#### ❖ LANGE ON BILES

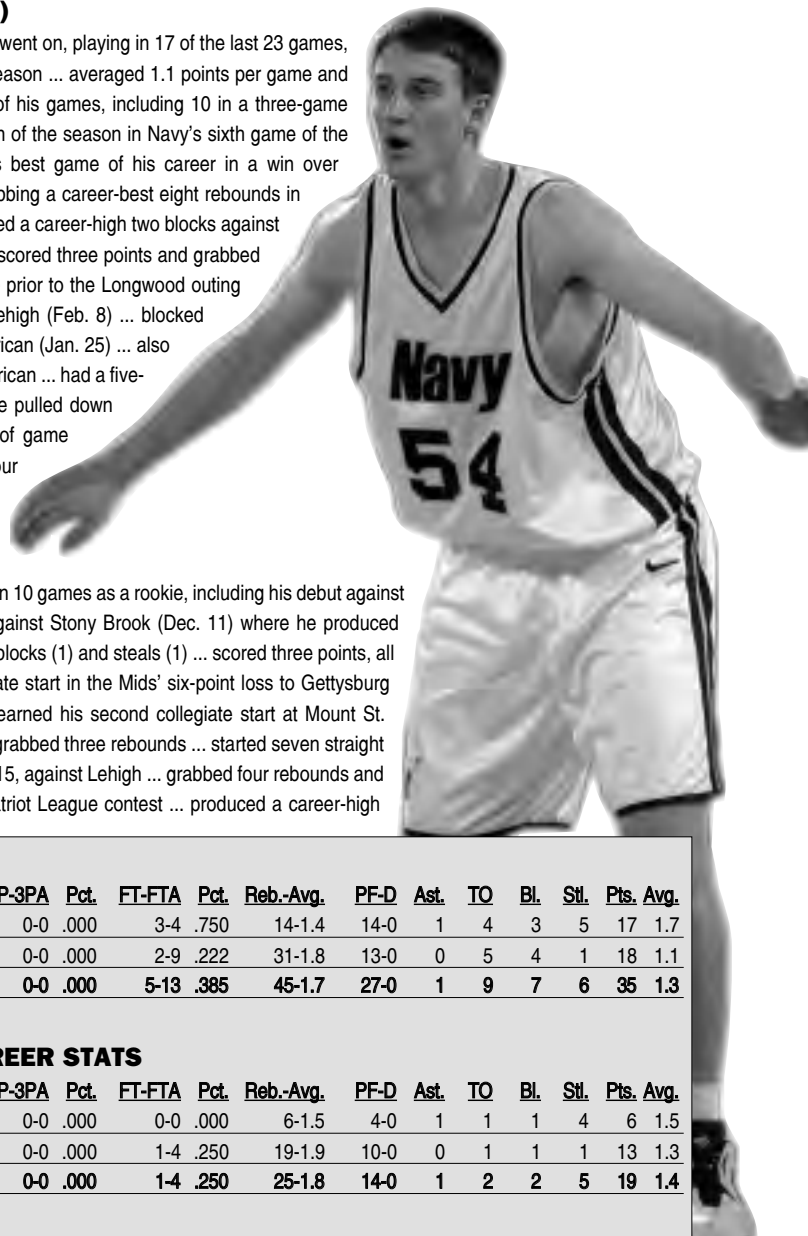
• Ben spent the entire summer in Annapolis, working on his game and getting better. He has improved his skill level immensely and we need him to use his size to help us inside. He will be asked to rebound, play physical, set screens and hopefully use his size to his advantage. He cares about the team first and should be able to provide us with valuable minutes. He has made great strides on improving his body and it shows in his improvement over the summer.

#### ❖ AS A SOPHOMORE (2005-06)

• Biles saw his playing time increase as the year went on, playing in 17 of the last 23 games, averaging 5.0 minutes per game for the entire season ... averaged 1.1 points per game and 1.8 rebounds per game ... scored points in six of his games, including 10 in a three-game stretch from Jan. 14 to Jan. 25 ... saw first action of the season in Navy's sixth game of the year against Morgan State ... had perhaps his best game of his career in a win over Longwood (Jan. 17), scoring five points and grabbing a career-best eight rebounds in a career-high 18 minutes of action ... also recorded a career-high two blocks against the Lancers and finished 2-of-5 from the field ... scored three points and grabbed six rebounds at Lafayette (Jan. 14), in the game prior to the Longwood outing ... tallied four points (2-of-2 shooting) against Lehigh (Feb. 8) ... blocked single shots against Washington (Md.) and American (Jan. 25) ... also grabbed a steal and three rebounds against American ... had a five-game stretch midway through the year where he pulled down 22 rebounds (4.4 a game) in just 50 minutes of game action ... enters 2006-07 having connected on four straight shots from the field.

#### ❖ AS A FRESHMAN (2004-05)

• Billy Lange's first recruited player ... saw action in 10 games as a rookie, including his debut against Ohio (Dec. 4) ... earned 15 minutes of action against Stony Brook (Dec. 11) where he produced then-career highs in scoring (4), rebounding (5), blocks (1) and steals (1) ... scored three points, all from the free throw line ... made his first-collegiate start in the Mids' six-point loss to Gettysburg (Dec. 18) ... scored a bucket in the contest ... earned his second collegiate start at Mount St. Mary's (Dec. 21), where he scored a lay-up and grabbed three rebounds ... started seven straight games from Dec. 18, against Gettysburg to Jan. 15, against Lehigh ... grabbed four rebounds and tallied a steal at Lafayette (Jan. 8) in his first Patriot League contest ... produced a career-high

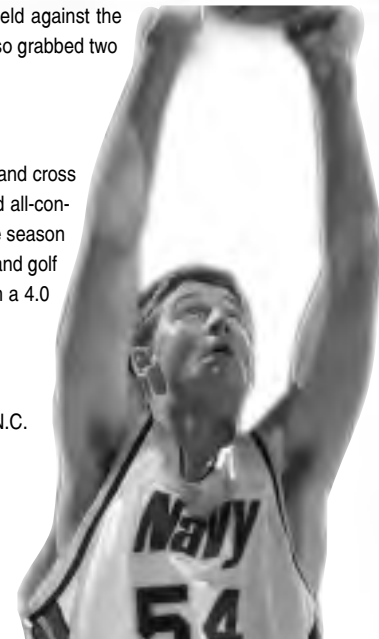

#### ❖ LANGE ON BRIGHAM

• We asked Bryce to improve on two things since the end of last season. One is that we wanted him to become a better ballhandler. Secondly, we felt that he could become one of the best three-point shooters in the country with some consistency. He has taken pride in improving both aspects and should be one of the top long-range threats in the Patriot League.

#### ❖ AS A FRESHMAN (2005-06)

• Brigham had an outstanding freshman season, being one of five players, and one of two freshmen, to play in all 28 games ... Brigham averaged 3.9 points per game during the entire season, but the average jumped to 4.5 in Patriot League play ... he also grabbed 1.3 rebounds per game and was one of two players on the team to have an assist:turnover ratio of at least 1.00 ... Brigham scored in 22 of the 28 games, and connected on at least one three-pointer in 19 of them ... had a stretch of eight games (Dec. 18 to Jan. 11) where he hit at least one three-pointer ... opened the season 15-of-33 (.455) in the first 13 games from three-point land ... in the last 15 games, finished 11-of-36 (.306) ... set career highs in points (13), field goals made (5), three-pointers made (3) and steals (2) against Holy Cross (Feb. 15) ... finished the game 5-of-6 from the field and 3-of-3 from three-point land ... tallied nine points against Washington (Md.) and Bucknell (Jan. 7) ... against the Bison, he was 3-of-5 from three-point range and added a career-best five rebounds in a career-high 22 minutes of action ... against Washington (Md.), Brigham attempted a career-high nine shots, connecting on three of them ... scored five points (2-of-5 shooting) in first career game, the season opener against Georgetown ... scored at least five points in 11 games ... contributed seven points against Army (twice), Holy Cross (Feb. 1) and American (Feb. 23) ... enjoyed playing against Holy Cross, averaging 6.7 points per game, while shooting 8-of-12 from the field and
