Patriot League Pre-Season Poll

The Patriot League's coaches and sports information directors gave Navy the nod as the favorite to win the 2014 Patriot League title. The Mids garnered 14 of a possible 18 first-place votes in the league (voters were not allowed to cast ballots for their own school), as well as a league-best 157 points.

Strong NCAA Tournament Showing Again

Navy acquainted itself well on the national stage once again by its performance in the first round of the 2013 NCAA Tournament.

The 15th-seeded Mids led second-seeded and No. 7 ranked Kentucky the majority of the first half before heading into the locker rooms at the break with a 26-25 advantage. It is the first time in over two decades in which a Patriot League team either held the lead or was tied at halftime of an NCAA Tournament game.

The Mids trailed DePaul by three points (24-21) and Maryland by eight points (31-23) at halftime of their two previous NCAA Tournament games.

Patriot League in the NCAA Tournament

Patriot League teams have lost 21 consecutive games in the NCAA Tournament. However, Navy has played the three closest games by a league team over this span of over two decades.

Additionally, the average margin of defeat for Patriot League teams — not including Navy's three appearances — is 34.9 points a game, with the margin being 39.0 points a game over the six years prior to Navy's initial 2011 appearance. Conversely, Navy's three defeats were by a combined 48 points and an average of 16.0 points a game.

Three-Straight Tourney Titles

Navy capped its 2012-13 season by winning the program's third Patriot League Tournament title. That run of three-consecutive titles is one shy of the league record held by Holy Cross.

Navy Under Pempfer in PLT (Part 1)

Head coach Stefanie Pempfer has guided the Mids to 11 victories in the Patriot League Tournament. That is more wins than Navy had posted in its first 17 years as a member of the league.

2012-13 Patriot League Co-Champions

Navy compiled an 11-3 record in the Patriot League during the 2012-13 season to share the regular season crown. It marked the second time in three years (2011) and the third time in school history (1998) in which Navy earned a share of the regular season title.
