Interviews

Coach Marrayott is available most days prior to practice, while interviews with players will be coordinated around their academic and athletic schedules.

No interviews will be scheduled on the day of a game.

Credentials

Media requesting credentials for a Navy home game are asked to contact Justin Kischefsky at least three days prior to the scheduled game. Requests for credentials to Navy road games must be made to the sports information office of the home team.

Postgame Interviews

The Navy locker room is closed at all times, both at home and on the road. Postgame interviews at home games will be conducted in the interview room, across from the visitor's locker room in Alumni Hall, while interviews on the road will be conducted either outside of the Navy locker room or else in a designated media area at the arena.

The postgame interview session will begin 10 minutes following the conclusion of the game.

In addition to the regular season slate of games, all Navy postseason games will be carried live by the network.

All broadcasts begin 15 minutes prior to tip with the Navy Pregame Show featuring an interview with Navy head coach Tom Marrayott. The Navy Postgame Show, beginning immediately following the conclusion of the game, includes interviews with Navy players and/or a member of the Navy coaching staff.

Tom Marryott's 20 Years with Navy Basketball

- ◆ Was named as the fifth head coach of the Navy women's basketball program on May 22, 2003.
- ◆ Overall, is in his 10th year of coaching at the Naval Academy, as well as his 20th year of being associated with the Naval Academy.

Head Coach, Navy Women's Basketball, 2004-pres.

2003-04 Season

- ◆ During his initial season coaching both the team and on the women's collegiate level, led Navy to 13 overall victories and a 6-8 record in Patriot League games.
- ◆ Among the victories was the program's first over Holy Cross in Worcester, Mass.
- ◆ Navy competed at the prestigious Rainbow Wahine Classic in Honolulu, Hawaii, where the Mids faced nationally-ranked Texas and Arizona, as well as Syracuse.
- ◆ Courtney Davidson was named First-Team All-Patriot League and garnered CoSIDA Academic All-America accolades for the second-straight season.

2004-05 Season

- ◆ Navy entered the season with only three players who had totaled over 100 points in their respective careers.
- ◆ The Mids ended the year with a 6-8 record in league play and won the program's first postseason game in six seasons.
- ◆ Nikki Curtis received Second-Team All-Patriot League honors.

2005-06 Season

- ◆ Navy posted a 7-7 record and a fourth-place finish in the Patriot League. The .500 record and the league placing were the best for the Mids in seven years.
- ◆ Navy compiled a 6-6 record in true road games, the most wins and highest winning percentage in eight years.

- ◆ The Mids set a school and Patriot League record by averaging 6.32 three-point field goals made a game.
- ◆ Lauren Skrel garnered Second-Team All-Patriot League honors.

- ◆ Meredith Addington was the inaugural recipient of the Patriot League's Women's Sportsmanship Award.

2006-07 Season

- ◆ Navy finished the league season tied for fourth place in the standings with a 6-8 record.
- ◆ The back-to-back fourth-place finishes for Navy is the best for the program in consecutive years since 1998 (first-place tie) and '99 (third).
- ◆ Carly Meyer became just the second Mid to lead the Patriot League in scoring, as well as the seventh player in school history to receive first-team all-league recognition.
- ◆ Kate Hobbs was named First-Team All-Senior CLASS (Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School).

Assistant Coach, Navy Men's Basketball, 1999-2003

- ◆ Served as an assistant coach to Don DeVoe for the Navy men's program for five years.
- ◆ Navy posted an 80-65 overall record, as well as a 30-26 mark in Patriot League games, during his five years with the team.

Head Coach/Athletic Director, NAPS, 1988-98

- ◆ Was the athletic director and head basketball coach at the Naval Academy Prep School (Newport, R.I.) from 1988-98.
- ◆ The men's basketball team compiled a 124-75 record during his decade as the coach.

Lehigh Preview

After opening its Patriot League season with four wins in as many games, Lehigh has since dropped three of its last four outings, including back-to-back decisions to Holy Cross and American, to fall to 5-3 in the league. Two of its losses, to Lafayette and Holy Cross, were by a combined five points, while three of its victories, over Navy, Army and Bucknell, were by a total of 10 points.

The Mountain Hawks are outscoring their opponents 59.0-47.4 points a game in its victories and are being outscored by an average of 54.3-48.3 points a game in their losses.

On the league season as a whole, Lehigh holds a slim 55.0-50.0 points per game scoring advantage over its foes.

Lehigh's league opponents have made only 23 three-point field goals this year, the lowest total in the league (American is second with 30 triples allowed). Conversely, the Mountain Hawks rank third in the league with 42 three-pointers made on offense.

Individually for Lehigh, Alex Ross leads the team in scoring with an average of 11.8 points per game, with Melissa Rich ranking second in scoring (10.1 ppg) and leading the squad in rebounds at 6.9 caroms a contest.

Navy vs. Lehigh Series Notes

Lehigh posted a 55-53 victory over Navy Jan. 16 in Bethlehem, Pa., to snap a five-game winning streak by the Midshipmen in the series.

Navy holds a 20-18 lead in the series with Lehigh, including a 17-16 advantage in Patriot League regular season games.

A victory by Navy would result in a season split of the series for the sixth time, while a Lehigh win would give the Mountain Hawks their sixth season sweep over the Mids and first since 2004.

The Mids have won three-straight games in Alumni Hall (by a total of 22 points) and hold leads of 11-7 in games played in Annapolis and 9-7 in games contested in Alumni Hall.

Lafayette Preview

Lafayette opened the league season with an overtime loss at Holy Cross, then ran off four-straight wins before dropping three ensuing games to fall to 4-4 in league play. Each of its three most recent losses have come by double figures.

The Leopards averaged 59.8 points a game (and allowed 55.2 points a game) in opening up the league season with a 4-1 record, but since are being outscored by an average of 61.6-49.3 points a game heading into a Wednesday night game at Colgate.

For the entire league season, Lafayette is narrowly being outscored (57.6-55.9 ppg) and outrebounded (36.8-32.5 rpg) by its opponents.

Lafayette has totaled the third-highest number of free throw attempts this year with 143 trips to the charity stripe, but the Leopards rank second last in the league with a free throw percentage of 60.8 percent.

Vanessa Van De Venter leads Lafayette in both scoring and rebounding with averages of 15.1 points and 5.5 rebounds a game, respectively.

Against UMBC in early December, Davidson connected on a career-high five three-point field goals, scored a season-best 15 points (narrowly missing her career-high of 18) and grabbed a career-high six rebounds.

She later drilled a pair of key three-point field goals on her way to scoring 13 points during Navy's 72-69 overtime victory against Air Force. Her first triple tied the game at 48-48 with six minutes remaining in the contest (as part of an 11-0 run that gave the Mids a 50-48 lead), then sank another trey to give Navy a 68-66 lead with one minute to play in overtime. Davidson proceeded to be fouled while grabbing a rebound on the ensuing Air Force possession, then sank both of the free throw attempts with 47 seconds left.

Morgan Hill

Morgan Hill entered Navy's Nov. 14 game against Howard having scored 39 career points (21 points during the entire 2006-07 season and 18 points during Navy's initial three games this season). Hill promptly scored a combined 31 points in Navy's games against the Lady Bison and the Broncs. She converted 7-of-9 shots from the field in scoring a career-high 16 points against Howard, then sank 6-of-12 field goal attempts on her way to scoring 15 points against the Broncs.

Hill has also produced back-to-back strong efforts in Navy's games against San Diego State and Air Force. Navy's game against Air Force marked the first overtime game for the Mids in two seasons (Feb. 21, 2006 at American, L, 89-81), the first home overtime game for the program in five seasons (March 1, 2003, Army, W, 86-85 in 3 OT) and the first home overtime game against a non-league opponent in seven years (Dec. 20, 2000, McNeese State, W, 74-65).

The win improved Navy's all-time record in overtime games to 18-13, to 13-4 in home OT games and to 9-1 in home overtime games against non-conference opponents.
