Started four of last nine games (2-2) ... Last 9 gms: 22 assists; 4 TO ... Career-high 7 assists (1 TO) vs. DePaul ... Two backcourt steals for dunks vs. Marq. ... Made six starts Double figures in 1st game of season (10 pts; 4-5 FG vs. Long Beach) Has scored in all but three games (Valpo; UC; SLU) ... high of four rebounds three times ... four or more assists six times ... had five steals in home game vs. Louisville.

2001-02: Taking a medical red-shirt after battling tendonitis ... played in five games, with high of 7 minutes at Long Beach and six minutes vs. #5 Florida ... first career steal came against Temple's Lynn Greer ... scored two points vs. Long Beach and Richmond, with all four points coming on free throws.

Top 100 recruit who gives the 49ers depth in the backcourt ... changed his name from Mitchell Bittle in the fall of his senior year (after his 18th birthday) to take the name of his longtime stepfather, Donnie Baldwin ... ranked as the #1 senior prospect in North Carolina entering his final year.

At Reynolds High: Two-time *Winston-Salem (N.C.) Journal* Player of the Year (Frank Spencer Award) for the two-time 4A State Champions ... is the fifth repeat winner of the Frank Spencer Award and the first to play outside the ACC ... ranked as high as #30 by All-Star Sports; #76 by Prep Stars; #100 by Rivals 100 averaged 17.7 points, 5.1 assists and 2.4 steals as a senior, leading coach Howard West's Demons to back-to-back state titles ... after being named MVP of the 1999 Frank Spencer Classic, Baldwin called his coach to ask to share the award with teammate Jason McDougald, who blocked three shots in the closing seconds of the title tilt ... averaged 17.4 points with 3.1 assists and 2.1 steals as a junior, leading the Demons to a 27-2 record, the 4A state title and a national rank of #23 by USA Today ... was a first-team AAU all-America ... signed with the 49ers over Florida State, Virginia Tech, Wake Forest, Virginia and Oklahoma.

Personal: Parents are Donnie and Bonnie Baldwin, who both work with the Sara Lee Corporation ... has a little brother Desmon, 10 ... was born Nov. 19, 1982.

2002-03: Nominated for C-USA's Defensive Player of the Year ... 49ers leader in rebounds (6.9 - 12th in C-USA) and steals (60); 2nd in assists (69) ... averaging 6.4 points ... ranks third in C-USA in steals with 60, the most by a 49er since 1991 and 6th-best all-time (see chart) ... ranks 5th in C-USA in offensive rebounds (3.0/gm), helping 49ers lead league in that category ... with 6.9 rebounds, is looking to become first wing player to lead 49ers in rebounding since 1st team all-C-USA choice Galen Young (1999) ... tied school-record with seven steals vs. DePaul ... his numbers improve to 7.7 points and 7.2 rebounds in C-USA play, shooting .532 from the floor ... career-high 19 points vs. Southern Miss ... double-figures in four C-USA games (USM, 19; Cincy, 10; @UAB, 15; Marq., 13) ... seven or more rebounds 17 times ... hit first 19 free throws of season for string of 21 straight dating to last year ... 17 multiple-steal games ... season-high 10 rebounds at Indiana and at East Carolina.

2001-02: Nominated for C-USA's Defensive Player of the Year ... regular in the 49ers main seven-man rotation ... averaged 18.9 minutes ... solid numbers of 4.3 points; 4.3 rebounds and .469 FG% ... second on the team with 42 steals; fourth in rebounding ... career-best 5 steals in win over #25 Marquette ... top game with career-best 12 points (5-10 FG); 9 rebounds and four steals at Miami ... had nine points vs. Louisville; eight points at Marquette and seven vs. East Carolina ... had 12 rebounds in win over DePaul; nine vs. Tulane and seven in wins vs. Memphis and UTEP ... came off knee surgery (left knee - meniscus) in summer, '01 but showed signs of the expected explosiveness as year went on ... suffered back spasms during C-USA Tournament that limited his practice time/playing time ... Athletic swing was a top 100 recruit who helped offset the loss of outgoing senior swing

James Zimmerman ... explosive, athletic, versatile, Basden fit well with the 49ers uptempo style of play ... rated sixth-best wing guard at adidas ABCD Camp and one of nation's top 10 wing guards according to Bob Gibbons of All-Star Sports.

At Roosevelt High: Averaged 18.5 points, 7.5 rebounds, four steals and three assists to lead the Raiders to the 4A state finals (runner-up to Magruder) ... was ranked as high as #72 by Prep Stars, #78 by All-Star Sports, #82 by Sporting News and #87 by Hoop Scoop ... Prince George's County Player of the Year ... first team all-D.C.

Metropolitan Area (all-Met) ... selected to play in the Capitol Classic All-Star Game (15 points) and the Charm City Challenge All-Star Game (13 points) ... completed his career as Roosevelt's all-time leader in points (1119), assists (288) and steals (277) ... led his AAU team to a 65-6 record and a #6 National Ranking ... originally signed with Massachusetts but was given a release when head coach Bruiser Flint resigned ... chose the 49ers over Villanova, West Virginia and Providence.

Said high school head coach Glenn Farello: "He's a highlight film waiting to happen. Eddie is an extremely versatile ballplayer. He doesn't have to score to have an impact on the game."

Said AAU Coach Sam Harris of Sky's the Limit: "He's called Superman around here. He is so explosive. He's an amazing dunker. He's a special kid."

2002-03: Team's leading scorer who leads the nation in three-pointers made and has scored 20 or more points 12 times ... has broken school and C-USA records for threes in a season (134; 4.79/gm); the C-USA record for threes in league games (78; 4.88/gm) and the school record for threes in a game (9, at UAB) ... has cleared the 1000-point plateau and moved up to #15 all-time in 49ers history ... was informed by the NCAA that he has earned his fourth year of eligibility ... his 4.78 three-pointers per game rank 2nd all-time in NCAA history and his 134 threes rank 6th.

What Can Brown Do For You?: Brown has scored 20 or more points in eight of the last 15 games and 12 games overall. He's had 18 games of 15 or more points. He's 6th in C-USA with an 17.1 scoring average that improves to 17.5 points in C-USA play (6th). He has scored 15 or more points in 19 games and has scored in double figures in all but four games (1-3). Brown is 2nd on the team with 37 steals. He became the 18th player in 49ers history to score 1000 career points when he scored 22 at Cincinnati. With 264 career threes, Brown is #3 all-time for the 49ers, behind Jobey Thomas and Henry Williams and #2 all-time in C-USA, trailing all-time leader Thomas. He has led the 49ers in scoring 18 times this year. Career-high six steals vs. Long Beach.

Triple Talk: His 134 threes rank 6th all-time in NCAA history and he is hoping to become just the 2nd player in NCAA Div. I history to average at least 5.0 threes per game. He has broken the 49ers and C-USA's single-season record for threes, set last season (110, Jobey Thomas). He has broken C-USA record for threes in league games (78; 4.88/gm). He broke the 49ers single-game school record (shared by Brown; Diego Guevara and Henry Williams) with nine threes at UAB on his way to a career-high 32 points. The NCAA record for threes in a season is 158 (5.64/gm) by Darrin Fitzgerald of Butler in 1987. Fitzgerald is the only player to average at least 5.0 threes per game. Brown's 4.78 threes per game are currently second best in NCAA Div. I history ... he has more three-pointers than DePaul (120); East Carolina (119) and Southern Miss (110). Is shooting a career-best .394 from long-range. He's hit at least 4 threes in all but six games.

2001-02: Team-high 125 assists (4.2/game) ... career-best 1.76 A-T-O ratio ... averaged double figures for the second straight year (11.3 ppg); posted 11.4 scoring average in C-USA games ... second straight year with 100 or more assists ... led team with 45 steals ... double figures in 11 of last 17 games; 17 games (13-4) overall ... season-high 27 points at Long Beach State (11-16 FG; 5-7 3FG), with 21 coming first half ... career-high 12 assists vs. Valparaiso, becoming first 49er since Dalonte Hill (10 assists vs. Davidson, Dec. 1999) to pass out double-figure dishes ... averaged 14.0 points at C-USA Tourney, shooting .429 from three-point range (6-of-14).

2000-01: Team-high 128 assists (4.0/game) ... scored in double figures 20 times, including first 17 games ... named C-USA Player of the Week for the week ending Dec. 3 following 16-point effort in 32-point win over Miami and then-career-best 23 points (7-11 threes) in 21-point win over South Carolina ... his seven threes vs. South Carolina matched the C-USA individual high for the season ... ranked 25th in C-USA with 11.7 scoring average ... career-high 28 pts. (9-15 FG) with career-bests in assists (8) and steals (5) in win at UTEP ... Dished out 14 assists in three games at the OCG Conference USA Tournament, including eight assist-no turnover outing in quarterfinals versus South Florida ... scored 10 in the semifinals against Southern Miss and had team-high 19 points in NCAA 2nd round loss to Illinois ... five games with 20 or more points ... named all-tournament at NC State's CoSIDA Classic ... ranked 4th in C-USA with a 1.66 assist-turnover ratio and seventh with 4.0 assists per game ... hit 65 threes to rank 10th in C-USA (2.03/gm)

1999-00: Sat out first year while attending the university ... Earned a spot on the Conference USA Commissioner's Honor Roll ... Participated in strength and conditioning workouts with the 49ers.

At Maine Central Institute (Pittsfield, Maine): Proved to be a quick point guard with good physical strength ... Averaged 17 points and 9 rebounds at MCI ... A good three-point shooter ... Excellent off the dribble ... Chose Charlotte over Connecticut and Xavier ... Considered one of the top prep school point guards by Bob Gibbons, of All-Star Sports ... Was ranked as high as second among prep school point guards.

At Randallstown (Md.) High School: A top 100 rated player ... Averaged 28.8 points and 7.0 assists as the team's top offensive weapon.

Personal: Demon Brown was born May 15, 1980 ... Initially signed with Charlotte in the fall of 1998 ... A member of the 49ers' 19th-ranked recruiting class.
