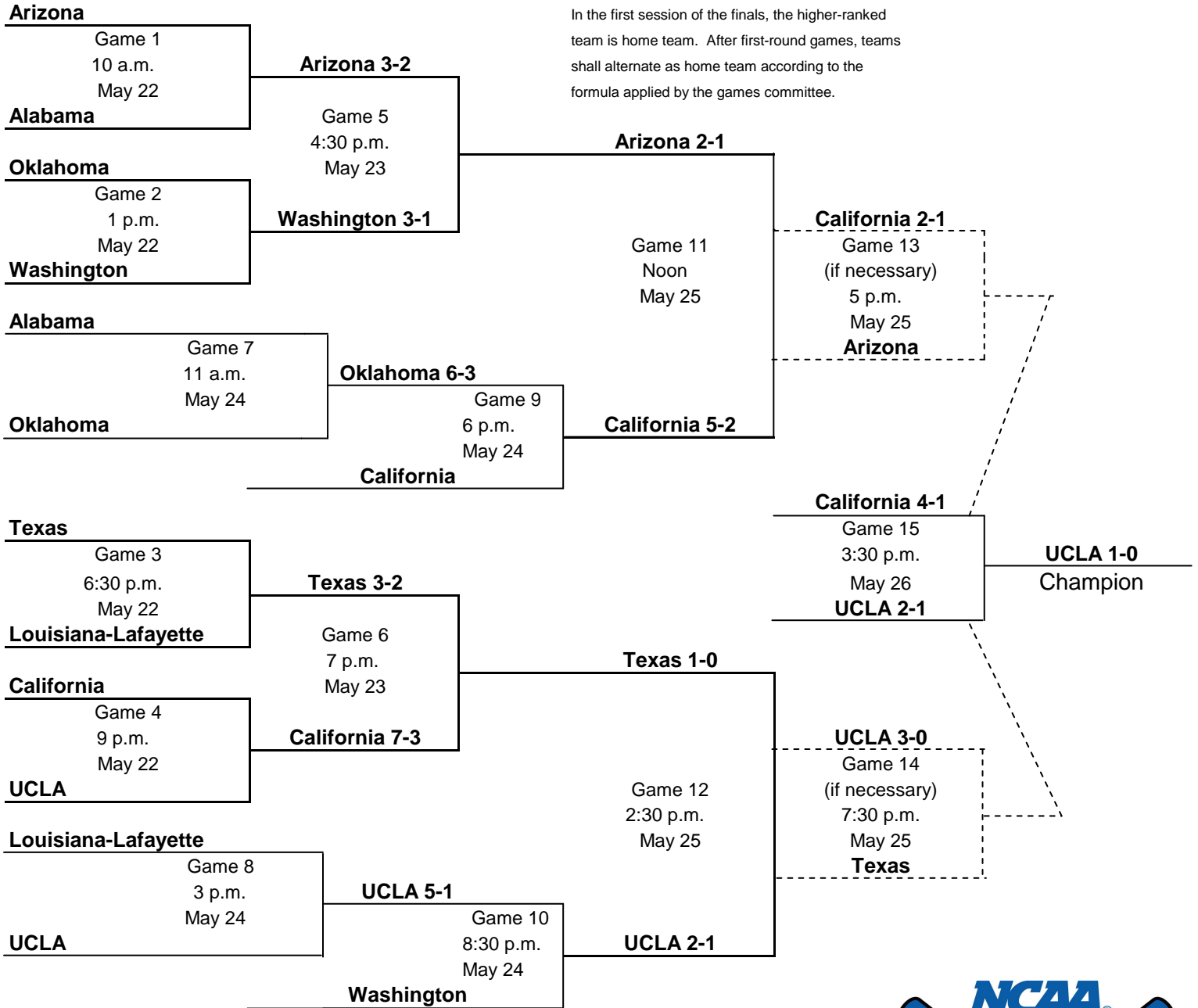




2003 National Collegiate Division I Women's SOFTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

In the first session of the finals, the higher-ranked team is home team. After first-round games, teams shall alternate as home team according to the formula applied by the games committee.



Finals played at ASA Hall of Fame Stadium, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Eight eight-team regionals will be played at campus sites.

Bracket note:

1. If the winner of Game 9 defeats the winner of Game 5, then Game 13 is necessary.
2. If the winner of Game 10 defeats the winner of Game 6, then then Game 14 is necessary.
3. If Game 14 is the only necessary game of the evening, it will be played at 5 p.m.
