NAVY SEEKS FIRST WIN OF 2005-06 SEASON ON THE ROAD

MIDS LOOK FOR FIRST WIN OF 05-06 CAMPAIGN

Coming off a 72-49 loss to Big East power Georgetown last Friday at Alumni Hall in Annapolis, Navy will travel more than 900 miles to Arkansas in search of the Mids' first win of the 2005-06 campaign. This marks the first time in the program's 99-year history that the Midshipmen will play in the state of Arkansas.

UALR (the preferred name of Arkansas-Little Rock) is also coming off a loss. The Trojans dropped a 75-65 decision on the road to Appalachian State last Friday.

FRESHMEN SEE TIME IN OPENER

All six freshmen saw time in the Mids' opener against Georgetown, and four of the six dumped in buckets for Navy. **Bryce Brigham** led the charge with five points, a rebound, a steal and an assist. **Kaleo Kina** played 18 minutes and led the Mids with three assists, while grabbing a steal, a rebound and scoring four points. **Adam Teague** pulled down three boards and scored a bucket, while **John Bailey** entered the game where he immediately scored on a lay-up.

GUARDS PRODUCE VS. GEORGETOWN

Navy's starting guard combination of **Corey Johnson** and **Greg Sprink** led the Mids against Georgetown last Friday in the opener. Both players scored a team-high 14 points for the Mids, while Johnson added five boards and a pair of steals.

FANNIN FACES TOUGH FRONT LINE

Georgetown has one of the best front lines in the country and arguably all three players — Jeff Green, Brandon Bowman and seven-footer Roy Hibbert, could be NBA players in the near future. Navy senior captain **Matt Fannin**, however, held his own against the Hoyas. He led the Mids in rebounding with eight and steals with four, while swatting two shots and scoring eight points.

ROAD WOES

Over the last six years, the Mids have posted a 23-55 (.295) record on the road, versus a 50-39 (.562) mark in games played at Alumni Hall. Over the last five seasons, Navy has won just eight of its 50 road games (.160).

Over the last five years, Navy has scored 70-plus points just 36 times in 115 games (.313). In the last four seasons, the Mids have scored 70 points just 21 times in 85 games (.247). In 2003-04, Navy scored 70-plus points just four times, while last season, the Mids topped 70 points in 13 of the 28 contests.

ABOUT UALR

- UALR has won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference East Division titles.
- UALR owned a 13-1 record at home a year ago and under head coach Steve Shields' watch, the Trojans are 25-3 on their home floor.
- UALR led the Sun Belt last season in free throw percentage, hitting 72.7 percent.
- The Trojans finished the 2004-05 campaign with the second-highest RPI rating in school history ... it ended the year at No. 64.
- Guard Elijah Muldrow is the only senior on the UALR squad and is one of only three returning let-winners.
- Golden State Warriors guard Derek Fisher played at UALR from 1993-96 and is third on the school's all-time scoring list with 1,393 points ... Fisher donated \$700,000 to the institution for its auxiliary gym which is named in his honor.
- UALR head coach Steve Shields was named the 2004 Sun Belt Coach of the Year.

NAVY-UALR SERIES

The Mids and Trojans meet for the first time on the hardwood when the two programs clash Tuesday.

NAVY VS. THE SUN BELT CONFERENCE

Navy has just four of the 11 schools that make up the Sun Belt and owns a 4-3 (.571) record against the conference members. The Mids have played Arkansas State, Denver, Florida International and South Alabama. The last time Navy faced a Sun Belt foe was in 2000 when the Mids defeated Denver on the road, 92-78.

THE JACK STEPHENS CONNECTION

The late Jack Stephens donated money to both UALR and Navy to help build and renovate facilities. In 2003, Stephens gave a \$10 million gift to Navy's *Leaders to Serve the Nation* campaign which included the renovation of the Mids' football stadium, Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium. The field has since been named "Jack Stephens Field" in honor of the donor.

Stephens' name also dons UALR's newly-opened basketball arena. Tuesday's game marks the first regular-season men's basketball contest played at the Jack Stephens Center. The Trojans played two exhibition men's basketball contests earlier this month.

HOOPER FOR THREE

Senior guard **David Hooper** hit at least one three-pointer in 23 of the 28 games in 2004-05, and has made a triple in 53 of the 76 games (.697) in which he has played during his career.

Hooper is ranked seventh on the Mids' all-time three-point field goals list with 113. He trails sixth-place Michael Burd by just eight triples, while he is 88 away from Michael Heary's school-record 201 threes. He stands as one of only seven players in Academy history to make 100-career three-pointers. He accomplished this feat when he connected on a triple against Army in last year's Star Game.

THE RETURNING CAST

Navy returns three starters and six lettermen from the 2004-05 squad. The Mids' returning players topped the 1,200-point plateau and turned in better than 600 rebounds. Last season's leader in every statistical category returns for Navy this season, with the exception of blocks. More than 60 percent of the production in nearly every statistic returns for the Mids, including three-point shooting, where Navy returns 69.1 percent of its long-range scoring. George O'Garro and Laramie Mergerson, 2005 grads, were the top shot blockers for the Mids a year ago, leaving **Matt Fannin** as Navy's top returning shot blocker.

GET OUT THE TALCUM POWDER

Second-year head coach Billy Lange and his staff welcomed six newcomers to the Academy over the summer. Though the newcomers may be in their infancy at Navy, Lange has high expectations for his first full recruiting class.

Navy is now 74-25 (.747) in season openers after a 72-49 loss to Georgetown last Friday in Annapolis.

Navy has won just two of its last nine and four of its last 11 season openers. In the last 11 years, Navy has opened at home just five times, including three times in the last eight years. Navy owns a 4-1 record in openers played in Annapolis over the last 11 seasons.

MEET THE CAPTAIN

Senior forward **Matt Fannin** will serve as the Mids' team captain this season. A two-year starter, Fannin is perhaps the most experienced player in the Navy lineup.

"The main thing I'm excited about heading into the season is the senior leadership in general," said Navy coach Billy Lange. "The class as a whole is unselfish, hard working and solid people. It all stems from the chief of the tribe, Matt Fannin.

"Matt puts the program ahead of himself in terms of image first, winning second and himself third. It sets a good example of future captains of the Navy basketball program."

If there was an award for the league's most improved player, Fannin would have ran away with it last season. A slimmer, more mobile player, Fannin led the Mids in scoring (10.9 ppg) and rebounding (6.7 rpg) a year ago. His 7.4 boards in Patriot League action tied for the best mark in the conference, while he earned top billing for his 3.14 offensive boards per game.

ALUMNI HALL: HOME OF THE MIDSHIPMEN

The Mids have traditionally been known as a strong home court team. Navy was 15-2 at Alumni Hall during the 2000-01 campaign, winning 15 in a row while boasting a 6-0 league mark at home. But recently Navy has struggled to defend its home court. Last season marked the first time since the 2000-01 season (5-1), in which Navy secured a winning home record in Patriot League action, posting a 4-3 record.

Since opening its doors for the 1991-92 season, Navy has produced a 124-68 (.646) record in Alumni Hall. Against Patriot League foes, the Mids are 55-33 (.625).

QUICK RECOVERY

Junior forward **Carlton Baldwin** made a quick recovery after breaking his right ankle the weekend of Sept. 24-25. The two-year letterwinner had surgery on Sept. 26 and was expected to be out at least two months. He returned to practice on Nov. 3, roughly six weeks after his surgery and was in the starting lineup in the Mids' season opener against Georgetown.

It's the second-straight year in which Baldwin has suffered a preseason injury. In September of 2004, he fractured a toe in his left foot and was so severe, the doctors estimated three to six months of recovery time. Baldwin missed just the first-three games of the season.

THE NATION'S FUTURE LEADERS

Three of Navy's four seniors recently received their service assignments for which they will fulfill upon graduation in May. **Kelvin Boatner** and **David Hooper** will pursue careers as surface warfare officers aboard a ship and team captain **Matt Fannin** will serve as a naval flight officer, the backseater in an aircraft. **Leonard Green** is still awaiting his assignment.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

Navy's 16 varsity players represent 12 different states — Arizona, California (2), Colorado, Indiana (2), Kansas, Maryland, North Carolina (2), Ohio, Oregon, Texas, Virginia (2) and Washington.

ELITE EIGHT ANNIVERSARY

This year marks the 20th anniversary of the 1985-86 team's memorable run in the NCAA Tournament. Led by All-American David Robinson, the Mids disposed of Tulsa, Syracuse and Cleveland State before dropping a 71-50 decision to top-ranked Duke in the Elite Eight. Navy will welcome back the 1985-86 Elite Eight team on Jan. 7 to recognize their accomplishments.

NEXT OPPONENT

Navy returns home to play host to rival Academy Air Force next Sunday (Nov. 27). Game time is set for 9 p.m. at Alumni Hall and will be aired live on CSTV.

NOTABLES FOR 2004-05
NAVY ON THE RISE

Navy produced a 9-19 record a year ago, claiming wins in five of its final 10 games. It's the most wins by Navy since the 2001-02 team produced a 10-20 record. The Mids' five conference wins (5-9) marked the most by a Navy team since the 2001-02 squad posted a 5-9 record.

NATIONAL NOISE

Navy finished 2004-05 ranked among the country's top 100 in rebound margin and steals. The Mids' +5.1 rebound margin was the 32nd best among 326 Div. I schools, while Navy finished 34th in steals per game, grabbing 8.9 per contest.

TOP O' THE LEAGUE

The Mids finished the 2004-05 campaign ranked No. 1 in the Patriot League in four statistical categories (overall games), including scoring offense. Navy averaged 69.7 points per game, 2.5 points more than second-place Lafayette (67.2 ppg). The Mids displayed a +13.5 scoring gain over the previous season, while averaging just under six boards a game more than the 2003-04 campaign.

Navy also led the league in rebounding offense (41.1), offensive rebounds (16.11) and rebounding margin (+5.1).

TOP O' THE LEAGUE PART 2

In Patriot League competition, Navy paced the conference in rebounding offense (42.4) and offensive rebounds (17.14).

ON THE GLASS

Navy concluded last year's league season as the top rebounding offense, grabbing 42.4 boards per game. That mark was just 0.4 off the school record set during the 1997-98 season, and matched the following year. It marks the first time since 1999-00 (41.2 rpg) that Navy has averaged 40-plus rebounds in conference play.

CLOSE CALLS

Eighteen (6-12, .333) of Navy's 28 games last season were decided by 10 points or less, including 10 of the last 16. Additionally, nine contests (3-9, .333) were decided by five or fewer points.

TWENTY SOMETHING

A Navy player scored 20 or more points in 12 of the Mids' 28 contests last year, including the last three games. In 2003-04, Navy players produced just five 20-plus point games.

JOHNSON, SPRINK NAMED TO PATRIOT LEAGUE ALL-ROOKIE TEAM

Starting guards **Corey Johnson** and **Greg Sprink** were named to the 2004-05 Patriot League All-Rookie Team. The Johnson-Sprink duo is the fourth tandem to earn all-rookie recognition for the Midshipmen. Mark Majick and Derrick Wall both garnered all-rookie honors in 1991-92, Randy Torgrimson and Brian Walker were acknowledged in 1993-94 and Jason Jeanpierre and Scott Long were etched into the all-rookie annals in 1999-00. Current teammate, junior guard **David Hooper**, was among those honored in 2002-03.

JOHNSON, SPRINK MAKE THEIR MARK

Guards **Corey Johnson** and **Greg Sprink** garnered Patriot League All-Rookie Team kudos last season after accomplishing a feat no other freshman tandem has done at Navy — become the first pair to each score 200 points. Johnson became just the 14th freshman in school history to post 200 points when he led the Mids with 17 against Holy Cross on Feb. 4. He finished the season with 269 points, the sixth-best freshman scoring output in Navy history. Sprink made his way onto the list with his 20-point effort against American in the Patriot League Tournament. He finished the season with 209 points and stands 15th on the Mids all-time freshman scoring list.
