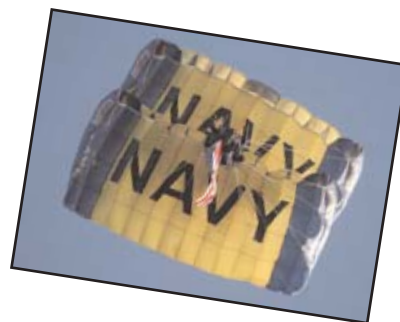


Navy Aquatics Invites YOU!
