49ers Open Final Non-Con Homestand, Tuesday

The Charlotte 49ers (9-2), winners of seven of eight, open their final non-conference homestand, Tuesday at 7:30 vs. Mercer (WBCN Radio, 1660 AM - Matt Swierad). The game starts a two-game homestand that includes a Jan. 2 tip-off vs. Georgia Tech (7:00; FOX SportsSouth). Charlotte is unbeaten at home (4-0) with double-digit victories in each of the four victories.

At 9-2, the 49ers are off to one their best starts under head coach Bobby Lutz and their recent seven-game win streak is one of the 49ers' longest under Lutz. The 49ers started the 2004-05 season with a 12-2 record, following a Lutz-best 9-game win streak after a 2-2 start. That is only season under Lutz that the 49ers have completed December with just two losses.

OFFENSE:

Charlotte is averaging 77.2 points while shooting .441 from the field, which are among the best offensive numbers the 49ers have put up under head coach Bobby Lutz. The highest scoring average under Lutz is 79.1 (2003-04) and in each of the three seasons that the 49ers have averaged over 75.0 points per game, they have reached the NCAA Tournament. Of note, though, after scoring 80 or more points in six straight games, Charlotte has scored under 60 in the last two.

DEFENSE:

Six of the last seven opponents have shot under 38%. Overall, opponents are shooting .391. Only two opponents (Duke; ODU) have scored over 75 points, but Charlotte has lost both of those games. Overall opponents are scoring 68.8 points per game. In 49ers wins, opponents are averaging 63.9 points while shooting just .359.

SEASON'S GREETINGS:

Charlotte is 5-1 in December this year and was a perfect 4-0 last December (including road wins at Mississippi State and Southern Illinois). That gives Charlotte a 9-1 mark over the last two Decembers.

SHOOTER'S TOUCH:

Over the last five games, forward Chris Braswell is shooting .676 (23-34). Last 4: Shamari Spears is shooting .535 (23-of-43); Charles Dewhurst 857 (6-7). Last 3: An'Juan Wilderness .800 (8-10).

FROM ESPN.COM (ANDY KATZ): Charlotte and freshman Chris Braswell among his Team and Player of the Week considerations:

"Give credit where credit is due: Charlotte ran the Ville out of Freedom Hall in an 87-65 win. It was the worst home loss of the Rick Pitino era. As bad as the 49ers looked at Duke in mid-November, they have improved. They could be a real player in the Atlantic 10."

"The 49ers needed more diversity in scoring and found that in Braswell in a shockingly easy 22-point win at Louisville. Braswell was incredibly efficient in scoring 21 points and grabbing 14 boards. He finished 9-of-12 from the field and made all three of his free throw attempts."

ROAD WARRIORS:

Charlotte is 5-2 on the road including a 3-2 mark in "true" road games, with wins at Hofstra, #20/#18 Louisville and Winthrop. Last year, Charlotte was 2-14 on the road.

NEW BLOOD: Several newcomers have played prominent roles for the 49ers this season, led by junior scoring leader Shamari Spears, who is averaging 17.3 points while shooting .545 from the field. Freshman Chris Braswell leads the 49ers in rebounding (8.4/gm) and has already posted four double-doubles, including a 21-point; 14-rebound outpouring at #20/#18 Louisville. The top eight single-game scoring performances belong to newcomers, including Spears' four 20+ outings, 20-point outings from red-shirt freshman Shamarr Bowden (21 vs. UNC Asheville), freshman Chris Braswell (21 points at #20/#18 Louisville), and sophomore Derrio Green (20 points at #20/#18 Louisville) as well as Green's 18-point outing vs. Yale.

TOP 25 WINS:

Charlotte's 22-point victory over #20/#18 Louisville is the largest margin of victory for head coach Bobby Lutz over a nationally-ranked opponent. It also marks the third straight year that the 49ers have posted a top 25 win, a first for the 49ers under Lutz:

SKED STRENGTH (AP/ESPN USA TODAY POLLS LISTED):

Charlotte will play five teams that were consensus preseason top 25 teams (#9/#8 Duke, #10/#11 Tennessee, #19/#23 Louisville, #21/#22 Dayton and #22/#20 Georgia Tech). Two other foes: Xavier and Old Dominion were receiving votes in the preseason polls. Charlotte is 1-1 thus far vs. top 25 opponents (W, 87-65 vs. Louisville; L, 59-101 at Duke). The next nationally-ranked foe: RV/#22 Georgia Tech, Jan. 2.

DOUBLE-UP:

Freshman Chris Braswell is second all-time with four double-doubles in his rookie season. Of note, former standouts Curtis Withers (2003 Conference USA all-Rookie Team), Rodney White (2001 ESPN.com National Freshman of the Year; 2001 C-USA Freshman of the Year) and Cedric Maxwell all had three double-doubles in their first seasons. The record for a freshman is 15 (Jarvis Lang, 1990-91). Clinton Hinton had seven double-doubles as a freshman in 1984-85, 2nd on the list.

STREAK:

Charlotte's seven-game win streak is the 49ers fifth of 7 or more under Lutz. The last came in 2004-05, going 9-0 to jump to a 12-2 start and 7-0 in February. They won 7 straight in 2001-02 and 8 straight in Lutz's first season of 1998-99. Each of those seasons were NCAA seasons.

**HEAD COACH
BOBBY LUTZ:**

The 49ers all-time winningest coach, Bobby Lutz (pronounced "Loots") is 208-148 (.583) in his 12th year as head coach of the Charlotte 49ers. In his 21st career year, he owns a career mark of 389-239 (.619). He holds the 49ers career coaching record with five NCAA Tournament trips. He is the first coach in 49ers history to reach 200 career win and just the second to reach 100 wins (Jeff Mullins, 182-142). Lutz has advanced to post-season play in eight of 11 seasons (NCAA - 1999; 2001; 2002; 2004; 2005; NIT - 2000; 2006; 2008); earned five berths to the NCAA Tournament (advancing to the 2nd round twice), won two C-USA Tournament titles (1999, 2001) and one C-USA regular-season title (2004).

In 2005, he was a finalist for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award after going 21-8 and advancing as high as #18 in the AP poll. In 2004, he was named the Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year by Basketball Times after a 21-9 season that included a perfect 3-0 record vs. Top 10 teams.

In 1999, he became the third 49ers first-year coach to amass a 20-win season (Lee Rose; Melvin Watkins). He is 13-8 in conference tournament action; and 2-5 in the NCAA Tournament.

He produced a 23-11 record in his first season, capturing the Conference USA Championship with four wins in four days and an NCAA Tournament berth. That team produced the program's highest NCAA seed (#5), the program's highest RPI (#18) and a final AP rank of #24.

Lutz, a 1980 UNC Charlotte High Honors graduate, coached Pfeiffer University from 1986-95 and produced a program-best record of 181-91 (.665) including marks of 22-11, 29-4, 30-5, 23-6, 24-6 and 25-8 in his last six seasons for a combined mark of 153-42 (.785) from 1990-95. His Falcons played in six straight NAIA National Tourneys, including the "Final Four" in 1991, '92, and '95 (title game), the "Elite Eight" in 1990 and the "Sweet 16" in 1994.

Lutz joined the Charlotte program as an assistant in Jeff Mullins' 11th and final year (he retired), 1995-96, and was a Melvin Watkins' assistant from 1996-98. He was named head coach April 9, 1998 after being appointed Interim Head Coach, March 31.

A resident of Harrisburg, N.C., Lutz was Grand Marshall of the 2001 Harrisburg, N.C. 4th of July Parade, and was presented a key to the city following the

team's 2001 C-USA Championship.

AWARDS AND HONORS FOR LUTZ:

Bobby Lutz was a finalist for the 2005 Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award after leading Charlotte to a 21-8 record and C-USA runner-up finish and a four-week stay in the national polls. He was the 2004 Mid-Atlantic Region Coach of the Year by Basketball Times after leading Charlotte to a 21-9 record, a share of the Conference USA Regular-Season Championship and a berth in the NAAs.

Lutz was inducted into the UNC Charlotte Alumni Hall of Fame, Nov. 9, 2002. In the summer of 2002, he was named Carolinas "Father of the Year". Lutz is on the Pfeiffer University Board of Directors. He was inducted into the Pfeiffer Hall of Fame, Oct. 9, 1999. Pfeiffer hosts the annual Bobby Lutz Tournament in Misenheimer, N.C. each Thanksgiving. Head coach at Pfeiffer for nine years, Lutz put Pfeiffer (N.C.) basketball on the map, taking the NCAA II school to six NAIA Tournaments, including three "Final Fours" and one NAIA National Runner-Up finish.

BRASWELL ON THE BOARDS:

Freshman Chris Braswell leads the 49ers in rebounding (8.4/gm) and has posted four double-doubles. The last 49ers freshman to lead the team in rebounding: Jarvis Lang, 1990-91 (10.6 rpg). Lang led the nation's freshman in scoring and rebounding that season. Only Lang (15) and Clinton Hinton (7, 1984-85) had more double-doubles than Braswell as freshman. Former standouts Cedric Maxwell, Kevin King, Rodney White and Curtis Withers all had three as freshmen. During the recent seven-game win streak Braswell scored in double figures four times with two double-doubles and averaged 10.0 points and 8.9 boards.

BOARDED UP:

Six different players are averaging 4.0 or more rebounds per game for the 49ers, led by freshman Chris Braswell (8.4 rpg) averages 5.8 defensive rebounds per game and junior Phil Jones (5.7 rpg).

DEPTH:

During the seven-game win streak, seven different 49ers scored in double figures at least twice. Overall, 11 different 49ers have scored in double figures in at least one game, four different 49ers have posted a game with 20 or more points and eight have had multiple double-digit games. 11 49ers are averaging at least 10 minutes per game and 15 have hit the scoring column.

TURNAROUND:

Charlotte, which is off to a 9-2 start, opened the 2008-09 season with a 1-6 record and is two wins shy of matching last year's win total (11). With a 5-2 record on the road, Charlotte has more than doubled last year's road win total (2-14).

FANTASTIC FROSH:

Red-shirt freshman Shamarr Bowden and freshman forward Chris Braswell are enjoying impact seasons in their rookie years. Both already have an A-10 Rookie of the Week award to their credit. Bowden, who leads the team with 22 three-pointers made, has scored in double figures three times, including 21 in his debut vs. UNC Asheville and 17 at #20/#18 Louisville. Braswell, who leads the team in rebounding (8.4/game), has four double-doubles, including a career-best 21-point; 14-rebound double-double in the 22-point win at #20/#18 Louisville.

DIJUAN'S DISH:

Senior point guard DiJuan Harris, who led the A-10 in assists last year, is back on the A-10 leaderboard with 5.3 assists per game (2nd-A-10). He has passed out a season-high eight assists vs. Winston-Salem State and had seven assists with just one turnover to key the 49ers 22-point win at #20/#18 Louisville. His 2.6 A-TO ratio ranks fourth in the A-10. He has led the A-10 in that category the last two years. Harris ranked 4th in the NCAA in assists and 6th in A-TO ratio, last year. Harris ranks 8th all-time with 386 career assists, 14 shy of becoming the 8th 49er to reach 400 career assists.

CHARITY STRIPE:

Charlotte is shooting .739 from the foul line -- the best-ever under 12th-year head coach Bobby Lutz (.708; 2001-02). Junior Charles Dewhurst is 17-of-19 from the line (.895) and had a string of 23 straight dating back to last season snapped vs. East Carolina. Senior point guard DiJuan Harris is shooting .785 (51-of-65) from the line, and is averaging 5.9 free throws per game. Junior Shamari Spears is shooting .780 (39-of-50) and is averaging 5.0 free throws per game. The 49ers are averaging 24.4 free throws per game. Last year, they averaged 19.4.

JONES' BLOCK PARTY:

Junior center Phil Jones ranks 2nd in the A-10 with 27 blocked shots (2.7/game), including a career-high 7 vs. Elon in the first round of the NIT Season Tip-Off. Jones led the 49ers with 43 blocks (1.4/gm), last year, which are the 10th most in a single-season in school history. With 92 career blocks, he is 6th all-time and is 2 shy of the top 5 (94, T4 - Rodney Odom; Cedric Maxwell) and 8 shy of becoming the 4th 49er to block 100 shots in his career.

GREEN'S DAY:

Sophomore combo guard Derrio Green's day has come. After getting off to a 1-for-14 start from three-point range (.071) through the first three games, Green has hit 21-of-61 treys (.344) over the last eight games (7-1) with three double-figure games (20 at Louisville; 18 vs. Yale; 12 at Hofstra).

First three games: .238 FG%; .071 3FG%; 3.7 ppg;

Last eight: .338 FG%; .344 3FG%; 10.4 ppg.

SPEARS STRENGTH:

The 49ers are led by the play of junior power forward Shamari Spears, who scored 20 or more points in each of his first four games and owns a team-high 17.3 scoring average. A one-time recipient of the A-10 Player of the Week honor, Spears is shooting .545 from the field; .780 from the line, and averaging 4.7 rebounds and 5.0 FTA/game.

20-SOMETHING:

By scoring 20 or more points in each of his first four games, junior Shamari Spears got off to the best start of any first-year player in history and neared Jarvis Lang's run of five straight 20+ games in 1990-91 -- the most by a 49ers first-year player at any point in the season. Overall, all-time leading scorer Henry Williams holds the record with 11 straight games of 20 or more points in 1989-90. With four straight, Spears joined some elite company (see chart, page 2).

DEBUTS:

Red-shirt freshman Shamarr Bowden, freshman forward Chris Braswell and junior Shamari Spears made their 49ers debuts in fine fashion. Bowden hit 6-of-11 threes in scoring 21 points in the 49ers victory over UNC Asheville. Braswell notched a 10-point; 11-rebound double-double in his collegiate debut vs. UNC Asheville. Spears hit 10-of-17 shots to score a game-high 23 points as the Niners downed Elon in the NIT Season Tip-Off First Round.

With his 21-point debut, Bowden became the first 49er freshman since 2001 ESPN.com National Freshman of the Year Rodney White to score 20 or more points in his debut (22 pts. v. Fordham, 2000 CoSIDA).

With his double-double debut Braswell became the first freshman to start his career with a double-double since Jarvis Lang (21 points; 15 rebounds vs. NC A&T, 1990-91)

Bowden and Braswell are the first 49ers freshmen to score 20 or more points in a game since teammate An'Juan Wilderness (21 points against Wake Forest; 11/29/07). Prior to that, Leemire Goldwire scored 22 points vs. Yale as a freshman in the Cable Car Classic, Dec. 28, 2004.

MULTIPLICITY:

For the 15th time in conference history and sixth since 2000, the Atlantic 10 earned multiple at-large berths to the 2009 NCAA Men's Basketball Championship. League champion Temple was joined by Dayton and Xavier in the field of 65. The league received two of just four at-large bids awarded to non-BCS conferences and over the past two years, the A-10 leads all non-BCS conferences with six NCAA berths.

PRESEASON TALK:

Charlotte was picked to finish 7th in the 14-team Atlantic 10 in a preseason poll of the league's coaches and selected media. Senior DiJuan Harris was a preseason second team all-Atlantic 10 choice while Shamarr Bowden was named to the A-10's preseason all-Rookie team. Dayton was picked to win the league followed by Xavier, Richmond and LaSalle.

THE KISSING BANDIT:

Senior shooter Ian Andersen, who blows kisses to his wife, Jill, after every made three-pointer, scored 15 or more points in seven games and scored in double digits 18 times, last year. The 49ers second-leading scorer, Andersen knocked down 81 three-pointers. He shot .355 from long-range. He hit 5-of-7 threes in the Niners win over #16/#17 Xavier on his way to a game-high 16 points. He hit a career high 7 treys (7-of-11) vs. Clemson, on his way to a career-best 21-point effort and nailed 6 second-half threes in the Niners comeback win at Southern Illinois. He had 5 vs. Xavier, at Duquesne and vs. Winthrop. He now has 173 career three-pointers made, 9th all-time in school history, 1 shy of #8 De'Angelo Alexander (174) and 27 shy of becoming the seventh 49er to reach 200.

THREE 49ERS TAKEN IN NBDL DRAFT:

Three former Charlotte 49ers were selected in the 2009 NBDL Draft, including Curtis Withers, who was taken with the 11th overall pick in the first round by the Dakota Wizards. Also selected were former stars Leemire Goldwire and De'Angelo Alexander.

Withers, one of just three players in school history to earn first team all-conference honors three times, is the 49ers third all-time leading rebounder and seventh all-time leading scorer. He helped the 49ers to three post-season appearances, including the 2004 and 2005 NCAA Tournaments. A three-time team MVP, Withers led Charlotte to a share of their first Conference USA regular-season title in 2004. He graduated with 1750 career points and 1042 career rebounds -- one of just three players to eclipse the 1500 point mark and the 1000 rebound plateau.

Two-time team MVP Leemire Goldwire (52nd pick; 4th round), who scored thirty or more points six times while averaging 18.6 points during his senior season in 2008 was taken by Sioux Falls. Alexander (117th; 8th rd.), a 2006 first team all-Atlantic 10 choice who led the 49ers in scoring in both 2006 (17.0 ppg) and 2007 (17.6 ppg) was taken by Rio Grande Valley.

HOME GROWN:

Nine different 49ers hail from North Carolina while three 49ers (Charles Dewhurst, DiJuan Harris, Javarris Barnett) call Charlotte home. Dewhurst played at Charlotte Latin while both Harris and Barnett played at Victory Christian. In addition, freshman KJ Sherrill (Cleveland, N.C./West Rowan) and Shamari Spears (Salisbury, N.C./Salisbury H.S.) are from nearby counties. The Niners have had a nice track record with local talent, including Lew Massey (South Mecklenburg H.S.) Byron Dinkins (East Meck), DeMarco Johnson (North Meck), Jobey Thomas (Independence), and Curtis Withers (West Charlotte) who are all in the 49ers all-time Top 10 scorers. Charlotte-native George Jackson (East Meck), holds the single-game (45 points) and single-season (24.5 ppg) records.

BIG WINS:

The 49ers posted a pair of impressive home wins in the month of February, handing Dayton just its third loss of the season with a 13-point victory, 79-66, Feb. 8. Less than two weeks later the 49ers down #16/#17 Xavier, 65-60. The 49ers were the only A-10 team to defeat both Xavier and Dayton this season. The 49ers were 1-2 in Top 20 games last season and the Xavier win was the 49ers second top 20 win in as many seasons. The 49ers topped #18/#19 Clemson, 82-72, on the road, in 2007-08. Charlotte scored 79 points against Dayton (W, 79-66), which ranked 2nd in the A-10 in scoring defense; and allowed 60 points to Xavier (W, 65-60), who ranked 3rd in the A-10 in scoring.

MORE TV TIME FOR THE A-10 IN 2010:

The league's television schedule for the upcoming season consists of 133 televised contests representing 206 appearances, including the title game of the 2010 Men's Basketball Championship on Mar. 14 at 1:00pm on CBS Sports for the first time in league history. Among the highlights for this season's television schedule: 73 A-10 matchups will air on television this season, an increase of 25 percent from a year ago; an 18 percent increase in the total number of television appearances from last season; greater distribution in A-10 media markets; ESPN will televise 32 men's games on its three networks as part of its college basketball package representing 41 appearances; 10 games will be carried nationally on CBS College Sports Network, including the semifinals of the 2010 A-10 Championship; and 32 league contests will be part of CBS College Sports Network's syndication package, including the quarterfinals of the A-10 Championship.

LUTZ'S MILESTONE WINS:

Bobby Lutz captured his 100th conference win vs. #16/#17 Xavier, 65-50, last year and picked up his 200th overall victory as 49ers head coach vs. UNC Asheville, 86-70, in the season opener, this year. Lutz now owns a 101-74 conference record. Overall, the 49ers' winningest coach has a 208-147 record with the 49ers -- the first 49ers head coach to reach the 200-win plateau.

625 STRAIGHT GAMES WITH A TREY:

After hitting 6 treys vs. Old Dominion, the 49ers have scored at least one three-point field goal in 625 straight games, which includes all 302 games played in the 90s, and every game in the last 20 years. The last game without a trey was in a win over Jacksonville, 2/23/89. The 49ers streak ranks 9th in the nation.

STREAK CONCLUDES:

In each of head coach Bobby Lutz's first 10 years, the 49ers boasted the league leader in three-pointers made or three-pointers made per game. That streak came to an end in 2008-09, when Ian Andersen led the 49ers with 81 three-pointers made (2.61/gm) to rank fifth in the A-10. In 2006-07, Rhode Island's Jimmy Baron led the A-10 in three-pointers made, the first time a 49er had not led their league in Lutz's tenure -- but Charlotte's Leemire Goldwire did lead the league by hitting 3.03 threes per game (91 overall). In 2008-09, Goldwire was 1st in the A-10 in threes made (128) and 2nd in threes made per game (3.76/gm).

CHAMPIONSHIP CHATTER:

Starting in 2010, a new format will be in place for the Atlantic 10 Men's Basketball Championship. The top 12 teams will qualify for the Championship; however the first round games will be hosted on the campuses of teams seeded #5, #6, #7, and #8 on Tuesday, Mar. 9, 2010. The setting for the Championship then shifts to Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, N.J., as the quarterfinal round commences on Friday, Mar. 12. Semifinal action will take place on Saturday, Mar. 13, with the Championship game held on Sunday, Mar. 14, and televised live nationally at 1:00pm on CBS Sports for the first time in A-10 history.

CAPS AND GOWNS:

Over the last five years, the 49ers have graduated 14 seniors that have exhausted their eligibility. May, 2009: Charlie Coley, III; May, 2008: Leemire Goldwire; Sean Phaler, December, 2007: Jerell Jamison. May, 2007 E.J. Drayton and Travis Gordon. The entire senior class of 2006: Curtis Withers, Chris Nance, Marcus Bennett, Mitchell Baldwin and Tripp Miller all graduated as did the 2005 senior class: Eddie Basden, Brendan Plavich and Chris Sager.

LUTZ BAREFOOTS FOR RELIEF ORGANIZATION:

Head coach Bobby Lutz will coach barefoot, Jan. 17 vs. Saint Louis as part of an effort to raise awareness for Samaritan's Feet.
