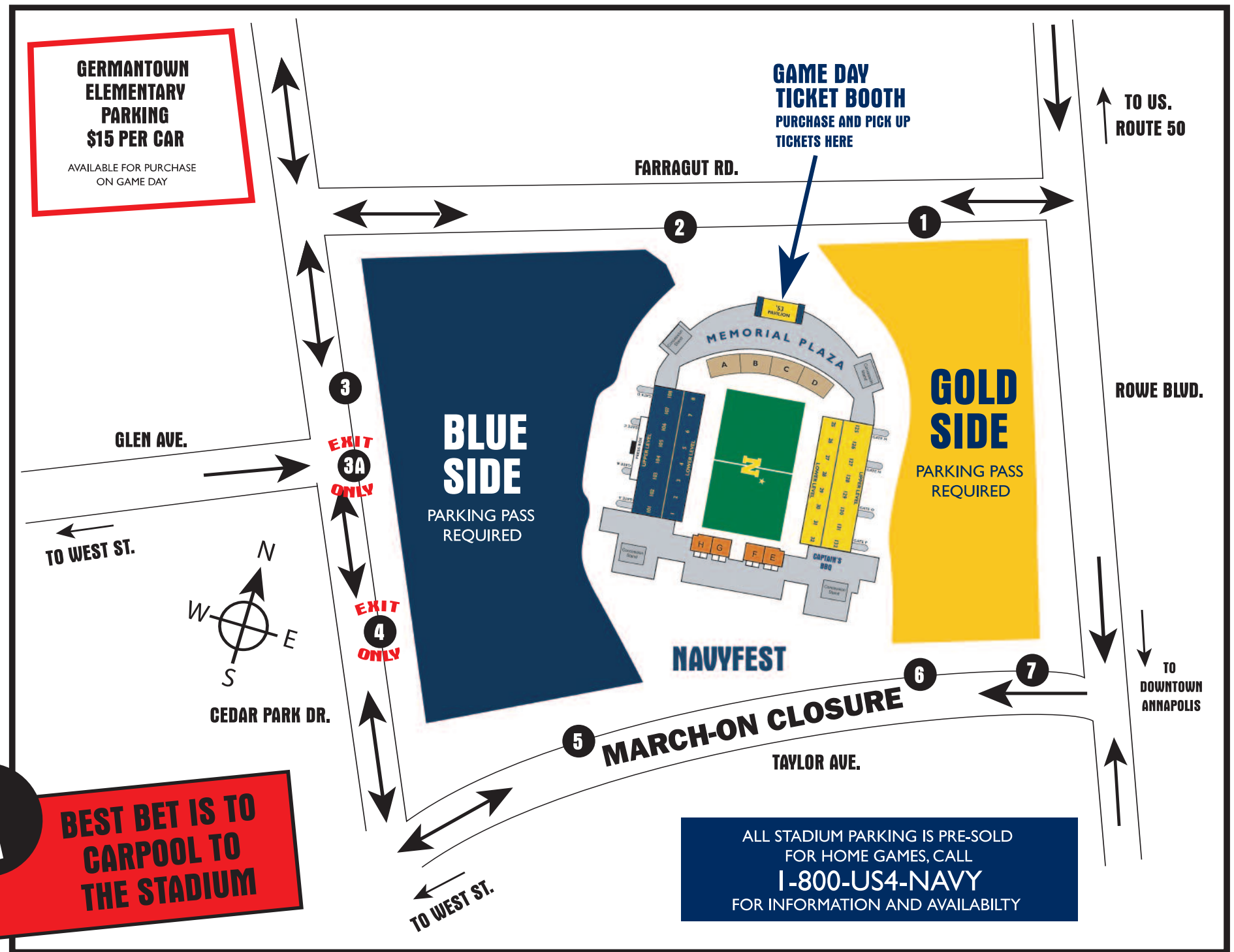
LOCAL MAP OF ANNAPOLIS
