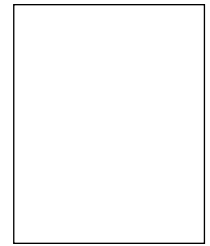

Army-Navy is one of the most storied rivalries in all of college and professional athletics. Its roots date back to Nov. 29, 1890, when the two military institutions squared off on the gridiron with Navy taking the inaugural meeting, 24-0.

While the annual Army-Navy football game is revered by many as one of the premiere college football games, it is just one of the many athletic competitions contested on a yearly basis between the two schools. Twenty-two of Navy's 31 sports battle Army each year in Star Competitions - that is a predetermined contest between Army and Navy with the winner receiving a letter for his/her letter sweater. There is only one Star Competition per sport despite the number of times the two programs face one another during the season.

2007 NAVY WOMEN'S SOCCER

1992 — Navy Director of Athletics Jack Lengyel announces women's soccer will be added as a varsity sport for the 1993 season.

July 1993 — Carin Gabarra is hired as Navy's inaugural head women's soccer coach.

Sept. 4, 1993 — Navy plays its first game, a 2-0 loss at home against Loyola.

Sept. 9, 1993 — The Midshipmen earn the program's first win, while recording their first shutout in a 4-0 victory at Johns Hopkins ... senior forward Julie Treanor scored three of Navy's four goals, including the first at 13:35 in the opening half.

Oct. 17, 1993 — Julie Treanor feeds Patt DeSpain for the game-winning goal in the 24th minute, as Navy captured its first win over a Div. I program, a 1-0 victory at Georgetown.

Oct. 22, 1993 — Navy concludes its first season with a 2-5-0 record against Div. I foes.

Sept. 10, 1994 — Navy plays its first game as a member of the Patriot League, a 4-1 loss at Holy Cross.

Sept. 17, 1994 — The Midshipmen earn their first Patriot League win in a 5-0 victory over Fordham.

Oct. 29, 1994 — Navy ends its first full season of Div. I action with a 7-9-2 record.

November 1994 — Amy Hakola, Cori Thornton and Ty Westinghouse become Navy's first award winners, all garnering All-Patriot League recognition.

Nov. 4, 1995 — Navy makes its first appearance in the Patriot League Tournament ... the Mids post a 2-0 win at Bucknell in the opening round earning the program's first championship game appearance ... Navy loses to Colgate in the championship contest.

Navy held 18-time NCAA Tournament Champion North Carolina scoreless for more than 72 minutes in front of an NCAA-record crowd 6,527 fans at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium in 2003.

December 1995 — Defender Nicole Aunapu and forward Cori Thornton receive NSCAA Third-Team All-Mid-Atlantic Region recognition ... they are Navy's first all-region honorees.

November 1996 — Michelle Nance produces 20 points (7G, 6A) to become Navy's first player to be named the Patriot League Rookie of the Year.

November 1996 — Carin Gabarra is named the Patriot League Coach of the Year after leading the Mids to an 11-6-2 record.

Nov. 13, 1996 — Navy earns its first postseason tournament appearance in a 2-0 loss at Monmouth in the ECAC Tournament.

Sept. 16, 1998 — Michelle Nance becomes the first Navy player to be named to a national team of the week (Soccer America).

Oct. 30, 1998 — Navy claims its first Star Game win over Army with a 2-0 win at West Point.

Oct. 31, 1998 — Behind a 3-0 win over Lehigh, Navy clinches its first Patriot League regular-season title with a 5-0-1 record.

November 1999 — Justine Fisher paces to the league with 38 points on 16 goals and six assists to become the Mids' first Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year recipient.

November 1998 — Nicole Aunapu becomes Navy's first two-time Patriot League Defensive Player of the Year, leading the Mids to 14 shutouts and a 0.56 goals-against average, both the second-best marks in program history.

Nov. 2, 1998 — Navy makes the program's first appearance in the NSCAA poll, debuting at No. 26.

December 1998 — Nicole Aunapu becomes the first Navy women's soccer player to garner Academic All-America recognition.

May 1999 — The Vice. Adm. Lawrence Sword for Women, presented to the midshipman of the graduating class to have personally excelled in athletics during her years of varsity competition is awarded to Nicole Aunapu, the first soccer player to earn the award.

Summer 1999 — Nicole Aunapu become first Navy student-athlete to be named the state recipient of the NCAA Woman of the Year.

Oct. 31, 1999 — A road win over Bucknell gives the Mids their second-consecutive Patriot League regular-season crown.

November 1999 — Justine Fisher is Navy's first recipient of the Patriot League Offensive Player of the Year award ... she is the only player in program history to pick up two different player of the year awards from the league, also being named the Patriot League Rookie of the Year in '98.

Oct. 28, 2000 — Olympian and Navy head coach Carin Gabarra inducted into the National Soccer Hall of Fame ... became just the second woman named to the Hall.

Oct. 31, 2000 — Nicole Aunapu represents Navy on the Patriot League All-Decade Team.

Sept. 7, 2001 — Navy turns back Davidson, 4-1, in its first contest played at the Glenn Warner Soccer Facility.

Oct. 28, 2001 — Justine Fisher becomes Navy's all-time leading scorer (overtook Cori Thornton, later passed by Stacy Finley & Meggie Curran) in leading Navy to a 3-0 win over George Mason ... the win is Carin Gabarra's 100th collegiate win.

Feb. 12, 2002 — Justine Fisher is drafted in the fourth round by the Washington Freedom, becoming the first Navy women's soccer player drafted into the professional soccer league.

Sept. 6, 2002 — Navy shuts down Air Force, 2-0, at the Military Academies Classic in St. Louis, posting the program's 100th win.

Sept. 9, 2002 — Amelia Sheveland scores four goals and adds an assist to set the Navy record for single-game points with nine against Marist.

Nov. 4, 2002 — With its 8-1 win over Robert Morris, Navy finished the regular season unbeaten (16-0-4) for the first time in program history ... Navy was the only team in Div. I to complete the 2002 regular season undefeated.

Sept. 26, 2003 — Headed into its contest against No. 1-ranked North Carolina owning the nation's longest regular-season unbeaten streak of 35 games between Aug. 30, 2002 and Sept. 25, 2003.

Sept. 26, 2003 — An NCAA-record crowd (now No. 2) of 6,527 watch Navy hold top-ranked and National Champion North Carolina scoreless for the first 72 minutes at Navy-Marine Corps Memorial Stadium, the only Navy women's soccer game to be played at the stadium ... the Tar Heels won, 1-0.

Nov. 9, 2003 — Navy defeats American, 4-1, to earn the program's first Patriot League Tournament title.

Nov. 14, 2003 — Fifth-seeded Penn State defeats Navy 5-1 in the first round of the NCAA Tournament ... the Navy women's soccer team is the first women's team in any sport at the Academy to earn an NCAA Tournament berth ... it is also the first Service Academy women's soccer team to play in the NCAA Tournament.

Spring 2004 — Quinn Rinehart becomes the first women's soccer player to serve as Brigade Commander ... she is also the recipient of the Academy's Calvert Award recognizing a member of the graduating class who has persevered during her career ... she is the first soccer player to garner the award.

July 1, 2004 — Carin Gabarra, along with her teammates that won the gold medal in the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games, are inducted into the U.S. Olympic Hall of Fame.

Sept. 4, 2006 — Defender Lauren Bresnahan became Navy's first freshman to earn national recognition when she was named to *Soccer America's* National Team of the Week.

Oct. 8, 2006 — Navy earns its 50th Patriot League victory behind a 2-0 effort at Holy Cross.

Oct. 16, 2006 — Junior forward Brigitte Fox became the first player in school history to be named to the *Soccer America*, *Soccer Buzz* and *Soccer Times* Team of the Week in the same week.

Oct. 16, 2006 — Ten different players score the Mids' program-record 10 goals in their win over Howard.

Oct. 23, 2006 — Navy makes its first appearance in program history in the *Soccer Times* poll ... the Mids entered the poll at No. 25.

Oct. 26, 2006 — Sophomore forward Kristen Laraway's goal in the 80th minute leads Navy to a 1-0 win over No. 9 Penn State at the Glenn Warner Soccer Facility ... it is the program's first win over a nationally-ranked team ... a facility-record 2,412 fans were on hand to support the Mids.

Oct. 30, 2006 — Navy receives votes in the NSCAA poll for the first time since Nov. 2, 1998.

Oct. 31, 2006 — Navy receives its highest ranking in the NSCAA Mid-Atlantic Region in program history at No. 5 with a 19-1-0 record.

Nov. 2, 2006 — Navy sweeps all five of the Patriot League's major awards for the first time in program history — Meggie Curran as Offensive POY, Shelly Moeller as Co-Defensive POY, Lizzie Barnes as Goalkeeper of the Year, Cassie Barbaresi as Co-Rookie of the Year and Carin Gabarra as Coach of the Year ... Barnes is Navy's first recipient of the goalkeeper award.

Nov. 5, 2006 — The Mids reach 20 wins for the first time in program history with its 2-0 victory over Lehigh in the Patriot League Tournament Semifinals.

Nov. 5, 2006 — Freshman Shelly Moeller's goal in the eighth minute proves to be all Navy needs to defeat Colgate and claim its second Patriot League Tournament title in four seasons ... Meggie Curran's assist is her 15th of the year, a program record.

Nov. 6, 2006 — Navy earns its highest national ranking as the No. 11 team in the *Soccer America* poll ... it is also the highest ranking in Patriot League history.

Nov. 6, 2006 — Goalkeeper Lizzie Barnes appeared in *Sports Illustrated's* Faces in the Crowd.

Nov. 10, 2006 — Navy advances to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history via penalty kicks against 20th-ranked William & Mary ... it is the first time in program history (272 games) that a Navy game has been decided by penalty kicks.

November 2006 — Lizzie Barnes finished the year as the nation's leader in goals-against average (.292) and save percentage (.933).

Dec. 3, 2006 — Navy finished the 2006 campaign ranked No. 1 in the nation in goals-against average (.372), shutout percentage (.790) and save percentage (.918).

Dec. 3, 2006 — Navy finishes the season ranked No. 17 in the NCAA's RPI.

Dec. 8, 2006 — Meggie Curran and Shelly Moeller earn NSCAA First-Team All-Mid-Atlantic Region recognition ... they are the first players in program history to be named to the first team.

Dec. 20, 2006 — Shelly Moeller and Cassie Barbaresi become Navy's first players to be named Freshmen All-Americans (*Soccer Buzz*).

Dec. 21, 2006 — Meggie Curran is named a Third-Team Soccer Buzz All-America selection, Navy's first player named to an All-America team by any organization or media outlet.
