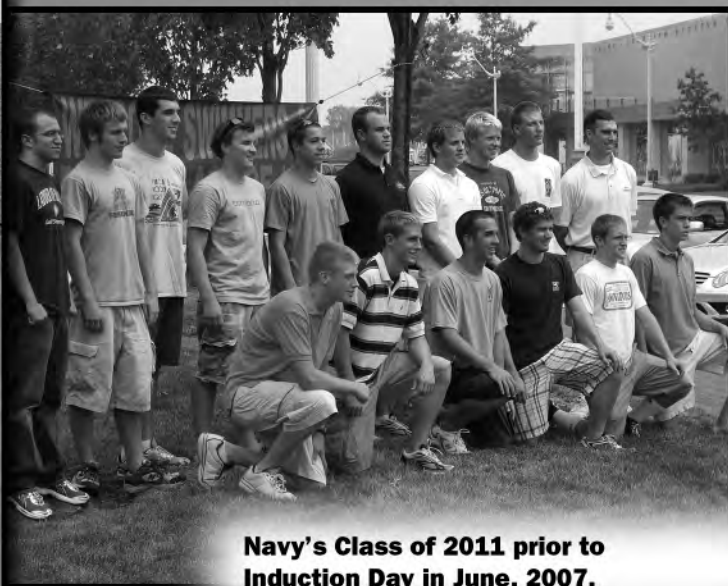

2007-08 MEN'S SEASON OUTLOOK

2007-08 NAVY SWIMMING & DIVING

Overall Comments

The Navy men's swimming and diving program enters the 2007-08 season looking to not only extend its success from the last few years, but also set new standards for the program.

Among the successes the program is looking to replicate from past seasons is winning its fifth Patriot League title in as many seasons, reach double figures in regular season victories for the fourth-straight year and defeat Army for the 17th consecutive campaign.

Additionally, Navy will try to place among the top-four teams at the Eastern Intercollegiate Swimming League Championship for the first time since the 2000 meet.

"We have similar team goals each year," said men's swimming head coach Bill Roberts. "From there, we aim to do things a little better than before. If we can continue to improve in our technique, our strength in the water and our overall conditioning, we can expect to be competitive in reaching our stated goals."

The Mids lost a number of standout athletes when the Class of 2007 received their commissions last May, including backstroke record-holder Kevin Mukri and all-league diver Kevin Teague, but the majority of their key competitors from last season return again this year.

"Even more so than last year, we return a very balanced group of upperclass team members," said Roberts. "Leading the way has to be our Class of 2008 which includes several athletes who have been a part of our core group of scorers over the past three seasons."

Even with the large number of returning athletes, the Mids will look towards its newcomers to provide an immediate impact on the team.

"The class of 2011 has tremendous potential," said Roberts. "Though it will take some time for them to develop into the athletes we feel they eventually will be, I have been nothing but impressed with their desire to work hard while at Navy."

Kevin Mukri concluded his Navy career last year by setting the school standards in both backstroke events, placing second in both events at the EISL Meet and attaining a 2008 Olympic Trials qualifying time in the 100 back. In his absence, Billy Vey and Danny Mizelle will be looked upon to fill the large void Mukri left behind.

Vey is the second-fastest 200 back swimmer in Navy history, as well as the third-fastest 100 back artist. Mizelle, meanwhile, placed among the top-three swimmers in over half of his regular season races last year.

"With the loss of Kevin to graduation, we will find ourselves in an entirely new position during competition," said Roberts. "He was a virtual lock to both win his events as well as lead off the relays. Though we do not have an immediate replacement, we do have several returners who have proven themselves over the past few seasons."

Adam Meyer, Kevin Kysiak and Ari Molina are expected to headline Navy's breaststroke swimmers this season. Meyer placed ninth in the 200 breast at last year's EISL Championship, Kysiak placed third in the 100 breast at the Eastern meet, and Molina won the Patriot League title in the 100 breast and placed 10th in the 200 breast at the EISL Meet.

"This year the Navy breaststroke crew is as talented as it has been in recent years," said Roberts. "They are a strong training group that has improved dramatically over the last few seasons through their work ethic and determination. They will be counted on each meet to score big against Navy's opponents."

"The group is being led by Kevin and Mike, who both bring a wealth of championship experience with them to the event. Following their lead will be Ari in the 100 and Adam in the 200, as well as Andrew and Alex. We expect the newcomers to the squad to have a sharp learning curve as they grow into immediate impact roles at the conference meets."

Navy's butterfly corps returns pretty much intact from last season. Tyler Hill is the Navy record holder in the 200 fly, an event he placed second in at the 2007 Patriot League Meet. He also won the 100 fly event at the championship, while Lascara reached the finals in both events at the Patriot League Meet and scored points in the 200 fly at the EISL Championship.

Adam Meyer, meanwhile, placed among the top-three swimmers in six of his nine 200 fly races during the 2006-07 regular season.

"With everyone returning, Navy's butterfly swimmers should continue to improve on their overall competitiveness in these events," said Roberts.

"With the graduation of Kevin, we expect to see four qualified divers who can compete for the win on any given weekend," said Navy diving coach Joe Suriano. "At this time I do not know who will be our best male diver this year, nor do I know what the order of finish will be. All four men are very strong, very talented and capable of qualifying for the NCAA Championship."
