NINER NOTES

Just Charlotte, Please

When referring to the team, please use "Charlotte 49ers". The official name of the school is the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, or UNC Charlotte. However, the athletic teams all go by "Charlotte 49ers." Niners is also a correct second reference.

Road Warriors

Charlotte will play its first 25 games away from home in some form or fashion. With construction ongoing at Robert and Mariam Hayes Stadium, the Niners will play the first 13 "home games" off campus. Charlotte begins play this weekend in the conference home opening series against Massachusetts. Charlotte has played home games on three different home fields away from campus. Charlotte is 15-1 at "home" in three different parks in 2007, 22-5 is the best record through 27 games in school history.

The Teams

Charlotte finished 35-20-1 last year (tied for third-most wins in program history), leading the Atlantic 10 in 10 of 13 offensive categories. Charlotte finished tied for third in the A-10 with an 18-9 record in league play. The pitching staff was tops in four categories, while second only in two others. Charlotte's pitching staff finished the season 19th in the NCAA in ERA, and the offense was 22nd in runs scored. Charlotte returns one weekend starter, and eight of the nine batters from the starting lineup.

Winthrop last had a fantastic 46-8 season in 2006, including a 17-7 Big South finish, good enough for second place. The Eagles made the NCAA Tournament and played in the Chapel Hill regional, falling in the final game to winner North Carolina after a 2-2 record over the postseason weekend. Winthrop has been ranked at times this season, and is receiving votes in several polls. The Eagles have registered wins over #13 UCLA, Maryland, Mississippi State and a three-game sweep of A-10 foe Xavier.

The Series

Charlotte has a 10-11-1 record against Winthrop all-time. Charlotte snapped an Eagles' three-game win streak by defeating Winthrop 4-2 on April 6, 2005. This was the last time the two teams met. Neither team had been able to put together more than a pair of consecutive wins before that run. The two teams played to a scoreless tie and called the game after six innings in 1997. Charlotte has been shutout twice by Winthrop (4/17/80, their first meeting, and 4/6/88). Charlotte has never shutout Winthrop.

Head Coach Loren Hibbs Over the 400 Mark

Now in his 15th season at the helm, Loren Hibbs is the all-time winningest coach in the program's history. His record now stands at 425-378-3 (.530) overall. Hibbs was an assistant at his alma mater, Wichita State, prior to being named head coach of the Niners. He is still the NCAA's all-time single-season leader in runs scored with 125 (1982). He was a member of the College World Series all-tournament team that year for the Shockers.

With a Little Help from My Friends

Charlotte had a .303 batting average with runners in scoring position in the Massachusetts series last weekend. The Niners were 10-for-33 in those situations in the series. For the season, the Niners are .333 (122-for-366) in those situations, 135 points better than opponents so far in 2007. Even better than that, Charlotte is hitting .366 (190-for-519) with runners on any base this season. That total is 145 points better than the opposition this season. Also of note is the number of bases-loaded situations for Charlotte this season. The Niners have logged 41 at-bats with the bases loaded, as opposed to just 19 for the opposition. Charlotte is hitting .317 (13 hits) in those situations, while opponents have just six hits in similar instances.

Rally With Two

This season, Charlotte is batting .309 (98-for-317) as a team with two outs (opponents are 53-for-276, for an average of .192), and Charlotte is outscoring opponents 76-25 in two-out situations.

Enough Bagels for a Sandwich Shop

Charlotte had a 34 scoreless innings pitched streak ended in the 2/20 game against Furman. Charlotte was one out away from tying the school record, but Furman scored in the third inning, ending the streak at 34 innings pitched without allowing a run. Charlotte had shut out the previous three opponents before Furman, one shy of the school record four games, which took place in 1990. The Niners had their only other three-game sweep in school history at Old Dominion, pitching three straight road shutouts in 1988. This marks the first time in Loren Hibbs' head coaching career that his team has not allowed a run in three consecutive contests. Charlotte already has more shutouts (six) this season than all of last year (three). The school record season shutouts is eight, and the Niners are three-fourths of the way to that record. On the flip side, Charlotte has not been shutout since April 8, 2005 versus Tulane, a streak that has reached 107 games.

I'll See Your Strikeout Total, And Raise You One

Starting pitchers Adam Mills and Spencer Steedley played a game of "top this" earlier this season. Mills tied a career-high with 12 strikeouts on 2/9 against Campbell. Mills struck out the last ten batters in a row that he faced before being lifted for exceeding his pitch count.

Steedley bested Mills' performance by striking out a career-best 13 batters in his victory the next day of the series.

Mills went one better again and struck out a career-high 14 batters in the Radford game on 2/18 in seven innings of work. The strikeout total was just two shy of the school record. He followed that up with 13 more K's against Campbell on 2/23. In five of his eight starts, Mills has struck out at least 12 hitters. For the season, Mills has fanned 85 in 67.2 innings pitched.

For the Record

The Niners broke two school records on 2/18. Charlotte belted nine doubles for one record and won by 24 runs, the second record, in a 24-0 win against Radford. The shutout was the third straight for Charlotte, one shy of the school record of four games in a row (1990)... Charlotte has logged six shutouts this season, including a complete-game version for Spencer Steedley and two complete-game shutouts for Adam Mills... The six team shutouts is two shy of the team record of eight, set in 1990... Charlotte's 22-5 start is the best in school history after 27 games... Senior Cory Lane's triple against Massachusetts claimed the school's career triples record.



National Player of the Week

The National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) released the first Pro-Line Cap National Player of the Week awards of the season. Charlotte senior lefty Spencer Steedley was named National Pitcher of the Week for his complete-game shutout at Campbell on February 10. It was Steedley's first shutout in 18 career starts, breaking his previously long outing of six innings (reached twice). Steedley allowed seven singles but no walks, and struck out a career-high 13 batters, nearly doubling his previous high of seven. He was also named to the College Baseball Foundation's National Honor Roll and was the Insidepitching.com Southeast Regional Pitcher of the Week.

Senior Adam Mills would not be denied. The righty tossed a one-hit, one-walk performance against Radford, striking out a career-best 14 batters in seven innings. For his efforts, he was among just six players in the country named to the *Collegiate Baseball* "Louisville Slugger Player of the Week" list. As was Steedley, Mills was named to the College Baseball Foundation's National Honor Roll as well as Insidepitching.com's Southeast Regional Pitcher of the Week.

Mills did the trick again a week later, tossing a complete-game three-hit, three-walk shutout as Charlotte defeated Campbell 1-0 on 2/23. Mills was Co-Player of the Week for the Atlantic 10 and again was named to the six-player *Collegiate Baseball* "Louisville Slugger Player of the Week" list.

Home Grown Talent

Of the 31 players currently on the numerical roster, 19 hail from the state of North Carolina. Included in that mix are seven position player regulars: Aaron Bray (Charlotte), Chris and Cory Lane (twins from Kernersville), O'Brien Taylor (Winston-Salem), Chris Taylor (Mt. Pleasant), Alex Bryant (Ellerbe), and Spencer Steedley (Granite Quarry). On the mound, North Carolina natives include relievers Matt Foard (Indian Trail), Zach Rosenbaum (Huntersville) and Sam Pierce (Davidson).

Stocked Trophy Case

Nine different players earned All-Atlantic 10 honors, the most in school history. The school-record 1998 team (43 wins) had eight players honored by Conference USA. Mike Ambrose (1st), Spencer Steedley (1st), Cory Lane (2nd), Chris Taylor (2nd), O'Brien Taylor (2nd), Aaron Bray (2nd, All-Rookie), Derek McDaid (Hon. Mention), Adam Mills (Hon. Mention) and Kyle Pfirman (All-Rookie) were all honored by the A-10 coaches. Mike Ambrose and Spencer Steedley became the first 49ers to earn first-team all-conference honors since John Maine (New York Mets) was C-USA Pitcher of the Year in 2001. Aaron Bray became only the program's second *Collegiate Baseball* Freshman All-American, joining Mike Taylor from 2000. The program extended to 16 straight years its streak of having at least one player honored in the conference post-season awards (1991-06). Charlotte has now won 74 All-Conference awards in 28 seasons, including 54 in Coach Loren Hibbs' 14 seasons with the Niners.

Prognosticator's Corner

No season has ever been successful on paper, but the Niners are picked to win the Atlantic 10 by several sources. First, the A-10 coaches selected Charlotte as the preseason favorite to win the championship, the second time in the Niners' two seasons in the league to be so honored. *Perfect Game Crosschecker* selected Charlotte as the top team in the league, and the only A-10 qualifier to the NCAA Regionals. The publication also put the Niners in the "Top 100 teams of 2007" section, one of only two league teams to make an appearance. *Baseball America* also lists the Niners as the favorite to win the A-10, going so far as to project Charlotte's post-season appearance. The publication shows Charlotte heading north to the Chapel Hill regional, along with projected teams East Carolina, Elon and host North Carolina in the national tournament.

Postseason History

Charlotte has played in a post-season conference tournament 21 times in the first 27 years of the program's history (1979-2006). The 49ers were in the Conference USA Tournament seven times in 10 years of membership in the league, posting an 11-12 record in that tournament overall. They made two championship game appearances, and advanced to the NCAA's as an at-large selection out of C-USA in 1998 after losing to top-seeded Tulane in the league's title game. The Niners' inaugural season in the Atlantic 10 netted Charlotte a berth in the six-team post-season festival at the Bronx.
