Niner Notes

- Junior outside hitter **Abbey Szlanfucht** is the only player in Conference USA this year to rank among the league top 10 in both digs and either kills or points. She is also the only player to appear on all three top 10 lists. She averages 4.50 points, 4.00 kills and 3.54 digs.

- Two 49er juniors went over the 1,000 kill plateau this season. Outside hitter **Abbey Szlanfucht** reached the mark on November 5 at Cincinnati, and now has 1,043 in 294 games for her career (3.55 per game). She ranks 9th on the school's all-time kills list.

Middle blocker **Lisa Newell** reached the mark against DePaul on November 13, and has 1,005 in 356 games in three seasons (2.82 pg). She needs 25 to move into the top 10.

- Szlanfucht is also closing in on 1,000 digs for her career. She had 403 this season (3.54 per game), to raise her three-season total to 938.

- Senior setter **Molly McDonald** moved into third on the school's all-time assists list on October 30, passing Sherri Hall (1985-88). McDonald has 4,126 assists in her four-year career, including three straight 1,000-assist seasons. McDonald has won two C-USA Setter of the Week awards this season.

- McDonald's total this season (1,451) currently ranks as the second-best single-season performance in school history. The school record is 1,543 by Sandy Merkel (1992).

- Szlanfucht recorded a pair of double-doubles last weekend, raising her team-leading total to 18 this season. She has gone over ten digs in 24 of 32 matches this season, and recorded over 10 kills in 23 matches - including seven straight entering the Tournament.

- Szlanfucht's 27 digs against DePaul marked the fourth time this season she had gone over 20 digs. She has two 20/20 double-doubles this year, against ECU and Elon.

- The 49ers finished in a five-way tie for eighth place, afterin being picked 13th of 14 teams in the preseason C-USA coaches poll.

- With 19 this season, Charlotte has its most wins in a season since the 1994 campaign (22-13). The 49ers also won 18 in 2002. Charlotte also established a record for most wins under current head coach **Lisa Marston**, who took over as head coach in 2000.

- The team's turnaround from last season has been dramatic. Charlotte was 8-24 last season. By comparison, the Niners won their eighth match this year on September 14, in the midst of an 8-1 run to start the campaign.

- Charlotte is ranked eighth nationally and leads C-USA in service aces, averaging 2.36 per game. Sophomore **Jessica Oldenburg** and junior **Lisa Newell** are ranked second and third, respectively, in the conference this season. Oldenburg has 61 aces in 112 games (0.54 per game, 30th nationally), while Newell totals 57 in 116 games (0.49 per game).

- Charlotte raised \$3,300 for the Susan G. Komen Foundation through the "Dig for the Cure" program. Coach Marston started the program last season, and the team raised nearly \$3,000. This season, all 14 C-USA schools were involved.

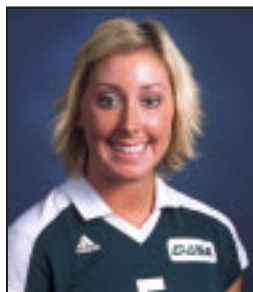
