Must register with the Clearinghouse (International Application)

Send official transcripts with certified translations to Clearinghouse

Need SAT/ACT scores (TOEFL is not an acceptable substitute)

Refer to Initial Eligibility requirements in the NCAA Guide to International

Academic Standards for Athletics Eligibility. (AAC can provide an unofficial preliminary assessment)
