

2006 Highlights

- For the first time in program history, the Mids topped the 20-win plateau, claiming victory in 21 of their 24 contests ... their .896 winning percentage is also a program best.
- Earned the program's second NCAA Tournament berth by winning its second Patriot League Tournament.
- Won a share of the Patriot League regular-season title for the sixth time in the last nine years.
- Advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history by way of penalty kicks (5-4) vs. William & Mary.
- Finished the season ranked 17th in the 2006 NCAA Women's Soccer RPI.
- Finished the season ranked No. 19 by *Soccer America*.
- Achieved the program's highest ranking of No. 11 by *Soccer America* on Nov. 6 ... it's the highest ranking by a Patriot League team in conference history.
- Its seven-week stay in the polls was the longest a Patriot League team has been ranked.
- Ten different players scored goals in the Mids' school-record 10-0 win over Howard.
- Forward **Kristen Laraway** scored in the 80th minute to lead Navy to its first win over a nationally-ranked team, a 1-0 win over No. 9 Penn State.

Receiving National Attention

- Two features were written about the Navy women's soccer program that appeared on ESPN.com last fall.
- Its initial story focused on senior **Meggie Curran** and appeared on the internet on Sept. 13.
- On Nov. 1, Graham Hays wrote a riveting piece on the rise of the Mids' soccer program.
- Sophomore keeper **Lizzie Barnes** appeared in the Nov. 6 issue of *Sports Illustrated's Faces in the Crowd*.
- Freshman **Lauren Bresnahan's** appearance on the *Soccer America* National Team of the Week on Sept. 4, marked the first time a Mid has received national recognition since 2000 when Rebecca Gould was named to the *Soccer America* Team of the Week.
- Junior **Brigitte Fox** garnered *Soccer America*, *Soccer Buzz* and *Soccer Times* recognition on Oct. 16 ... it's the first time in program history that a player has been named to all three teams in the same week.
- Newcomer **Shelly Moeller** earned a place on the Nov. 6 *Soccer America* and *Soccer Buzz* Teams of the Week after scoring both game-winners for the Mids in the Patriot League Tournament ... Moeller and Bresnahan are the first Navy freshmen to earn national recognition.

Stifling Defense, High-Powered Offense

- Navy fielded the stingiest defense in the country in 2006, finishing the season ranked No. 1 in goals-against average (.372), shutout percentage (.790) and save percentage (.918).
- The Mids were ranked No. 8 in scoring offense, averaging a school-record 2.92 goals per game.
- Navy shut out a program-record 19 of its 24 foes.
- Navy outscored its opponents 70-9, with 17 of its 20 field players scoring at least one goal ... nearly half (4) the goals the Mids gave up were scored by National Champion North Carolina in the second round of the



Navy advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament via penalty kicks over William & Mary.

NCAA Tournament.

- All 20 players, as well as starting keeper **Lizzie Barnes**, produced a goal or an assists in '06.
- Set school records in points (219), goals (70), assists (79), shutouts (19), and goals-against average (.37).
- Navy's 19-game winning streak to open the season (the nation's longest) was the longest in program history ... Navy was the only Div. I team, men or women, that had not been beaten or tied heading into the last weekend of regular-season play.
- During their 19-game winning streak, the Mids recorded a school-record 10 straight shutouts.

Read it in the NCAA Record Book

- The Midshipmen finished among the NCAA record books in the following
 - 14th in goals-against average (.372)
 - 5th in shutout percentage (.792, 19 of 24 opp.)
 - Tied-7th in shutouts (19)
 - 2nd in save percentage (.918)
- Navy's 10-consecutive shutouts between Sept. 24-Oct. 26 are tied as the fifth most in NCAA history.
- Navy's 8.5-game improvement from 2005 to 2006 ranks as the 13th-best turnaround in NCAA history ... the Mids turned in a 10-8-2 record in 2005.
- Sophomore **Lizzie Barnes** played 859:23 without giving up a goal (Sept. 17-Oct. 29), the seventh-most consecutive shutout minutes in NCAA history.
- Barnes' name also appears in the NCAA record book for save percentage (.933, 2nd), goals-against average (.292, 11th), solo shutout percentage (.565, 10th), solo shutouts (13, 8th).

There's No Place Like Home

- Navy owned a program-best 14-1 (.933) record in games played at the Glenn Warner Soccer Facility
- The Mids won 14 in a row in Annapolis before dropping their regular-season finale.
- Three of the top four home crowds watched the Mids last fall, including a facility-record 2,412 fans who cheered Navy on to victory over No. 9 Penn State.
- More than 10,000 fans flooded the gates over the course of the 2006 campaign, an average of 670 fans per contest.
- Navy was ranked 19th in the country in average home attendance and the highest in the Patriot League.

Memorable Games of 2006

Sept. 17 • Navy 3, Columbia 1

- Senior **Meggie Curran's** goal in the 72nd minute knotted the game before rookie Cassie Barbaresi knocked in the game-winner in the 75th minute ... among its 21 wins, it was the only game Navy was forced to come from behind to win.

Oct. 6 • Navy 4, Army 0

- With a goal and an assist, **Meggie Curran** became just the fourth player in program history to score 100 points during her career ... she led Navy to a 4-0 Star Game win over archrival Army.

Oct. 8 • Navy 2, Holy Cross 0

- Senior **Carmen Myers** and rookie defender **Shelly Moeller** each scored headers off corner kicks to lead the Mids to a 2-0 win over Holy Cross and the program's 50th win in Patriot League action.

Oct. 14 • Navy 4, Colgate 0

- Junior **Brigitte Fox** turned in her first collegiate hat trick by scoring three of Navy's four goals, including her first less than two minutes into the game ... it marked the most goals scored by the Mids in the 13-year history of the series.

Oct. 16 • Navy 10, Howard 0

- Ten different players scored the Mids' program-record 10 goals against Howard.

Oct. 26 • Navy 1, No. 9 Penn State 0

- A goal by sophomore **Kristen Laraway** in the 80th minute led Navy to its first win over a nationally-ranked program ... the win also marked the 100th win for the Mids at home ... Navy extended its shutout streak to 10, the fifth-best mark in NCAA history ... a facility-record 2,412 fans came out to support Navy.

**Nov. 5 • Navy 1, Colgate 0
 Patriot League Championship**

- **Shelly Moeller** booted in the game-winning goal in the eighth minute to lead the Midshipmen to their second Patriot League Tournament title in their 13 years of being affiliated with the conference ... Meggie Curran provided the assist, her school-record 15th.

**Nov. 10 • Navy 0 (5-4 PK), No. 20 William & Mary 0
 NCAA Tournament - First Round**

- With penalty kicks deadlocked at four apiece and entering sudden death, junior **Lindsay Parker** gave Navy a 5-4 edge when her shot made contact with the left side of net. Navy keeper **Lizzie Barnes** preserved the win by snatching Kendall Stone's kick out of the air. Navy would advance to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in program history.
