ANACONDA PLAYER OF THE WEEK (JAN. 5-11)

KALEO KINA, NAVY Sr., G, 6'4, 210, Phoenix, Ariz./Trevor Browne

Kina ties a Patriot League single-season record with his fourth Anaconda Player of the Week honor after leading the Mids to a pair of victories last week, including a 71-67 triumph over Bucknell in their League opener. He scored 25 points against the Bison while also dishing out four assists. Kina scored six points in the final three minutes of the game, hitting a three-pointer to put Navy up, 61-56, with 2:27 left and icing the game with a foul shot with five seconds remaining. It was the eighth 20-point game of the season for Kina, who ranks 33rd nationally and leads the Patriot League with 19.6 points per game this year. He also became the 33rd player in Patriot League history to score 1,300 career points. Kina had 13 points in Navy's 66-62 win at Elon on Monday. He scored four straight points to tie the score at 58 with 3:08 left. Kina averaged 19 points, 2.5 assists and two rebounds in the pair of Navy victories. He has scored in double figures in every game this season, and in 19 consecutive contests overall. It is the longest double-figure scoring streak for a Navy player since Chris Williams (2000-01 season) had 21 straight double-figure games. Kina becomes the seventh student-athlete to earn four Player of the Week honors in a season. It is the third consecutive season that a player has earned four Player of the Week awards (Keith Simmons, Holy Cross (2006-07); Jarell Brown, Army (2007-08). Michael Heary (1996-97) was the only other Navy player to accomplish the feat. Kina earlier became the fifth Patriot Leaguer with three consecutive Player of the Week honors when he received the award on Dec. 1, 8 and 15.



ANACONDA ROOKIE OF THE WEEK (JAN. 5-11)

JULIAN SIMMONS, ARMY Fr., G, 6'0, 185, Katy, Texas/Cinco Ranch (USMAPS)

Simmons earns his second Patriot League/Anaconda Rookie of the Week award after leading the way for Army in each of its contests last week. He was the only Army player to score in double figures in losses against Fairfield and Colgate, averaging 16 points over the two games. Simmons notched a career-high 19 points in Tuesday's loss against Fairfield, connecting on four three-pointers and also pulling down a career-high four rebounds. The 19-point effort was the top scoring game by an Army freshman since the 2006-07 season. Simmons followed that up with a 13-point effort in Army's loss to Colgate on Saturday. Simmons has scored in double figures three straight times and is second on the team with five double-digit games this season. He is averaging 15.7 points per game in his three starts. He joins Holy Cross' R.J. Evans and Bucknell's Bryan Cohen as multiple winners of the Rookie of the Week award this season.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

IT'S WINNERS AGAINST LOSERS ON WEDNESDAY

Teams that won their Patriot League opener will square off against squads that dropped their first League game in each of Wednesday's four League contests. Navy, Colgate and Holy Cross will all try to go to 2-0 in League play with a road contest, as the Mids are at Lehigh, the Raiders go to Lafayette and the Crusaders visit Army with each of the home squads in search of their first League win. Defending Patriot League champion American tries to start 2-0 in League action when it plays host to Bucknell.

PATRIOT LEAGUE SCHEDULE OFF AND RUNNING

An overtime contest between the top two teams in the Patriot League men's basketball preseason poll highlighted the first set of League contests on Saturday. American opened its quest for a repeat title with a 76-66 overtime home win over Lehigh, which rallied from a 10-point deficit to force the extra session. Navy and Holy Cross also opened League play with home wins, with the Mids knocking off Bucknell, 71-67, and the Crusaders topping Lafayette, 81-67. Colgate was the only team to open with a victory on the road, defeating Army, 64-42.

PATRIOT LEAGUE BACK ON ESPNU

Saturday's Bucknell-Navy game brought Patriot League play back to ESPNU, with five more regular season games still yet to come. Bucknell returns to the network on Saturday, as the Bison host Holy Cross at Noon in the League's second ESPNU appearance. Future Patriot League games on ESPNU include: American at Holy Cross, Jan. 24; Navy at Army, Jan. 25; Colgate at American, Feb. 14; and Lafayette at Lehigh, Feb. 22. The Leopards and Mountain Hawks will each have this Wednesday's games televised on regional outlets.

2-0 NOT AN EASY ACCOMPLISHMENT

None of the four teams in search of a 2-0 League record on Wednesday hit the mark last season, and three of the four have not opened with two League wins in quite some time. Colgate has the longest drought, as the Raiders have not started League play at 2-0 since 1999. Navy has not won its first two League games since 2001, which was also the last season it had opened with a victory until Saturday's triumph. American is trying to start 2-0 for the first time since 2004 (excluding a 2-0 start in 2005 from a game later forfeited by Lehigh). Holy Cross goes in search of two wins to open the League schedule for the third time in the last four years.

NAVY EXTENDS PERFECT HOME RECORD

Navy continued its winning ways at home on Saturday against Bucknell, moving to 8-0 on its home court this season. The eight-game streak is the fourth-longest home winning streak in Alumni Hall history, behind a 16-game streak in 1999-2000 and a pair of nine-game streaks. The Mids completed a 7-0 mark in their non-League home schedule with a 75-70 victory over Wofford on Jan. 2. It was Navy's first ever perfect non-League home mark, and the Mids have won nine consecutive non-League home games overall.

THREE PATRIOT LEAGUE TEAMS AMONG NATION'S BEST ON ROAD

Only 22 Division I teams have recorded five or more road victories this season, and three of those squads reside in the Patriot League. Lehigh (5-3), American (5-5) and Colgate (5-5) have each notched five victories on the road, just one off the Division I lead of six road wins held by seven teams. The Raiders have a chance to join the group with six road wins when they visit Lafayette on Wednesday. The Patriot League and Atlantic 10 are the only two conferences in the nation where three different teams have at least five road victories this season. Colgate and American are two of 30 teams in the country that have already played 10 or more road games, a group Bucknell will join when it visits American on Wednesday.

PATRIOT LEAGUE NOTEBOOK

WEST COAST BIAS

The Patriot League is firmly cemented in the Eastern part of the United States, but a group of players from well outside the region are making sure the Western influence is felt throughout the League. Four of the League's top five scorers come from the Western part of the country, with Navy's Kaleo Kina (Arizona) in first at 19.6 points per game, American's Garrison Carr (Washington) next at 17.9 per game and Lafayette's Andrew Brown (Colorado) and Lehigh's Marquis Hall (Oregon) tied for fourth with 14.4 points per game.

CHECKING UP ON THE CAREER LISTS

In addition to this season's scoring outburst, the quartet from the west is also carving out impressive numbers in the Patriot League career record book. Kina, Brown and Carr are the top three active career scorers in the Patriot League, and have all joined the League's 1,000-point club. Kina and Brown are both over 1,200 points, with Kina holding the top mark among active players with 1,300 career points. He became the 33rd Patriot Leaguer with at least 1,300 career points on Saturday against Bucknell. American's Derrick Mercer is the final active member with 1,000 points, and leads all active players and places in a tie for eighth in League annals with 435 career assists. Hall is next among active players with 333 career assists, with Kina and Brown right behind to join Mercer as players with more than 1,000 points and 300 assists. Colgate's Alex Woodhouse is 10th with 142 career blocks, while Kina is tied for 17th with 161 steals. Brown and Carr both have impressive standing in the three-point career leaderboard. Brown is sixth all-time with 259 three-pointers. Carr's 241 three-pointers are ninth in Patriot League annals, and his 41.1 three-point percentage is fourth in League history.

NAVY, LEHIGH ENTER LEAGUE PLAY WITH DOUBLE-DIGIT WINS

Navy and Lehigh both finished impressive non-League campaigns with double-digit victories. The Mids have won 11 non-League contests for just the third time as a Patriot League member, doing so in back-to-back years in 1998-99 and 1999-00. Lehigh set school records with 10 non-League victories and five non-League road wins. No team had double-digit victories before Patriot League play last season, though Holy Cross did record a 10th non-League win later in the year.

THIS AND THAT

Lehigh's Matt Szalachowski is one of 30 candidates for the 2008-09 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, presented to a student-athlete based on classroom, character, community and competition...American's Derrick Mercer and Garrison Carr are the first set of Eagle teammates to both have over 1,000 career points in the same season since 1996...Army has already had 12 different players score in double figures this season...Navy senior guard Kaleo Kina became the fifth student-athlete in Patriot League history to earn three consecutive Player of the Week awards on Dec. 15. Kina was also one of four finalists for CollegeHoops.net Mid-Major Player of the Week honors on the same week...Lehigh junior guard Marquis Hall is on the nominee list for the Bob Cousy Award, presented to the top guard in college basketball...After posting a 2-1 record from Dec. 1-7, Navy was honored as the Mid-Major Team of the Week by Jeff Goodman in the FoxSports.com Weekly Wrap. The Mids had improved to 7-2 at the time...Navy has the best single-game shooting performance in the nation. The Mids' connected on 71.4 percent of their shots (25-for-35) in a 78-65 win over UT-San Antonio on Dec. 2....Lehigh's 76-71 win over Rutgers on Nov. 26 was the first for the Mountain Hawks against a Big East team in their Patriot League history, and first for the Patriot League against the Big East since 2005.

47 PATRIOT LEAGUE GAMES SET FOR BROADCAST TV

The eight Patriot League men's basketball teams have a combined 47 games on broadcast television. The television schedule is highlighted by the Patriot League's contract with the ESPN Networks. Six Patriot League men's basketball regular season games will be shown on ESPNU via the League's package. The Patriot League Men's Basketball Championship will be shown on ESPN2 at 4:45 p.m. on March 13. The men's television slate features 18 non-League games and 29 League contests, with games on ESPNU, Comcast Sports Net and the Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN) in the non-League action.

2009 PATRIOT LEAGUE TOURNAMENT

The Patriot League Tournament will once again be played on campus sites. The quarterfinal round is set for March 4, the semifinals will take place on March 8 and the Patriot League Championship will be decided on Friday, March 13 at 4:45 p.m. on ESPN2.

Navy tries to open Patriot League play with a 2-0 mark for the first time since 2001 when it travels to Lehigh on Wednesday...The Mountain Hawks are trying to avoid a second consecutive 0-2 record in the League...Navy has won the last three meetings in the series, including the last two in Bethlehem by five points apiece...All three of those victories are by 10 points or less, with an 80-75 win at Lehigh in the teams last meeting on Feb. 13, 2008...The Mids hold a 23-11 advantage over the Mountain Hawks in Patriot League regular season games, and a 42-15 mark in the all-time series.

NAVY Navy earned its fourth consecutive victory overall and moved its perfect home record to 8-0 with a 71-67 win over Bucknell in the Patriot League opener for both schools on Saturday...The Mids snapped a seven-game losing streak in League openers, winning their initial League contest for the first time since 2001...Navy has won two of the last three meetings against Bucknell, with each contest held in Annapolis...Bucknell had won seven straight in the series before that stretch...Kaleo Kina led Navy with 25 points, including some big plays down the stretch...He hit a three-pointer to give the Mids a 61-56 lead with 2:27 left, and sealed the four-point win with a foul shot with five seconds remaining...It was his eighth 20-point game of the season, and 19th straight game in double figures scoring going back to last season...Kina is at 1,300 points for his career, the 33rd Patriot Leaguer to reach that number...Adam Teague also made two huge threes for the Mids, as Navy held off a late Bucknell rally that had cut a nine-point lead to one...Navy hit its final three three-pointers after making just 3-of-22 before that point...The eight-game home winning streak is the fourth-longest home winning streak in Alumni Hall history, behind a 16-game streak in 1999-2000 and a pair of nine-game streaks...Navy improved to 7-1 in games decided by five points or less, winning each of last week's games by four (66-62 at Elon on Monday)...Navy's current starting lineup of O.J. Avworo, Chris Harris, Kaleo Kina, Adam Teague and Mark Veazey has posted an 8-0 record this year...The Mids improved to 12-4 overall after previously matching the 1998-99 and 1999-00 teams for the most non-League wins since joining the Patriot League with 11.



LEHIGH Lehigh rallied from a 10-point second-half deficit to force overtime at American, but was outscored, 12-2, in the extra session and fell to the Eagles, 76-66, in its Patriot League opener on Saturday...It was Lehigh's third straight loss against American...The Mountain Hawks were down, 60-50, with 5:51 left, but came all the way back to send the game to overtime on a three-pointer by Marquis Hall with 27 seconds left...Zahir Carrington led the Lehigh offense with 19 points and 11 rebounds, his second consecutive double-double...Carrington leads all Patriot League players with four double-doubles this season, and has five for his career...Hit hit 8-of-10 foul shots in the game...Hall chipped in with 14 points, connecting on 4-of-6 three-pointers, and also dished out six assists...The teams opened the League schedule against each other for the fifth year in a row...The Mountain Hawks recorded a school record for non-League wins (10) and non-League road wins (five) this season...Lehigh will try to earn its fourth consecutive home victory and snap a brief two-game losing skid on Wednesday.

Colgate and Lafayette meet in Easton on Wednesday, with the Raiders looking to run their League record to 2-0 for the first time since 1999...Lafayette is trying to avoid its first 0-2 start since 2001...The teams played three competitive games last season, with each contest decided by two points or less...Colgate won the last two meetings, with a 76-75 win at Lafayette on Feb. 13 and a 76-74 victory at home in the Patriot League quarterfinals on March 5...The Leopards scored a 69-68 overtime win on Jan. 16 of last season at Colgate, and have won in each of the last three seasons when the teams squared off in the second League contest of the year...Colgate has won the last two and three of the last four games at Lafayette, with each Raider win decided by three points or less...The Raiders have a 44-37 advantage in the all-time series, including 26-10 in Patriot League regular season games.

COLGATE Colgate earned its second consecutive victory and opened Patriot League play with a win over Army for the fifth straight year with a 64-42 triumph over the Black Knights at West Point on Saturday...Colgate has won eight of the last nine meetings between the schools, and took a 52-51 lead in the all-time series...Colgate has a 31-6 edge against the Black Knights in Patriot League regular-season play...The Raiders improved to 3-4 on their eight-game road trip, which ends Wednesday at Lafayette...Colgate is 5-5 on the road this season...The Raiders used an early 8-0 run to take an eight-point lead, and held Army to just two field goals in the final 13:16 of the first half to take a 37-22 lead at the break...Colgate scored the first five points of the second half to go up by 20, and led by as many as 25...Freshman Yaw Gyawu topped the Colgate offense with 15 points along with a career-high six rebounds...The 15 points came in only 19 minutes of action...Mike Venezia had 10, while Alex Woodhouse had eight points and seven rebounds...Woodhouse scored his 500th point in the game, and now has 501...Freshman Nick Pascale matched Woodhouse in boards with a career-high seven...Colgate shot 52 percent from the field, and limited Army to 27 percent...The Raiders held a 43-28 advantage on the boards...Colgate concludes its eight-game road trip on Wednesday, and will try to join seven other teams that lead Division I with six road wins (as of Monday).



LAFAYETTE The Leopards fell for the third consecutive time with an 81-67 loss at Holy Cross in their Patriot League opener on Saturday...Lafayette lost its sixth straight trip to the Hart Center...The Leopards were down 12 at the break, but came back to cut the deficit to 44-40 with 12 minutes left before the Crusaders built the lead back to double digits...Jeff Kari led Lafayette with 16 points, while freshman Ryan Willen scored 13 points in his first career start...Willen was coming off scoring a career-high 17 points against Penn on Tuesday...He sank 16 consecutive free throws over a seven-game stretch, including five against Holy Cross, before missing his final free throw to finish 5-for-6 in the game...The Leopards connected on 13-of-16 shots at the foul line...Marek Koltun scored a career-high eight points, all in the first half...Lafayette opens a two-game homestand against Colgate on Wednesday, followed by Navy on Saturday...The Leopards are 3-4 at home this season.
