THE GAME

Navy opens up the second half of league play on Saturday with a 1:00 pm tip against Lafayette at the Kirby Sports Center in Easton, Pa. The Midshipmen enter the contest with a 3-18 overall record and are looking for their first Patriot League win of the season after going winless in the first "go-around" of league play. Lafayette is 9-13 overall and 4-3 in the Patriot League standings, currently sitting alone in fourth place, one game out of second place behind Lehigh and American (5-2). Three of Navy's seven losses in Patriot League play have been by single-digits and another one was decided by 11 in overtime at Colgate. The Midshipmen lost by two at home (65-63) to Lafayette in the Patriot League opener on Jan. 7.

GAME COVERAGE

Saturday's game with Lafayette can be heard on WNAV (1430 AM, 99.9 FM, wnav.com) and SIRIUS Satellite Radio (Ch. 134) with **Pete Medhurst** handling the call, beginning with the Navy Basketball pregame show at 12:45 pm (ET). All-Access subscribers can watch the game online as part of the Navy and Patriot League All-Access packages and live stats are available on NavySports.com(.) THE OPPONENT

Lafayette currently boasts a 9-13 overall record and is 4-3 in the Patriot League with wins over Colgate, Holy Cross, Army and Navy in the league's first half of play. The Leopards entered the conference season with three straight losses to Columbia, NJIT and Penn before defeating Navy and Army to start league play 2-0. The Leopards own a non-conference win over the Big 10's Penn State, the Nittany Lions first loss ever to a Patriot League squad.

Senior **Ryan Willen** leads Lafayette in scoring (14.8 ppg) and rebounding (5.1 rpg), while sharp-shooting senior **Jim Mower** averages 14.0 ppg and has made 44 three-pointers this year. Preseason all-Patriot League selection **Tony Johnson** returned from a back injury six games ago and is averaging 7.3 ppg and 4.7 apg. As a team, the Leopards are shooting 38.2 percent from three-point range, but are giving up 73.4 points per game and allowing foes to shoot 47.0 percent from the field.

SERIES

Navy leads the series with Lafayette, 41-27, but since the start of the of the 1995-96 season, the two teams are deadlocked with 18 wins apiece. Seven of the last 10 meetings have been determined by single-digits, including a 65-63 Lafayette win on Jan. 7. Navy is 3-8 against Lafayette at the Kirby Sports Center having lost three straight games by an average of just 8.0 points per game (4.5 the last two games). Navy's last win at Kirby came in the 2008 season when **Greg Sprink** found **Clif Colbert** for a baseline jumper with 0.4 seconds left in an 82-80 victory.

UP NEXT: vs. HOLY CROSS (9-12, 3-4 PATRIOT LEAGUE)

Navy hosts Holy Cross on Wednesday, Feb. 8, at Alumni Hall, beginning at 7:00 pm. Holy Cross has won three straight meetings against Navy, including a 73-69 decision in Worcester on Jan. 11.

LAST MEETING IN THE SERIES

Lafayette 65, Navy 63

January 7, 2012 ■ Alumni Hall ■ Annapolis, Md.

Lafayette's **Ryan Willen** scored 10 of Lafayette's last 12 points, including a layup off an offensive rebound with 3:02 to play and a conventional three-point play with 1:54 left that gave the Leopards a three-point lead (60-57), to lift Lafayette to a 65-63 victory over Navy. Navy led 57-53 with 3:25 to play, but Lafayette scored seven straight points to grab a late lead it would not relinquish. Navy led by as many as 10 in the first half, before settling in for a three-point half-time advantage (32-29). **Jordan Sugars** had 20 points and six rebounds and **J.J. Avila** had 15 points and eight rebounds for Navy. Willen led the Leopards with 21 points while **Jim Mower** had 13. The two teams combined for just 18 turnovers, nine by each team, in the contest.

LAST TIME OUT (BUCKNELL 66, NAVY 51)

Navy jumped out to a 6-2 lead early on, but Bucknell used a 20-6 run to take a double-digit lead and the Bison led by at least 11 for the last 26 minutes of the contest en route to a 66-51 victory over the Midshipmen. Bucknell has now won three straight in the series for the first time since winning seven in a row from Feb. 13, 2005 to Jan. 11, 2008. Bucknell connected on 26-of-51 (.510) from the field while holding Navy to 20-of-55 (.364) from the field and 3-of-19 (.158) from three-point range. The two squads combined to shoot 18-of-19 from the free throw line as Bucknell went 10-of-10 and Navy was 8-of-9. It marked the 10th time this season that Navy was held to 59 or fewer points. **Worth Smith** (7-of-10) and **Isaiah Roberts** (5-of-10) combined to go 12-of-20 (.600) from the field, while the rest of the Midshipmen went 8-of-35 (.229) from the field and 1-of-16 (.063) from three-point range. Smith led Navy with a career-high 16 points and nine rebounds and Roberts tied his career high with 13. 2011 Patriot League Player of the Year **Mike Muscala** went 11-of-15 from the field for 27 points and eight rebounds.

NAVY NOTEBOOK

- During's Navy's 14-game losing streak, Navy is getting outscored by a 67.1 to 57.3 points per game margin and the Mids are shooting just 39.0 percent from the field and 26.4 percent from three-point range. Opponents are shooting 49.2 percent from the field and 39.2 percent from long distance.
- In its seven league games, Navy is shooting just 39.3 percent from the field and 26.7 percent from three-point range (47.2 percent from two-point range). Opponents are shooting 48.6 percent from the field and 43.1 percent from three-point range.
- In its seven league games, opponents have made 122 free throws, while Navy has attempted 115.
- In Navy's three wins, the Midshipmen are shooting 52.5 percent from the field and have 56 assists against 46 turnovers for an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.22 while averaging 76.7 points per game.
- In the 17 losses, Navy is shooting 39.4 percent from the field, 26.3 percent from three-point range and is averaging just 57.2 points per game.
- Navy has had 11 different starting lineups already this year and has not started the same lineup since Dec. 6-10, vs. Monmouth and Missouri.
- The last five opponents (Army, American, Colgate, Lehigh and Bucknell) have each shot over 50.0 percent from the field. However, all five of them have shot between 51.0 and 51.2 percent.
- Navy has outrebounded seven of its 21 opponents this year. Last year, Navy outrebounded just five opponents.
- The Midshipmen have not shot 45.0 percent in a game since Jan. 1 vs. Norfolk State. Navy has shot under 45.0 percent in all seven Patriot League games.
- J.J. Avila**, **Worth Smith** and **Jordan Sugars** have grabbed 364 of Navy's 648 rebounds, averaging 17.3 rebounds per game between them while grabbing 56.2 percent of Navy's rebounds. All three of them average at least 4.9 rebounds per game; next highest is Jackson (1.5 rpg).
- In the previous seven seasons (2005-11), Navy was 56-18 (.757) when attempting more free throws than its opponent. This year so far, Navy is just 3-7 (.300).
- Navy has failed to reach 70 points in a game since the second game of the season, when it scored 88 against Penn State Altoona on Nov. 13.
- When opponents shoot better than Navy, the Mids are just 1-18 with the lone win coming against Mount St. Mary's.
- Navy is just 3-6 when leading or tied at halftime. Navy has had at least a five-point lead in six of its 14 losses during its losing streak.
- Navy remains stuck on win No. 1,298 in program history, still needing two wins for 1,300. The Mids own a 1,298-933 record (.582).
- Navy has had 266 consecutive games with a three-pointer, dating back to Jan. 30, 2003 vs. Colgate (0-for-3).
- Navy has had 173 consecutive games in which a Texas native has played, dating back to Feb. 25, 2006 vs. Colgate.
- Navy has had 139 consecutive games in which a Texas native has started, dating back to Nov. 17, 2007 vs. Texas-San Antonio.
- Navy's 14-game losing streak is one shy of the school record (15) set during the 1988-89 season. The Mids' 14-game streak is the fourth longest in the country (Binghamton - 23; UC Davis - 16; South Carolina State - 15). Navy has tied a school record with seven straight home losses and its seven straight Patriot League losses are the fourth most in school history.
- Brandon Venturini** leads the team in plus-minus (points for minus points against while on the floor / much like hockey) with a plus-46 total. The next highest total for a player that has played at least 170 minutes is **Brennan Wyatt** at minus-1.
- According to BBState.com, Navy ranks 314th nationally, and last in the PL, in possessions / game, which takes into account the pace of play that a team plays. It is a stark contrast to what Navy played under previous head coach **Billy Lange**. Under Lange, Navy ranked 13th (2011), 21st (2010), 55th (2009), ninth (2008), 270th (2007), 37th (2006) and fifth (2005) in possessions / game, averaging well over 70.0 possessions per game in those years. This year's team is averaging 63.8 possessions per game, compared to 74.2 possessions per game a year ago.
- Opponents have averaged at least 1.00 points per possession in 12 straight games and in 16 games overall. Over the last 12 games, opponents have scored 829 points on 724 possessions for an average of 1.15 points per possession. The standard average is about 1.00.
- Navy's freshmen (mostly **Worth Smith**, **Brandon Venturini**, **Donya Jackson** and **Jared Smoot**) are averaging 21.5 points per game over the last four games, accounting for 86 of Navy's 225 points during that span (38.2 percent). The group scored 32 points against Colgate, the most for the freshman class against a Division I foe this year.

NAVY STILL SHOOTING AT A HIGH CLIP

Despite Navy's struggles lately, the Midshipmen are still shooting at its highest mark from the field in over 10 years. Navy is shooting 41.3 percent from the field which, if the season ended today, would be the highest mark for a season since the 2000-01 team shot 44.1 percent from the field. During Navy's era in the Patriot League, the 41.3 percent would rank as the ninth-best field goal percentage in Navy's 21 years as a member of the Patriot League.

In addition, Navy is shooting a high percentage from inside the three-point line, connecting on 334-of-669 (.499) field goal attempts inside the three-point line. It would be Navy's highest mark inside the three-point line since it joined the Patriot League in 1991-92 (next highest is 49.7 percent in the 1994-95 season) and the second-highest mark in school history behind the very first season with the three-point line (1986-87) when a man by the name of **David Robinson** roamed the paint. That year, the Midshipmen shot 53.0 percent inside the three-point line.

THREE-POINT ISSUES

However, Navy's three-point shooting has been an issue all season long. Navy's current three-point percentage of 27.7 percent would smash the current school-record low of 29.4 percent set last year. Navy is shooting just 26.7 percent from three-point range in league play. Outside of **Worth Smith** (18-of-52 / .346), the rest of the team is shooting 99-of-370 (.268) from three-point range in all games and 32-of-125 (.256) in Patriot League games.

In the last two games, Navy is shooting 8-of-37 (.216) from three-point range and in the seven league games, Navy has made over 30.0 percent of its three-point attempts just twice (Holy Cross and Colgate; both at 33.3 percent). For the season, Navy has made 30.0 percent of its three-point attempts just nine times in 21 games.

Over the last two seasons (52 games), Navy has made just 353-of-1,225 (.288) of its three-point attempts. The Midshipmen ranked 281st (out of 286 teams listed) ranked last year in three-point percentage and this year, the Midshipmen are 331st (out of 338 teams).

NAVY TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

Navy enters the Lafayette game having committed just 299 turnovers in 21 games, an average of 14.2 turnovers per game. At the current pace, Navy would finish the season with 412 turnovers, which would be the fourth fewest in school history. As it stands now, the 14.2 turnovers per game would also rank as the fourth-lowest average in school history. In addition, Navy is averaging just 12.6 turnovers per game in Patriot League play, which is amazingly, the seventh most in league play.

STARTING LINEUPS

Head coach **Ed DeChellis** has had a difficult time picking just one starting lineup, as inconsistency has plagued the Midshipmen all season long. DeChellis has been quoted as saying that players haven't been able to put together long stretches of consistent play, playing well for 2-3 days, then not playing well in either practice or games, thus causing changes in the lineup to who has the hot hand in practice.

It's been evident as DeChellis has started eight different lineups in the last 11 games and the same lineup has not started back-to-back games since Dec. 6-10 against Monmouth and 10th-ranked Missouri. Nine different players have started at least three games, but only six players have started nine or more games. Twelve different players have earned the starting nod this year. The only constants in the lineup this year have been **J.J. Avila** and **Jordan Sugars**, who have started all 21 games.

NAVY ON THE DEFENSIVE END

Despite the 3-18 record, Navy ranks third in the Patriot League and 150th nationally in scoring defense. Navy is giving up just 66.1 points per game, on pace for the fewest since the 2006-07 team allowed just 62.7 points per game. Since the 2003-04 season, Navy has finished 190th or below nationally in scoring defense in seven of the eight seasons (2007 - 45th). Navy has also finished no higher than 242nd nationally in rebound margin in any of the last five years. This year's team ranks 226th (minus 1.1).

However, Navy's opponents are shooting 47.3 percent from the field, the highest mark for a Navy opponent since the 1991-92 squad (.486). The percentage ranks eighth on the all-time Navy list for field goal percentage by an opponent for the entire season. The Mids rank 311th nationally in that category, which would be the sixth time in the last nine years (since 2003-04) that Navy ranked worse than 200th in field goal percentage defense. Opponents are making 36.4 percent of their three-point attempts, the highest mark since 2003-04 (.383). Navy ranks 273rd in the country this year in three-point percentage defense.

MIDS STRUGGLE LATE IN TIGHT GAMES

Navy is 0-5 in games decided by four or fewer points and is just 2-10 in games decided by single digits. Navy has held a lead or been within five points with less than five minutes to go in all but six of its 18 losses (Quinnipiac, Missouri, Presbyterian, Army, Lehigh and Bucknell). Of Navy's 18 losses, just three (Quinnipiac, Missouri and Presbyterian) have been decided by 16 points or more.

- **Siena** -- Navy trailed 60-56 with 48 seconds left, but two straight turnovers in the final 30 seconds cost Navy any chance at a rally and Siena scored the game's final five points for a 65-56 decision.
- **Tulane** -- Navy led 55-53 with 4:24 to play, but went 0-of-5 with two turnovers down the stretch as Tulane scored the last four points of the game for a 57-55 setback.
- **Albany** -- After a furious Navy rally cut an Albany lead from 20 to four points, Navy failed to block out on a missed free throw and Albany would make two free throws on the ensuing possession with 1:40 left. Navy could get no closer than four points the rest of the way.
- **UMES** -- Navy trailed 46-43 with 6:11 to play, but made just 1-of-5 field goals with two turnovers down the stretch and the Hawks outscored Navy 13-3 in the final six minutes for the 13-point victory.
- **Elon** -- Led 45-42 with 3:33 left to play, but failed to even attempt a field goal in the last 3:30, turning the ball over three times and allowing Elon to end the game on a 9-3 spurt.
- **Monmouth** -- Led 62-60 with 5:08 left and had three chances to extend the lead off offensive rebounds. The Mids went just 2-of-7 from the field and had two of their three second-half turnovers during the stretch. Navy's last two field goals came in a rally mode in the final 48 seconds.
- **Mercer** -- Navy trailed 55-52 with 1:53 to play and had a two-on-one break after a steal. However, Navy turned the ball over and Mercer came down and hit a three-pointer to push the lead to six. Two of Mercer's five three-pointers in the game came in the last 1:30 of the contest.
- **Norfolk State** -- Navy held a six-point halftime lead, but trailed 64-63 with 1:53 to play. The Mids then went 0-of-4 from the field and 2-of-4 from the free throw line in the waning moments to end any hopes at a comeback.
- **Lafayette** -- Navy held a four-point lead with 3:25 to play, but had a turnover resulting in two Lafayette points and the Leopards scored five points off offensive rebounds in the final three minutes to kick-start a 12-4 run, allowing Lafayette to rally for the two-point victory.

- **Holy Cross** -- Navy led 56-53 with 7:21 to play, but then went scoreless for the next 4:30, allowing Holy Cross to go on a 12-0 run for a 65-56 lead. Navy twice cut the lead to three points in the final 1:07, but could draw no closer. The Mids went 0-of-5 from the field during the stretch.
- **American** -- Navy whittled a 25-point deficit to four points with a minute to play and had two chances to cut into the lead even further. However, the Midshipmen committed two of its nine turnovers in a 20-second span in the final minute to thwart any Navy comeback, losing by seven.
- **Colgate** -- Navy led by 11 in the second half and by four with 30 seconds left. A Colgate free throw, then a failed box-out on the second attempt allowed Colgate to make a three-pointer with seven seconds left to tie the game. It was the first double-digit second-half lead lost since Feb. 2009.

CHART-CLIMBING WITH SUGARS

Jordan Sugars enters Saturday's game with Lafayette needing just five rebounds for 600 in his career. Doing so, would make him the 10th player in school history with 600 rebounds and just one of seven Navy players (Eddie Reddick, David Robinson, Vernon Butler, Kevin Sinnett, Hank Kuzma and Don Lange) as members of the 1,200-point, 600-rebound club.

Sugars has joined Greg Sprink (2005-08) as the only players in Navy history to rank in the top 20 in career scoring and rebounding and the top 10 in career three-pointers made. He needs 139 points to move into the top 10 in career scoring.

AVILA AMONG NATION'S MOST COMPLETE PLAYERS

Sophomore J.J. Avila is one of five players nationally (Memphis' Will Barton, Miami [Ohio]'s Julian Mavunga, Princeton's Ian Hummer and Central Michigan's Trey Zeigler) to average 15.0 ppg, 7.0 rpg and 2.5 apg. If you throw in his 38 steals (1.8 spg), Avila may be one of America's most-complete players.

He already ranks fourth in points scored by a Navy player by the end of his sophomore season with 691 and is one of two Navy players (Vernon Butler in 1983-84) to score 500 points with 250 rebounds and 100 assists by the end of his sophomore season. He is the only player in the Patriot League to rank in the top 10 of points, rebounds, assists and field goal percentage and he and Iowa State's Royce White are the only players in the country to lead their respective team in points, rebounds, assists and steals.

Ed DeChellis is in his first year at Navy, leaving after a very successful eight-year run at his alma mater, Penn State. DeChellis led the Nittany Lions to a spot in the Big 10 title game and a berth in the NCAA Tournament's second round a year ago. In 2009, DeChellis was named the Big 10 Coach of the Year after guiding the Nittany Lions to a NIT National title and a school-record 27 wins. His time at Penn State followed a successful run at East Tennessee State, where he led the Bucs to an NCAA Tournament in 2003. He was named the 2006 Coaches vs. Cancer Man of the Year and to date, has helped raise over 1.5 million dollars for Coaches vs. Cancer. In the 2009-10 year alone, he helped raise over \$200,000 for the organization.

LIVING UP TO HIS NAME

Navy freshman **Worth Smith** is having a sensational freshman season, ranking third on the team in both scoring (7.4 ppg) and rebounding (5.1 rpg). However, in the seven league games, Smith is averaging 9.0 ppg and 5.9 rpg with a pair of double-doubles (13 p, 10 r vs. Holy Cross; 10 p, 10 r vs. Colgate) under his belt. Shooting 47.3 percent from the field, Smith is trying to become the first Navy freshman since **James Norris** in 1993 to score 100 points, grab 100 rebounds and shoot 45.0 percent from the field.

Among the league's freshmen in all games played, Smith ranks second in scoring (behind Lafayette's **Seth Hinrichs** at 8.2 ppg) at 7.4 points per game, first in rebounding (5.1 rpg), second in blocks (13) and fourth in steals (15). His 47.3 percent field goal percentage is fourth best among league freshmen. Among all players, Smith is 29th in scoring, 12th in rebounding and fifth in offensive rebounds.

However, in just Patriot League games, Smith leads all league freshmen in scoring (9.0 ppg), rebounding (5.9 rpg), is second in field goal percentage (.462) and first in offensive rebounds per game (3.0 rpg). Among all players, Smith leads the Patriot League (in league games only) in offensive rebounds per game (3.00) and is 18th in scoring, seventh in rebounding and 11th in field goal percentage.

FRESHMEN STEPPING UP THEIR GAME

Navy's freshmen have had to play a significant role this year and it has become more evident during league play that coach **Ed DeChellis** will lean on the group more. During the seven Patriot League games, the group boasts the team's third, fifth, sixth and 10th-leading scorers on the team. As a whole, the six members are averaging 17.3 points per game, accounting for 28.9 percent of Navy's scoring (121 of 419 points). The group is shooting 48-of-118 (.407) from the field, while the rest of the team is shooting just 101-of-261 (.397) from the field.

Other contributors include **Brandon Venturini**, who is averaging 5.0 ppg in league games to rank ninth among league freshmen in scoring. Venturini has just two turnovers against 12 assists in league games (assist-to-turnover ratio of 6.00) and leads the Midshipmen with an astonishing plus-46 (plus-minus / much like hockey) for the entire season. The next highest number of any Navy player that has played 175 minutes is **Brennan Wyatt** (minus-1).

Donya Jackson is averaging 3.4 points per game in league games to rank seventh on the squad. Jackson is shooting 11-of-24 (.458) from the field, including 10-of-17 (.588) from inside the three-point line. He scored 11 points against Colgate, the most he has scored in a game since tallying 12 against Albany on Nov. 25.

The last contributor is **Jared Smoot**, who has seen his minutes increase in the last four games. Smoot has played 23 minutes combined in the last four games. During that span, he has scored four points (2-of-2 FGs) with seven rebounds. A fantastic athlete, Smoot is starting to earn some game experience and he has a tremendous upside that will give him more minutes during the second half of league play.

NAVY SENIORS RECEIVE SERVICE ASSIGNMENTS, SELECT SHIPS AFTER COMMISSIONING

Service assignments were handed out on Wednesday, Nov. 30 to all of Navy's 1,135 seniors and Navy's three seniors on the basketball team received their first choice. Ship selections were then handed out on Thursday, Feb. 2, in a ceremony for Naval Academy seniors.

Jordan Sugars and **Carlton Smith** each received Surface Warfare Officer (Surface Warfare Officers are Navy officers whose training and primary duties focus on the operation of Navy ships at sea and the management of various shipboard systems). Sugars selected the USS Anchorage LPD 23 out of San Diego, Calif. Smith, meanwhile selected the USS Bataan out of Norfolk, Va., and will join 2011 Navy basketball graduates **Romeo Garcia** and **Greg Brown** on the ship in June.

Ted Connolly received the Special Warfare assignment of Navy SEAL (Sea, Air and Land Teams -- U.S. Navy's principal special operations force and a part of the Naval Special Warfare Command (NSWC) as well as the maritime component of the United States Special Operations Command).
