## EXTENDED POSITION CAMPS TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION

Free transportation to and from the BWI airport/ Amtrak station for the Extended Positions is provided to all campers. To assist in your travel reservations please note our pick up times. Camp staff members will be present in the airport from 7:30 – 10:30AM on the first day of each camp. For those campers flying in from the West or other fringe areas, you may fly in the night before camp starts and we will pick you up at the airport. There is an additional fee of \$55 for this service. The fee covers the extra transportation, extra night in the dorm, supervision, dinner, and breakfast. A travel form will be sent in their confirmation packet or, you may register on-line and fillout and update the travel form when ever you like

- Update and change your son's travel arrangements to and from camp instantly

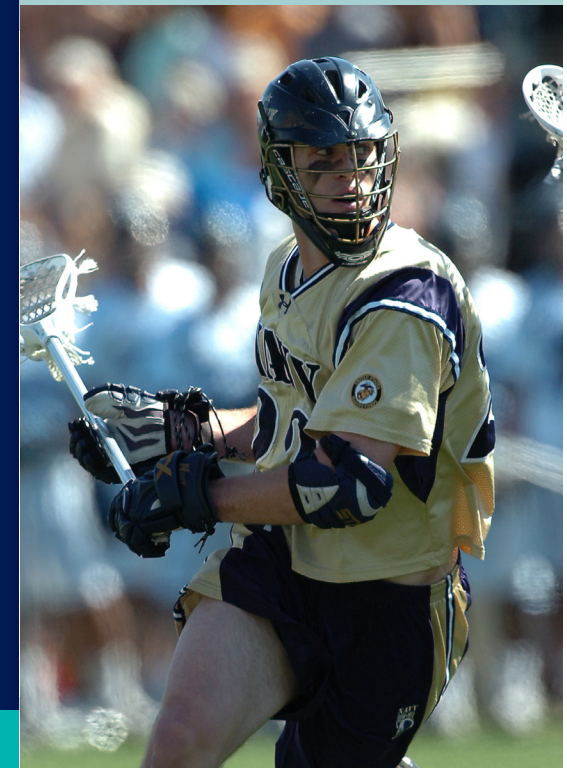

## CAMP DETAILS

Our most popular camps! This is an intensive camp that offers a ton of lacrosse- up to four sessions a day with constant action. Campers are taught the skills needed to advance to the next level. They are separated by age and skill level to ensure they are properly challenged. Campers sleep in Bancroft Hall and eat in King Hall with the midshipmen.

**Eligibility:** The clinic is open to boys ages 10-18. Campers will be separated by age and ability to maximize their education.

**Location:** The camp will be held entirely at the United States Naval Academy.

**Coach to camper ratio:** The clinic will offer a camper to coach ratio of 6 to 1. One of the best ratios available in any camp. This low ratio will maximize their positive experience.

**Registration:** Detach and mail in the registration form with payment. You will receive additional information via e-mail. If you register on-line you will be able to pick your team and room number. *NOTE: if you register by mail you will not be able to pick your room or team.* Check-in will begin on the first day of each camp at 8:00AM- 10:00AM in the NAVY-MARINE CORPS MEMORIAL STADIUM (1953 Pavilion).
