When referring to the team, please use "Charlotte 49ers". The official name of the school is the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, or UNC Charlotte. However, the athletic teams all go by "Charlotte 49ers." Niners is also a correct second reference.

The 2008 Charlotte 49ers were the first to win consecutive league tournament titles and the second squad (1995) to achieve back-to-back regular season crowns. The Niners have set school records for consistency by recording five straight 30-plus win seasons, three consecutive 35-plus win seasons and two straight seasons of 40-plus wins. Charlotte has also won 20 or more home games in four straight seasons.

#### NINERS AT ATLANTIC 10 CHAMPIONSHIPS

Charlotte has won its last six tournament games (setting numerous offensive records in the 2007 tournament) to win the last two A-10 Championships, securing automatic berths to the NCAA Regionals. Charlotte went two-and-out at their inaugural trip to the tournament, as the four seed in 2006. This season, Charlotte tied for fourth, but lost tiebreakers to both Fordham and Massachusetts to slide to the six seed. The Niners will need to win four games to secure a league-record third-straight title.

#### CLIMB THROUGH THE STANDINGS

After a 1-7 start in league play, Charlotte has won 15 of its last 19 Atlantic 10 Conference games to climb into a tie for fourth-place in the league. The Niners were tied for last place at 1-7 before going the other direction and emerging with a winning record in league play for the first time this season. In the 1-7 start, Charlotte was averaging 6.4 runs scored and an ERA of 9.40 and no saves, but in the last 19 league games, the Niners have scored 9.7 runs per contest and have an ERA of 4.97, with five saves.

#### HEAD COACH LOREN HIBBS ECLIPSES 500-WIN MARK

Entering his 17th season, head coach Loren Hibbs continues to extend his mark as the all-time winningest coach in the program's history. His record now stands at 527-421-3 (55.7%) overall. The 2009 season opener was his 900th career game as the Niner skipper. He won number 500 in the first game of the Columbia doubleheader on March 7. Charlotte signed him to a multi-year contract heading into this season, through 2012.

#### KING KONG IS LOOSE

Sophomore Ryan Rivers is having a "monster" season at the plate in his first year as a position player. He has belted 18 home runs so far this year (tops in the conference), none bigger than the two solo home runs he hit out on March 24 at No. 5 North Carolina. It was all Charlotte needed in the 2-1 victory on the road over the Tar Heels, the first win at North Carolina since April 20, 1988. Six of Rivers' homers have given Charlotte the lead. Rivers set a career-high with seven RBI on April 7 against N.C.A&T. His tenth homer of the season was also significant, as it gave him the cycle (along with his first career triple) in the first game of the George Washington doubleheader. He was the second Niner to hit for the cycle since joining the Atlantic 10 (Mike Ambrose vs. Indiana on 2/26/06) and the third since 1992 (Darren Vazquetelles vs. North Carolina on 2/17/92) to record all four types of base hits. Rivers finished that game tied with the third-longest consecutive at bats with a hit streak at eight. He was also named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic First-Team All-District II squad. He has hit at least one homer in each of his last six road conference games.

## **NO PLACE LIKE HOME**

Charlotte finished the final homestand Tuesday. Charlotte was 26-7 last season at Robert and Mariam Hayes Stadium, the fourth-most home wins in a season in team history (29 in 1998, 28 in 2006 and 27 in 1985). The Niners are 60-18 in the refurbished stadium since the park reopened on March 30, 2007, and were 20-9 at home this season. This senior class has a 98-27 (78.4%) home record since 2006.

## **BIG MIDWEEK ROAD WINS**

Charlotte won a pair of important road games on back-to-back days in late March at Winthrop (Receiving Votes in the USA Today Top 25 Coaches Poll) and at No. 5 North Carolina, holding these two opponents to a combined seven hits and one run. The last win for Charlotte on the road versus a top-five program was March 5, 2008 at No. 3 South Carolina. The shutout on March 24 against Winthrop was the first for the Niners since a May 19, 2007 blanking (7-0) at Richmond. Charlotte broke a school record for margin of victory on April 7 in a 31-1 win over North Carolina A&T.

## **BY THE NUMBERS**

In '09, the Niners are 22-4 when the opposition scores five or fewer runs. When an opponent in '09 has scored 7+ runs, Charlotte is 4-14. Charlotte is allowing just 5.8 runs per game this season. In 28 home games, the Niners averaged 9.1 runs per game, and kicked up the road scoring with 39 runs at Duquesne, 29 at Temple, 17 at USC Upstate, 27 more at Saint Louis and 33 runs at St. Bonaventure to finish at exactly eight per game on the road. Charlotte has scored five or more runs in 28 of its last 30 games, with a total of 295 runs in that span (9.8 per contest). Charlotte also has 153 two-out RBI (out of 409 total) this season, allowing just 84 from opponents.

## **LYERLY ON THE RADAR**

After leading the Atlantic 10 during his sophomore season in slugging (.705), doubles (26) and RBI (76) while playing 1B and DH, junior first baseman Lyerly was named to three preseason All-America lists in 2009 (Louisville Slugger/Collegiate Baseball, Recruiting Closer, College Baseball Insider.com) and is among the initial 50 names on the preseason Golden Spikes Award list. Last summer, Lyerly won the Northwoods League batting title, with a .342 average and was listed as the number-five prospect by Baseball America and the 15th prospect on the Perfect Game Crosschecker list. He was second in the league with 48 RBI and 19 doubles, both Madison Mallards team records, and was a NWL All-Star. His .474 slugging percentage also led the team. He played in left field for the Mallards.

Despite missing 12 games due to injury, Lyerly is batting .390 with 16 doubles, ten homers and a .688 slugging percentage for the Niners this season in 40 games. Even with missing the first league series, Lyerly leads Charlotte in hitting, doubles and slugging. He is in the top six in the league in all three categories. He was also named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic Second-Team All-District II squad.

## **START IT UP**

In 2009, Charlotte starting pitchers already have a pair of complete games (both of 88-pitch length) and have an ERA of 5.10 in 266.1 innings pitched. In 21 of 52 games, starters have lasted five or more innings and allowed two or fewer earned runs, and are 13-2 when they did. In 2008, starters factored in 32 (22-10) of 59 decisions. In 2009, that number is 33 (19-14) of 52. Part of the reason that the starters have gotten wins is that the offense has averaged more than a run per game in the first, third, fourth and seventh innings.

## **BIG SWINGS TO START SEASON**

Three batters hit home runs in their first at bat of 2009. Rob Lyerly hit a homer in the first inning in game one against Clemson on Feb. 20. Later in the game, pinch hitter Michael Gyoerkoe blasted a homer in his first plate appearance of the season. In Charlotte's home opener, outfielder Shane Brown, in his first career at bat, launched a line drive to right center that became an inside-the-park grand slam to break a four-all tie. Charlotte has had 13 players hit a big fly this season, three more than the 10 who homered in 2008 and six more than the seven players homering in 2007. Of Charlotte's 60 home runs, 22 have either tied the game or given Charlotte the lead. The Niners earlier hit a home run in nine straight games, a streak that included 18 total and ended on April 12. The Niners have belted 24 home runs in their last 16 games.

## **WILSON BREAKS CONSECUTIVE AT BATS WITH HIT MARK**

Sophomore right fielder Justin Wilson had a great start to his 2009 season. With two hits to finish up game three of the Columbia series on March 8, a 5-for-5 day in a March 11 win over Furman and hits in his first three plate appearances on March 13 against Presbyterian, Wilson broke the school record with hits in 10 straight at bats. The record of eight was set by Bo Robinson in 1997 and tied during the 2008 season by current junior Rob Lyerly and this season by Ryan Rivers.

## BIG RETURNING NUMBERS FROM BRAY

According to boydsworld.com, Aaron Bray is one of the top career stats leaders playing in college baseball entering the 2009 season. Coming into the season, he is listed tops among active players in walks (106), second in runs (169) and fifth in hits (229). So far this season, he has added 28 more walks, 41 more runs and 58 more hits this season. He is on pace to become Charlotte's all-time career leader in hits and runs. He needs just two more hits and six more runs to accomplish that feat. Bray joins Kevin Ayers as the second player in team history with 200 career hits and runs.

## 2008 TROPHY CASE

Lyerly was named 2008 Most Outstanding Player of the Atlantic 10 Tournament after driving in eight runs on six hits in three Charlotte tournament wins. He was joined on the All-Tournament Team by teammates O'Brien Taylor, Alex Burt and Luke Stahl. Lyerly is the second straight MOP winner, following Shayne Moody's award in 2007.

For their efforts in the 2008 postseason, Chris Taylor and Aaron Bray were named to the All-Raleigh, N.C. Regional team.

A school-record and league-high nine Niners earned All-Atlantic 10 honors in 2008. Senior Chris Taylor was the Co-Player of the Year, the third time in school history that honor was bestowed on a 49er (Tim Collie, 1995 and James Matan, 1998). Corey Shaylor was the second Rookie of the Year for Charlotte in three years in the A-10 (Aaron Bray, 2006) and the third Rookie of the Year in Charlotte history (Mike Taylor, 2000) Brad McElroy, Rob Lyerly and Kelly McLain joined Chris Taylor on the A-10 first-team All-Atlantic 10 squad. Shaylor, Aaron Bray, Shayne Moody, O'Brien Taylor and Joe Yermal were named to the second-team. Alex Burt was named to the All-Academic team. Shaylor and Yermal were named to the All-Rookie team. Charlotte has now won 93 All-Conference awards, and the 26th straight year a Niner earned All-Conference.

## Excellence On and Off the Field

The Charlotte baseball program was among the Top 10 percent (31 programs in the country total) honored by the NCAA for outstanding academic progress. The Academic Progress Rate, or APR, released by the NCAA listed Charlotte baseball, women's tennis and volleyball among the programs with outstanding numbers in the country. The NCAA honors teams that earned multi-year APR scores in the top 10 percent of all squads in their respective sports..

The APR provides a real-time look at a team's academic success each semester by tracking the academic progress of each student-athlete. The APR includes both retention at an institution and academic eligibility in its calculation and provides a clear picture of the academic culture in each sport.

The most recent APR scores are multi-year rates based on the scores from the 2004-05, 2005-06, 2006-07 and 2007-08 academic years.

In all, the NCAA is honoring 767 Division I sports teams or about 11.8 percent of all 6,484 Division I teams (last year, 11.4 percent were recognized).

The baseball program joins the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and Vanderbilt as the only three programs that boast a Top 10% APR number and a Top 10 winning percentage in college baseball in the past three seasons. Baseball's current team cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) is 2.94 at the end of the fall semester of 2008. Charlotte has a record of 157-67 (70.1%) since 2006 and is currently 32-20 in 2009.
