Credentials

Postgame Interviews

The Navy locker room is closed at all times, both at home and on the road. Postgame interviews at home games will be conducted in the interview room, across from the visitor's locker room in Alumni Hall, while interviews on the road will be conducted either outside of the Navy locker room or else in a designated media area at the arena.

The postgame interview session will begin 10 minutes following the conclusion of the game.

Wireless internet is available to media in Alumni Hall for Navy home games. Please contact a member of the Navy sports information office for the password to access the wireless system.

In addition, a limited number of direct internet jacks are available for use in Alumni Hall.

Broadcast Information**Radio / Internet**

A total of 11 Navy women's basketball regular season games will be carried on the radio by WNAV-AM 1430 and its corresponding web site www.wnav.com(.)

In addition to the regular season slate of games, all Navy postseason games will be carried live by the network.

All broadcasts begin 15 minutes prior to tip with the Navy Pregame Show featuring an interview with Navy head coach Tom Marryott. The Navy Postgame Show, beginning immediately following the conclusion of the game, includes interviews with Navy players and/or a member of the Navy coaching staff.

Naval Academy at the Head of the Class for Graduation Rates

For the third year in a row, the United States Naval Academy is at the head of the class for graduating NCAA student-athletes on the Division IA level. Navy graduated 100 percent of its student-athletes in 12 of the 19 sports reported on and no sport graduated lower than 94 percent.

"Our student-athletes continually strive to set the standard on the playing fields, in the classroom and in Bancroft Hall," said Naval Academy Director of Athletics Chet Gladchuk. "The support and encouragement they receive through the Commandant and her staff and the academic dean's office is extraordinary and provides tremendous motivation to be successful across the board. We are all proud to be leaders on the field, but even more so when we can prove to be leaders in the classroom as well. Our midshipmen clearly define the true meaning of student-athlete."

Annapolis

The City of Annapolis has been home to the Naval Academy for all but four years since the founding of the school in 1845 on the grounds of what originally was the Army's Fort Severn. The Academy moved its location to Newport, R.I., from 1861-65 during the Civil War.

Originally just 10 acres, "The Yard" has grown to a size of 338 acres.

Anchors Aweigh

"Anchors Aweigh" was written by Lt. Charles Zimmerman, musical director of the Naval Academy, in 1906, with the lyrics provided by Alfred H. Miles '06 as a fight song for the 1907 graduating class. The song made its debut at the 1906 Army-Navy game and when the Mids won, the song became traditional at the contest.

*Stand Navy down the field,
Sails set to the sky,
We'll never change our course,
So Army you steer shy.
Roll up the score, Navy,
Anchors Aweigh,
Sail Navy down the field,
And sink the Army,
sink the Army Grey*

Brigade of Midshipmen

The 4,000-member student body at the Naval Academy is called the Brigade of Midshipmen.

The Brigade is organized into:

- ◆ 2 regiments
- ◆ 6 battalions
- ◆ 30 companies

Bill the Goat

The first recorded use of a goat as the mascot for Navy teams was in 1893 when an animal named El Cid (the Chief) was presented to the Brigade by officers of the USS New York. El Cid helped Navy to a 6-4 win over Army that year and a goat became the permanent mascot of the Academy in 1904.

Co-Ed

Women were first admitted to the Naval Academy during the 1976 summer, with the 1980 graduation ceremonies being the first to commission female officers. Today, women comprise roughly 15 percent of the student body.

Marine Corps

Graduates of the Naval Academy entering the Marine Corps (commissioned as 2nd Lieutenants) have the following service options available to them ...

- ◆ Aviation -- air command and control, anti-air warfare, aviation maintenance, aviation supply, pilot, naval flight officer.
- ◆ Ground -- armor*, artillery*, communications (information systems), engineering, financial management, infantry*, logistics, military police
(* — not available to women)

Midshipman

The original 17th Century meaning of the word "midshipmen" designated those men who stood watch "amidships", or in the middle portion of a ship. The middle "s" was later dropped to give the current form of the word.

Midshipmen were originally young boys who were apprenticed to sea captains to learn the trade.

In the early days of the Navy, midshipmen were trained aboard ship until they were commissioned as ensigns.

Navy

Graduates of the Naval Academy entering the Navy (commissioned as Ensigns) have the following service options available to them ...

- ◆ Aviation -- flight officer, pilot
- ◆ Nuclear Propulsion -- ships, submarines*
- ◆ Restricted Line and Staff Corps -- civil engineering, cryptology, intelligence, maintenance, medicine, meteorology/oceanography, supply
- ◆ Special Operations -- explosive ordinance disposal, explosive ordinance management, mine countermeasures, operational diving and salvage,
- ◆ Navy SEALs*
- ◆ Surface Warfare -- conventional, nuclear powered
- ◆ Submarines*
(* — not available to women)

Nickname

The official nickname for all of Navy's athletic teams is Midshipmen.

"Mids" is an appropriate abbreviation, while "Middie" is inappropriate.

N-Star

Members of varsity teams who qualify for the varsity letter receive an N-Star for their letter sweaters if they participate in a victory over Army in any sport-designated Star Game.

The varsity N and corresponding N-Star were initiated during the early 1890s.

Navy has compiled a 14-10 record against teams from the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (0-0 under Tom Marryott). After Sunday's game, the only team from the league the Mids will not have played is Fairfield.

Rider Notes

With a 2-1 record on the year, the Broncs have already matched their victory total for all of the 2006-07 season.

Rider as a team is averaging 59.7 points per game and allowing opponents to score 52.7 points per game. The Broncs hold an advantage of eight rebounds a game over their opponents (42.7-34.7 rpg) and are connecting on more than six three-point field goals a contest.

Janele Henderson leads the team with a scoring average of 22.3 points per game, while Shaunice Parker is hauling in a team-high 13.7 rebounds a game.

Navy vs. Georgetown Series Notes

Georgetown posted a 51-34 victory over Navy last year in Alumni Hall, the first meeting between the Mids and the Hoyas in 14 seasons.

Kate Hobbs (17) and Carly Meyer (9), both 2007 graduates, combined for 26 of Navy's 33 points during last year's meeting. The Mids shot just 20.4 percent from the field and misfired on all 14 three-point field goal attempts in the game. It marked the only game over the last 11 seasons in which the Mids failed to connect on a three-point field goal attempt.

Georgetown has won eight of the 10 previous meetings between the two schools, including each of the three games played in Washington, D.C.

Navy has posted a 4-12 record against teams who currently comprise the Big East Conference (2-4 under Tom Marryott).

Georgetown Notes

Georgetown improved to 2-1 on the season with a 67-52 victory over American Friday night.

Georgetown is outscoring its opponents by seven points a game (63.3-55.7 ppg) and holds a nearly six rebound advantage on the glass (40.3-34.7 rpg). The Hoyas also are shooting 42.5 percent from the field while holding their opponents to a 35.0 percentage.

Kieraah Marlow and Brina Pollack lead the squad in scoring with respective averages of 17.0 and 12.0 points per game.

Howard jumped out to a 20-10 lead seven minutes into the game, but Navy closed the half on a 24-2 run to take control of the game. After spotting the Lady Bison the 10-point cushion, Navy held a 61-30 scoring advantage over Howard during the remainder of the game.

The Mids turned the ball over 33 times in the game, but overcame those miscues by shooting nearly 60 percent from the field and holding a 43-25 advantage on the glass. Additionally, Navy allowed the Lady Bison to score only 20 points following the Navy turnovers.

With 19 points and 11 boards, Cassie Consedine notched her third double-double over the opening four games of the season for the Mids. Morgan Hill, who scored only 21 points all of the 2006-07 season and had tallied just 18 points during the opening three games of the year, poured in 16 points against the Lady Bison.

Five Mids dished out four assists in the game, four scored in double figures and five grabbed at least four caroms.

Freshmen Starters

Including the Consedine-Myers duo, only eight freshmen (since individual game starts became available in 1990) have appeared in the starting lineup for Navy in the opening game of the season.

New Starting Five

Guard Kalen Kropa is the lone returning member of Navy's 2006-07 starting lineup. This marks just the second time since starts were recorded at Navy (1984-85 season) that the Mids have returned only one starter from the previous year (2004-05, Abi Campbell).

Kropa was one of only two players (Kate Hobbs) to start all 29 games for Navy last season. The only other returning players to have started a game during the 2006-07 season were Ali Currier (7 starts) and Whitney Davidson (5).

Consedine Sets Freshman Marks

In addition to becoming one of the few freshmen to start their inaugural game for the Mids, Cassie Consedine joined Adrienne Roseti as the lone freshmen to record a double-double in a season opening game.

With a pair of double-doubles, a Navy freshman class blocked shots record and averages of 11.0 points, 9.7 rebounds and 3.0 blocks per game, Cassie Consedine was selected as the Patriot League Rookie of the Week on Nov. 12.

She becomes the first Mid to receive the honor in seven seasons (Maile Shimoda, F12, 2001).

Morgan Hill

Morgan Hill entered Navy's Nov. 14 game against Howard having scored 21 points during the entire 2006-07 season and 18 points during Navy's initial three games this season. Hill promptly connected on 7-of-9 shots from the field and sank both free throw attempts against the Lady Bison for a career-best 16 points.

Offense vs. Defense

The Mids have played very good defense despite dropping three of its opening four games of the season.

Navy has held its opponents to an average of 54.0 points per game and to 33.3-percent shooting from the field. The Mids have held all but Rice (63 points) to 56 or fewer points.

While the defense has been stout for Navy, its offense has struggled to get on track. The Mids have surpassed 53 points just once this year (71, Howard) and are shooting 36.9 percent from the field. Navy has seen its possessions limited due to turning the ball over an average of 26.0 times a game, while in turn forcing only 17.3 turnovers a game. Thge Navy defense has been able to limit some of the potential damage its turnovers have caused, however.
