WNIT - The 49ers improved their school-record postseason tournament streak to six straight seasons. Seniors Sabrina Gregory and Whitney Hoey join former 49ers Pam Brown, Sakellie Daniels, Andrea Davidson, assistant coach Krystion Obie and Courtney Williams as the only seven players in school history to be a part of four postseason tournaments. The 49ers have reached the second round of the WNIT in three of the last four years with victories over Clemson, High Points and James Madison. Charlotte has a 6-5 all-time postseason tournament record with appearances in the 2003 NCAA Tournament and the 1990, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008 WNIT.

vs. VCU - The 49ers and VCU were members of the Sun Belt and Metro Conferences at the same time. The 49ers hold a 19-6 series lead including an 81-72 win in their last meeting which came at Halton Arena, December 7, 2003. Charlotte has won 11 of the last 14 meetings between the two teams including the last two meetings. The 49ers first played VCU in 1980 in a game that the 49ers won 80-61, January 18, 1980. VCU is a member of the Colonial Athletic Association. The 49ers have also played CAA members George Mason, Hofstra, James Madison, UNC Wilmington, Old Dominion and William & Mary during the program's history. The 49ers have a 38-20 all-time record against the CAA.

All-Atlantic 10 - Senior guard Sabrina Gregory earned third-team All-Atlantic 10 honors for the second straight season. Gregory was also named to the A-10 All-Defensive team for the second straight season. She earned her second straight A-10 Academic All-Conference team honor as well. Junior center Danielle Burgin, who earned third-team All-Atlantic 10 honors last season, earned honorable-mention All-Atlantic 10 honors.

Three-Point Shooting - Junior guard Traci Ray connected on her 100th career three-point field goal at UNC Greensboro (November 28). She connected on her 141st career three-point field goal against Dayton which is the second highest total in the program's history. Senior guard Whitney Hoey has moved into eighth place on the school's career three-point field goals made list with 86.

Halton Arena - The 49ers have won 38 of their last 45 home games including a school-record 22-game home winning streak which ended against George Washington, February 15, 2007. This season, the 49ers have posted home wins over Hampton, Davidson, Virginia Tech, Charleston Southern, Clemson, Winthrop, Massachusetts, Saint Louis, La Salle, St. Bonaventure, Saint Joseph's and Richmond. Since 2001-02, the 49ers are 80-15 in Halton Arena. This season, the 49ers averaged 67.9 points in their 15 home games while limiting their 15 opponents to 56.3 points per game.

400 And Counting: Charlotte earned the 400th win in program history on Dec. 7, 2003, beating Virginia Commonwealth, 81-72. The first in school history came at Salem, Jan. 27, 1976, a 58-43 decision. The 49ers currently have 493 wins. In the 33 years since, the program has moved to division I and changed conferences four times. Seven coaches have led the team, starting with Judy Wilkins, now director of athletics Judy Rose through current coach Karen Aston.

2007-08 Game Notes

Atlantic 10 Player of the Week - Senior guard Sabrina Gregory has been named A-10 Player of the Week twice this season and three times for her career. This season, she earned A-10 Player of the Week honors after scoring 19 points with four rebounds, six assists and six steals in the 49ers 76-55 victory over Virginia Tech (December 17). Then, she just claimed her second A-10 Player of the Week award of the season after tallying her first career double-double with 20 points and 11 rebounds in the 49ers 67-57 win at Duquesne (January 12). Junior center Danielle Burgin was named A-10 Player of the Week (November 12) after she averaged a double-double in the 49ers three games in the WBCA Classic.

Gregory amongst the program's career steals and assists leaders - Senior guard Sabrina Gregory tallied a team season-high six steals against Virginia Tech (December 16). With those six steals, Gregory moved into the program's top ten career steals list. She recorded two steals against Rhode Island which moved her past Monica League (2002-05) into seventh place on the program's all-time steals list with 194. She tied her career-high with eight assists against Saint Louis (January 19). She also currently leads the team and ranks seventh in the A-10 with 119 assists which gives her 385 for her career which is the fourth highest total in the program's history. She went over the 100 assists mark for the second time in her career with seven assists at Temple (February 6). She joins Markita Aldridge, Maria Byars, Sakellie Daniels, Monica League, Mia Nance and Elizabeth Walker as the only 49ers in the program's history to record 100 assists in a season twice in their careers.

Assists - Junior guard Traci Ray ranks tenth in assists in the Atlantic 10 with a career-high 101 assists. Gregory is seventh in the A-10 with 119 assists. Ray and Gregory are among two sets of teammates that rank in the top ten in assists in the Atlantic 10 (George Washington's Kimberly Beck and Sarah-Jo Lawrence are the other set of teammates in the league's top ten in assists.) Ray tallied four assists against Richmond (March 1) to go over the 100 assists mark for the first time in her career. Ray and Gregory are only the fourth set of teammates to record 100 assists in the same season in the program's history. Monica League and Sakellie Daniels accomplished that feat twice in 2003-04 and 2004-05. Daniels and Andrea Davidson each had over 100 assists in the 2005-06 season. Also, when Ray became the 14th player in school history to tally 100 assists in a season.

Minutes and Games Played - For the first time in her career, senior guard Sabrina Gregory played all 40 minutes of a game. She did not leave the floor once during the Minnesota game (December 2). She is in fourth place on the program's career minutes played list with 3,426 minutes. Monica League (2002-05) holds the program's career minutes played record with 3,769 minutes. Gregory played in her 123rd career game against Richmond (March 1) which set the program's record for career games played. Gregory played in her 124th career game against Dayton in the A-10 Tournament. Senior guard Whitney Hoey has played in 115 career games which moves her into eighth place in the program's history in career games played.

49ers In Overtime - The 49ers lost to Arizona, 86-77, in overtime in their last game. This game marked the 49ers first overtime game since losing to Houston, 76-73, in the Conference USA Tournament Quarterfinals, March 4, 2005. Charlotte has now lost their last four overtime games. The last time Charlotte won an overtime game was a 73-68 overtime win over Memphis, January 31, 2003. One of the biggest wins in the program's history came in overtime when Charlotte defeated #6 Alabama, 69-67 in overtime, February 18, 1997. The 49ers are 7-12 all-time in overtime games.

Reaching the 70-point mark - The 49ers are 8-1 this season when they score at least 70 points with victories over Hampton, UNC Greensboro, UAB, Virginia Tech, Charleston Southern, Winthrop, La Salle, Fordham and Richmond. The 49ers are 2-0 this season when they reach the 80-point plateau with an 84-55 win over Charleston Southern and a 82-45 win over Winthrop. In the program's history, Charlotte is 328-81 when they score at least 70 points.

1,000 Point Scorers - Senior guard Sabrina Gregory became the 15th player in the program's history to score 1,000 points in their career when she connected on a lay-up with 1:32 left on the first half clock in the Hampton (11/21/07) game. Her six points at Temple moved her into 11th place on the 49ers all-time scoring list.

Double-Figure Rebounds - The 49ers have had 16 double figure rebounds games this season. Junior center Danielle Burgin has had ten double-figure rebound games this season after an 11 rebounds performance at Fordham. Sophomore forward Erin Floyd collected her first career double-figure with 10 rebounds against Arizona and then she tallied her second one with 10 boards at Arkansas State. Wendy Stywalt tallied her first double-figure rebounding game of the season with 10 rebounds against Davidson and her second with 11 boards against Charleston Southern. Sabrina Gregory tallied her first career double-figure rebounds game with 11 boards at Duquesne. Then, Gregory collected a career-high 12 boards against La Salle.

Double-Doubles - The 49ers have had 12 double-doubles this season. Junior center Danielle Burgin has recorded eight double-doubles including an 10 points and 11 rebounds effort at Fordham, February 27. Sophomore forward Erin Floyd collected her first career double-double with 19 points and 10 rebounds

against Arizona, November 11. Floyd then collected her second career double-double with 10 points and 10 assists at Arkansas State, December 30. Sabrina Gregory recorded her first career double-double with 20 points and a 11 rebounds at Duquesne, January 12. After going three plus seasons without a double-double it only took Gregory two and half weeks to collect her second career double-double with 12 points and a career-high 12 rebounds against La Salle, January 30.

Rebounding - The 49ers grabbed a season-high 53 rebounds against Clemson, January 2 which marked the most rebounds by a 49er team since they grabbed 57 rebounds against Puerto Rico, December 20, 2004. The last time prior to the Clemson game that the 49ers grabbed 53 rebounds in a game came against North Carolina A & T, November 19, 2004. The 49ers tied their season-high with 53 boards against La Salle. The 49ers enjoyed a season-high 24 rebounds advantage (53-29) over La Salle. The 49ers 53 rebounds against La Salle marked the third time this season that the 49ers have grabbed at least 50 rebounds in a game. Charlotte grabbed 52 boards against Hampton. Charlotte 50 rebounds at Fordham marked the fourth time this season that the 49ers have grabbed at least 50 rebounds in a game.

Bench Scoring - The 49ers bench has accounted for 666 of the team's 2,034 points this season. The 49ers are averaging 21.5 points per game off the bench this season. Five times this season Charlotte's bench has scored at least 33 points including a season-high 42 points from the bench in the Winthrop game. Shannon McCallum scored 22 points off the bench in the 49ers' 73-63 win over UAB (December 5). Then, Wendy Stywalt scored 12 points off the bench in the 49ers 76-55 win over Virginia Tech (December 16). In the Virginia Tech game, the 49ers bench outscored Virginia Tech's 33-2. In the Charleston Southern game, the bench outscored Charleston Southern, 33-13. In the Arkansas State game, Stywalt, who came off the bench, was one of four Charlotte players in double-figures with 11 points. McCallum came off the bench to score a team game-high 14 points against Clemson. In the Winthrop game, Stywalt led the 49ers with 15 points off the bench while McCallum added 13 points off the bench. Whitney Hoey and Tyhiesha Smith each had six points apiece off the bench in the Winthrop game. Charlotte's bench outscored George Washington's 23-9 (January 26). McCallum came off the bench to score 10 points in the game. In the Saint Joseph's game, McCallum, who came off the bench, was one of three Charlotte players in double-figures with 12 points. The 49ers scored 34 points off the bench at Fordham (February 27). In that game, Danielle Burgin scored ten points and Jabrenta Hubbard scored nine points off the bench. Charlotte scored 30 points off the bench against Richmond led by Traci Ray's 15 points. The 49ers scored 32 points off the bench against Dayton in the A-10 Tournament led by Aysha Jones 10 points.

Double-Figure Scoring Games off the bench - The 49ers have had 18 double-figure scoring games off the bench this season (nine from Shannon McCallum, six from Wendy Stywalt and one from Danielle Burgin, Traci Ray and Aysha Jones). McCallum scored a team season-high 22 points at UAB (December 5) off the bench. McCallum also scored 11 points at Penn State (November 10) and 14 points at Old Dominion (November 17) off the bench. While, Stywalt scored 11 points at Penn State off the bench as well. Stywalt scored 11 points against Hampton (November 21). Stywalt scored 10 points at UNC Greensboro (November 28) and 12 points against Virginia Tech (December 16). McCallum tallied 14 points off the bench in the Charleston Southern (December 20). Stywalt scored 11 points against Arkansas State (December 30). McCallum scored 14 points against Clemson (January 2). Stywalt scored a team game-high 15 points and McCallum tallied 13 points against Winthrop (January 5). McCallum scored 10 points off the bench at George Washington (January 26). McCallum scored 12 points off the bench against Saint Joseph's (February 12). McCallum scored 13 points off the bench at Xavier (February 17). Burgin scored 10 points off the bench at Fordham (February 27). Ray scored 15 points off the bench against Richmond (March 1). Jones scored a team game-high 10 points off the bench against Dayton (March 8).

49ers Sign Three For 2008-09 Season - Charlotte 49ers women's basketball coach Karen Aston announced the signing of three players in her first recruiting class to national letters-of-intent for the 2008-09 season, November 14. She welcomes Jennifer Hailey of Marshville, North Carolina, Nicole Hargraves of Greensboro, North Carolina and Katie Meador of Marble Falls, Texas to the 2008-09 roster.

Hailey, is a 6-foot-3 forward from Marshville's Forest Hills High School, averaged 17.2 points and 13.8 rebounds per game last season as a junior. Hailey enters her senior season with 1,119 career points and 1,005 career rebounds.

Hargraves, a 6-2 forward from Greensboro's Grimsley High School, is a three-time All-Conference Metro 4A selection. She earned *Greensboro News and Record* honorable-mention All-Area honors in each of her three seasons so far at Grimsley. Hargraves enters her senior season with 749 career points, 510 career rebounds and 105 career blocked shots at Grimsley High School.

Meador, a 5-10 guard from Texas' Marble Falls High School, is a three-time all-district selection. She earned first-team all-district honors last two seasons. She has also earned all-district honors as a sprinter on the track team as a freshman and a sophomore. Meador enters her senior season ranked among the Top 150 players in the nation. She is an Adidas Top Ten All-American camper. She is also ranked in the Top 25 players in Texas by *Texas Hoops*. She also plays for the highly successful Lubbock Lady Hawks AAU team.

Packing Them In: The Niners have made a habit of drawing big crowds at Halton Arena in recent years. With 4,525 people turning out for the 49ers game against La Salle (January 30, 2008), the team set a program all-time attendance record. Charlotte had 3,881 people in attendance on Senior Night in their victory over Richmond (March 1) which is the third largest crowd in the program's history. The 49ers had 3,147 people see them defeat Virginia Tech (December 16) which is the fourth largest crowd in the program's history. The top twenty attended games in the program's history have occurred since the 2001 season. The 49ers currently average 1,544 fans per home game.

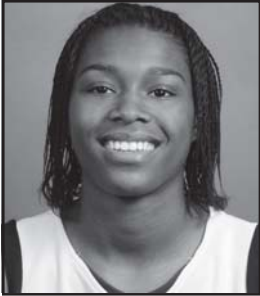

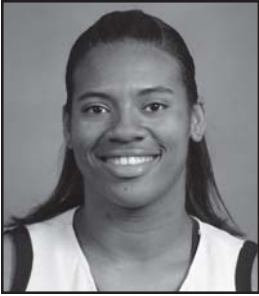
