MIDS RETURN AFTER WEEK-LONG LAYOFF

After a nine-day layoff for final exams, Navy returns to action Sunday when it plays host to Washington (Md.) College. Game time is set for 3:00 pm and will be carried live via 1430 WNAV with Pete Medhurst calling the action.

Navy owns a two-game winning streak heading into its contest with the Shoremen, defeating MEAC foes Howard and Morgan State. Last season, Navy put together back-to-back wins three times. However, one would have to turn the calendar back four years to find the last time the Mids won three straight. Navy strung together three wins twice during the 2001-02 campaign.

NAVY-MORGAN STATE HIGHLIGHTS

☆ Senior forward **David Hooper** paced the Mids with a season-high 16 points, shooting 5 for 9 from the field which featured four three-pointers.

☆ The Mids outrebounded Morgan State by 27 (52-25) ... senior **Leonard Green** grabbed a season-high nine boards, while fellow senior **Matt Fannin** grabbed seven of his eight boards off the offensive glass.

☆ Navy owned a 20-7 advantage on second-chance points thanks to its 20-8 advantage on the offensive boards.

☆ Navy was held scoreless for the first 4:30, but went on a 20-2 run between 15:23 and 7:35 to open up a 20-9 lead which it would not relinquish.

☆ Freshman **Clif Colbert** turned in his third-straight double-figure scoring game by posting 12 points ... he was one-of-four Navy players to turn in double-digit scoring marks.

THREE GAMES, FIVE DAYS

Navy will play its final three games before the holidays over the course of five days. The Mids play host to Washington (Md.) College Sunday before traveling to the Northeast. Navy plays at Yale Tuesday at 7:00 pm and faces Brown Thursday at 6:00 pm.

COLBERT EARNS PATRIOT LEAGUE HONOR

Rookie **Clif Colbert** was named the Patriot League Rookie of the Week last Monday after averaging 14.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per game and leading the Midshipmen to a pair of wins.

Colbert was asked to take over the starting point guard position three games ago after **Corey Johnson** suffered a knee injury Nov. 27 against Air Force. Colbert led the Mids to their first victory of the season, an 82-73 win over Howard, at the BB&T Classic where he paced the Mids with 16 points and grabbed a career-high three steals. Three days later, Colbert dumped in 12 points and pulled down five boards in Navy's 26-point road victory over Morgan State.

MORE ON COLBERT

Freshman **Clif Colbert** played a combined 13 minutes in the first three games of the season which featured just a field goal. Since taking over the starting job Dec. 2 at Penn, the first-year player has averaged better than 30 minutes per game, while scoring 16.7 points and grabbing 4.7 rebounds per game. He has scored in double digits in each of his three starts and is the only Navy player to break the 20-point barrier this season, notching a career-high 22 at Penn in his first-collegiate start.

NATIONAL STATISTICS

The Mids are ranked among the top 100 (of 326 Div. I teams) in three statistical categories. Navy is 24th in rebound margin, outboarding its opponents by 8.3 thanks to a 27-rebound advantage over Morgan State Dec. 8. The Mids are No. 73 in three-point field goal percentage, shooting 38.0 (38 of 100) percent, and are 98th in free throw percentage, making 71.1 (91 of 128) percent of their attempts.

Sophomore guard **Greg Sprink** is second in the league and 11th nationally in free throw percentage, shooting 95.2 percent. Sprink has made 20 of his 21 free throws this year.

NAVY-WASHINGTON (MD.) COLLEGE SERIES

The Mids and Shoremen meet for the 13th time in series history with Navy holding a 10-2 advantage. The two teams played most of their games in the 1920s. The Shoremen won back-to-back contests in 1925 (26-23) and 1926 (20-19) before the two programs parted ways for 50 years. Navy and Washington (Md.) College faced each other during the 1975-76 and 1976-77 seasons before severing ties once again. Washington (Md.) College last played the Mids on Dec. 18, 2003, when Navy claimed a 95-66 win in Annapolis.

WHEN WE LAST MET ...

Navy shot 53.9 percent from the field, including 56.4 percent in the second half, to claim its second win of the season, a 95-66 victory over Div. III Washington College.

Navy took the lead early in the game, but a lay-up by Shoreman guard Kyle Stem gave them their first of just two leads in the game. Back-to-back buckets by Navy's Jeff Charles and Kwame Ofori put it back up by two, but a David Horvath triple gave the Shoremen the 13-12 advantage.

Navy went on a 15-6 run to take a 27-19 lead with seven minutes to play. After trading buckets the last three minutes, Navy took a 44-34 advantage into the locker room.

The Mids extended their lead to 21 with 9:32 to go in the game, and over the final five minutes, Navy outscored Washington College, 14-5.

Navy pounded the paint, as four Mids produced double-digit scoring marks, including Charles, who missed just three shots en route to a career-high tying 19-point effort. Charles was 9-for-11 from the field and 1-for-1 from long range. Freshman **Carlton Baldwin** scored a career-high 16 points and added 11 boards for his first-career double-double. Junior Laramie Mergerson came off the bench to score 12 points on 6-for-11 shooting, while pitching in five boards and a pair of blocks.

The Mids managed to record a whopping 32 turnovers, as the teams combined for 60 TOs. Navy out-boarded the Shoremen by 25 (56-31) and its 95 points marked the highest scoring output by the Mids since their 95-93 overtime victory at Colgate Jan. 19, 2002.

LANGE'S 50TH WIN

Second-year Navy head coach **Billy Lange** claimed his 50th-collegiate win on Dec. 8, leading the Midshipmen to a 73-47 win over Morgan State. Lange owns a four-year coaching record of 50-52, posting a 39-19 record in two seasons at the Merchant Marine Academy and a two-year 11-23 mark at Navy.

JOHNSON HAS SURGERY TO REPAIR KNEE

Navy starting guard **Corey Johnson** tore the meniscus in his left knee in the Mids' loss against Academy rival Air Force Nov. 27. After sitting out two games, Navy's leading scorer underwent surgery on Dec. 6 to repair the tear. It is uncertain as to when or if Johnson will return this season.

THE 70'S GAME

Over the last five years, Navy has scored 70-plus points just 39 times in 120 games (.325). In the last four seasons, the Mids have scored 70 points just 24 times in 90 games (.267). In 2003-04, Navy scored 70-plus points just four times, while last season, the Mids topped 70 points in 13 of the 28 contests. Navy has scored 70-plus points in three of the six games this season, including the last three.

CRASH THE BOARDS

Last season Navy was one of the top rebounding teams in the country, owning a +5.1 rebound margin and a No. 32 national rank. The Mids also paced the league with its 41.1 rebounds per game.

Despite losing two of its top four rebounders to graduation, Navy is right back at the top of the charts. The Mids are averaging 39.0 boards per game which is second in the league. Meanwhile, their +8.3 rebound margin is atop the league.

NAVY FOR THREE

Navy is second in the Patriot League in three-point shooting, connecting on 38.0 percent (38 for 100) of its triples. The Mids, meanwhile, have done a nice job defending the three, holding their foes to 27.6 percent shooting (29 for 105) from behind the arc. Navy is also the league's leader in three-point field goal percent defense.

Eighteen of Navy's threes have been made by freshmen, including a team-best nine by **Kaleo Kina**, who leads the league in three-point field goal percentage (.474). Teammate David Hooper owns the league's second-best percentage, hitting 47.1 percent of his triples.

HOOPER FROM LONG RANGE

Senior guard **David Hooper** hit at least one three-pointer in 23 of the 28 games last season, and has made a triple in 57 of the 81 games (.704) during his career.

After connecting on four of seven triples at Morgan State (12/8), Hooper is now tied with Michael Burd for sixth on the Mids' all-time three-point field goals list with 121. He trails fifth-place Erik Harris by just two triples, while he is 80 away from Michael Heary's school-record 201. He is one of only seven players in Academy history to make 100-career three-pointers. He accomplished this feat when he connected on a triple against Army in last year's Star Game.

PROTECT THE BALL

Navy turned the ball over a season-high 30 times against Howard (12/5), the most TOs by the Mids since their 72-67 loss to Lehigh (1/15/05) where Navy committed 25 turnovers.

Navy has turned the ball over 37 more times than its opponents this season and owns 56 more turnovers than assists. In turn, the Mids have been outscored 96-76 in points off turnovers. Each of the Mids' opponents have turned in double-figure points off turnovers, including a season-high 29 by Penn (12/2).

FRESHMEN MAKE A STATEMENT

Head coach Billy Lange has wasted little time in getting his freshmen playing time. The Class of '09 has produced 158 points, 40.6 percent of the Mids' offense, and is averaging 26.3 points per game.

The freshmen had a sensational night at Penn (12/2), where the rookies scored a season-best 39 points, better than half of the Mids' 76 points.

Four of the five freshmen have made starts this season, including **Clif Colbert**, **Kaleo Kina** and **Adam Teague** who have been in the starting lineup in each of the last three contests.

PLAYING WITH PANIC, NOT YOUR HANDS

Senior captain **Matt Fannin** has fouled out of three of the six games this season, thus limiting his time on the court. Last season, he led the Mids in scoring and rebounding, but this season he has found it difficult to get into a rhythm because of his foul trouble. That said, Fannin is leading the Mids in rebounding, grabbing 6.8 boards per game, while scoring 8.0 points a contest.

SPRINK RETURNS TO FORM

2005 Patriot League All-Rookie Team member **Greg Sprink** came to life at Penn (12/2) after struggling against UALR (11/22) and Air Force (11/27) where he scored a combined three points. In the last three games, Sprink has averaged 12.7 points, 6.3 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game.

SPECIAL K

Freshman guard **Kaleo Kina** is Navy's fourth-leading scorer, averaging in 8.3 points a game, while pacing the team in assists (3.0 apg). In the Mids' nine-point loss to Academy rival Air Force (11/27), Kina led Navy in scoring (14), rebounding (5) and assists (4) in his first-collegiate start. He played 38 minutes against the Falcons. At Penn (12/2), Kina dealt out a season-high six assists. He currently leads the Patriot League in three-point field goal percentage, knocking down 47.4 percent of his triples.

ALUMNI HALL: HOME OF THE MIDSHIPMEN

The Mids have traditionally been known as a strong home court team. Navy was 15-2 at Alumni Hall during the 2000-01 campaign, winning 15 in a row while boasting a 6-0 league mark at home. But recently Navy has struggled to defend its home court. Last season marked the first time since the 2000-01 season (5-1), in which Navy secured a winning home record in Patriot League action, posting a 4-3 record.

Since opening its doors for the 1991-92 season, Navy has produced a 124-69 (.642) record in Alumni Hall. Against Patriot League foes, the Mids are 55-33 (.625).

QUICK RECOVERY

Junior forward **Carlton Baldwin** made a quick recovery after breaking his right ankle the weekend of Sept. 24-25. The two-year letterwinner had surgery on Sept. 26 and was expected to be out two months. He returned to practice on Nov. 3, roughly six weeks after his surgery and was in the starting lineup in the Mids' season opener.

It's the second-straight year in which Baldwin has suffered a preseason injury. In September of 2004, he fractured a toe in his left foot and was so severe, the doctors estimated three to six months of recovery time. Baldwin missed just the first-three games of the season.

SKED IS TOUGH TASK FOR MIDS

Navy has opened the 2005-06 with one of the tougher schedules in recent memory. Here are a few facts you should know about Navy's first four opponents — Georgetown, UALR, Air Force, Penn. ☆ The four teams own a combined 21-10 (.677) record this season, including Air Force with a 9-1 (.900) mark ... last year, the four teams produced a 75-44 (.630) mark.

☆ Last season, Georgetown earned an NIT berth and lost to eventual NIT winner South Carolina in the quarterfinals by three ... the Hoyas returned all five starters from that team, including Big East Rookie of the Year Jeff Green and All-East selection Brandon Bowman.

☆ UALR has won back-to-back Sun Belt Conference East Division titles ... Navy went on the road to play the Trojans where under Steve Shields, UALR owned a 25-3 record at home and last year posted a 13-1 home record ... the Trojans lost to 14th-ranked Michigan State by five Dec. 3.

☆ Air Force has turned its program around, reaching double digit wins in the last three seasons, including a 22-7 season in 2003-04 in which the Falcons reached the NCAA Tournament ... last season's team turned in an 18-12 record and finished third in the Mountain West.

☆ Penn has won the Ivy League title five times in the last seven years, including two of the last three ... in the last four years, the Quakers have reached 20-plus wins three times and in 2003-04, Penn posted 17 wins.

THE YOUNG AND THE RESTLESS

Second-year head coach Billy Lange is one of the youngest Div. I men's basketball coaches in the country. Former Indiana University standout and first-year IPFW mentor Dane Fife is the youngest coach at 26 years old. Lange is the sixth-youngest coach among 326 Div. I programs. The oldest you ask? Temple's John Chaney is 73 years old and will turn 74 on Jan. 21.

THE NATION'S FUTURE LEADERS

Three of Navy's four seniors recently received their service assignments for which they will fulfill upon graduation. **Kelvin Boatner** and **David Hooper** will pursue careers as surface warfare officers aboard a ship and team captain **Matt Fannin** will serve as a naval flight officer, the backseater in an aircraft. **Leonard Green** is still awaiting his assignment.

NATIONALLY KNOWN

Navy's 16 varsity players represent 12 different states — Arizona, California (2), Colorado, Indiana (2), Kansas, Maryland, North Carolina (2), Ohio, Oregon, Texas, Virginia (2) and Washington.

OVERCOMING DEFICITS

The Mids overcame a nine-point halftime deficit in their win over Howard by opening the second half on a 16-0 run. It's the largest halftime deficit Navy has overcome since March 1, 2003, when the Mids trailed Army, 28-19, at the half before claiming the N-Star with a 62-56 win.

JOHNSON MAKES THE MARK

Second-year guard **Corey Johnson** eclipsed the 300-point plateau in Navy's loss to Air Force (11/27) after he, along with rookie teammate **Kaleo Kina**, led the Mids with 14 points apiece. Johnson led Navy in scoring (tied for lead in two games) in each of the first three games this season and is the only Mid to average double digits in the scoring column (14.7 ppg). He owns Navy's longest current consecutive games scored streak, producing points in 31-straight games.

Johnson also reached 60 steals for his career in the loss to the Falcons, swiping a team-best three passes. The two-year starter needs five assists to reach the century mark.

NAVY PICKED SIXTH IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

After finishing last season tied with Lafayette for sixth place, the Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors have picked Navy to finish sixth according to the 2005-06 Preseason Patriot League Men's Basketball Poll.

Behind the play of Patriot League preseason all-league pick Charles Lee and Preseason Player of the Year Chris McNaughton, Bucknell picked up 14 of the 16 first-place votes to pace the field, while Holy Cross, who won the regular-season title a year ago, accounted for the final two first-place votes and is picked to finish second.

ELITE EIGHT ANNIVERSARY

This year marks the 20th anniversary of the 1985-86 team's memorable run in the NCAA Tournament. Led by All-American David Robinson, the Mids disposed of Tulsa, Syracuse and Cleveland State before dropping a 71-50 decision to top-ranked Duke in the Elite Eight. Navy will welcome back the 1985-86 Elite Eight team on Jan. 7 to recognize their accomplishments.

NAVY TO NAME BASKETBALL COURT IN HONOR OF DAVE SMALLEY

Navy will name its basketball court at Alumni Hall after Dave Smalley, who has been associated with the Academy as a player, coach, physical education professor and administrator for more than 50 years. The official dedication ceremony will be held on Saturday, Jan. 7, when the Navy men's and women's teams play host to Patriot League rival Bucknell.

A 1957 graduate of the Naval Academy, Smalley won a combined six letters in basketball and baseball, while earning four N-Stars against arch rival Army. He is one of only four midshipmen in the 99-year history of Navy men's basketball to serve as team captain for two-consecutive years. He was the Mids' top scorer during his sophomore and senior campaigns, while leading the team in free throw percentage as a junior and senior. He was also selected to play in the East-West All-Star Game in Kansas City his senior year.

Smalley scored 856 points during his three-year varsity career and twice won the Charles Evans McDonough Memorial Basketball Cup, awarded annually "to the member of the basketball squad deemed to have been the outstanding team player during the season."

Smalley was also a standout outfielder for the Navy baseball team. He won the Blair Bat, symbolic of the Eastern Intercollegiate Baseball League batting title, during his junior season with a league average of .419. He also led the league in RBIs with 12. In overall games that season, he led the squad in hits (30), homers (3), RBIs (25) and batting average (.448).

Smalley won the Naval Academy Athletic Association Sword in 1957 as the midshipman of the graduating class who was considered "to have personally excelled in athletics during his years of varsity competition."

A native of Baltimore, Md., Smalley served five years in the United States Marine Corps, where he was named to the All-Marine Basketball Team four years.

In 1962, Smalley returned to the Academy as an assistant coach with the men's basketball team and as a member of the Physical Education Department. In 1966, Smalley succeeded Ben Carnevale as head coach of the Navy basketball

team. Under his 10-year direction, Navy produced a 94-130 record and his Midshipmen teams were ranked among the top 10 in the country in team defense in three of his last six seasons.

In 1976, Smalley left his post as the men's coach and later that year was asked to lay the groundwork for a women's basketball program. His first season leading the women, competing at the junior varsity level, he led the Mids to a 10-1 record and won the Maryland AIAW state championship for small colleges. The program achieved varsity status in 1977, and he guided the Midshipmen to a 12-year combined record of 179-119 that featured 10 winning seasons. Smalley's teams recorded back-to-back 18-win seasons in 1981-82 and 1982-83, and the 1986-87 team finished 18-8 and captured the ECAC South Division II Championship.

Smalley held the title of Assistant Director of Athletics in charge of admissions since 1979 and was promoted to Senior Associate Athletic Director for Admissions, Academics and Compliance in 2001. In that capacity, Smalley handles the admissions process for recruited athletes in each of Navy's 30 varsity sports. Smalley and his staff also monitor the academic progress of Navy's 1500 student-athletes.

ROUGH STARTS

For just the third time in its 99-year history, Navy started its season 0-4. It's the third time in the last 14 seasons in which the Mids have gotten off to an 0-4 start.

☆ In Don DeVoe's first season as head coach (1992-93), the Mids lost their first five games before edging out Eastern Washington, 57-56, in a neutral site contest.

☆ In DeVoe's final season (2003-04), the Mids fell to 0-5 before squeaking out a 61-60 win over Gettysburg.

NAVY IN SEASON OPENERS

Navy is now 74-25 (.747) in season openers after a 72-49 loss to Georgetown last Friday in Annapolis.

Navy has won just two of its last nine and four of its last 11 season openers. In the last 11 years, Navy has opened at home just five times, including three times in the last eight years. Navy owns a 4-1 record in openers played in Annapolis over the last 11 seasons.

NAVY HEAD COACH BILLY LANGE

The 2004-05 campaign was the beginning of a new era for Navy basketball with first-year head coach Billy Lange at the helm. One that preached a commitment and the restoration of a tradition that has bled Blue and Gold for years.

With the new outlook came a new style of play, a new attitude — an aggressive, fast-paced, in-your-face, sense of panic which was welcomed not only by the team, but by Navy's faithful fans.

2004-05 NAVY HIGHLIGHTS

☆ Finished 9-19, winning four more games than in 2003-04 ... Navy's five conference wins were the most since the 2001-02 team owned a 5-9 league record.

☆ Won five of their last 10 games, including a 66-62 victory over Patriot League Tournament champion Bucknell, who defeated Kansas in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

☆ Finished 2004-05 ranked among the country's top 50 in rebound margin (32nd, +5.1) and steals (34th, 8.9 spg).

☆ Finished the 2004-05 campaign ranked No. 1 in the Patriot League in four statistical categories (overall games) — scoring offense, rebounding offense (41.1), offensive rebounds (16.11) and rebounding margin (+5.1).

☆ Displayed a +13.5 scoring gain over the previous season, while averaging just under six rebounds a game more than the 2003-04 campaign.

☆ In league games, paced the conference in rebounding offense (42.4) and offensive rebounds (17.14).

☆ Finished the season by setting three school records for Patriot League action — three-point field goals made (99), three-point field goals attempted (297) and rebounds (593).

☆ Helped mold **Corey Johnson** and **Greg Sprink** into Patriot League All-Rookie Team members ... the duo made Academy history as Johnson and Sprink became the first tandem to score 200 points each in their plebe season.

ADDITIONAL COACHING HIGHLIGHTS

☆ Part of a staff which led Villanova to three-straight appearances in the National Invitational Tournament, including the quarterfinals in 2004.

☆ Led the Merchant Marine Academy to two Skyline Conference crowns and a berth in the 2001 NCAA Division III Sweet 16.

☆ Named the New York Metropolitan Basketball Writers Division III Coach of the Year in 2001.

☆ In his first and only season as the head coach at Bishop Eustace, taking over for his father, Bill Sr., who was in a life-threatening accident just one week into the season, Lange led the team to a 20-6 record and an appearance in the state New Jersey State Championship game.
