

2017 NOTRE DAME STUDENT TICKET EXCHANGE

- Available to Notre Dame Students only – undergraduate and graduate.
- A maximum of 100 exchange tickets will be issued per game.
- A maximum of 1 ticket exchange in a season per student (spouse/child tickets are not eligible for exchange)
- The Athletic Ticket Office will oversee the payment and physical exchange of the ticket.
- The student ticket exchange program was created with the intent to accommodate students with family or career obligations who could not attend the game and to accommodate students who had a family member or friend in town who was interested in attending the game. We ask for your cooperation in maintaining the integrity of the “student” section and ensuring a positive environment for all. You are responsible for the behavior and actions of the person using your exchange ticket.
- Tickets may not be sold above face value or be in violation of University policy. du Lac states: “If a student is found to have sold his/her season ticket booklet, or individual game (exchange) tickets, for an amount greater than the face value of the tickets, or have sold his/her tickets to a ticket broker/agency who in turn resells the tickets for an amount greater than face value, he/she will lose his/her ticket privileges for a minimum period of one (1) year and reimburse the University for the amount greater than face value. The student may face additional disciplinary action. Repeat offenders will be subject to stricter penalties up to and including permanent revocation.”

How do you purchase your exchange ticket?

- LOCATION: PURCELL PAVILION TICKET OFFICE
- TIME: 10:00am – 4:00pm
- THESE ARE THE ONLY DATES TO PURCHASE YOUR EXCHANGE TICKET:
 - Temple - Monday, August 28th
 - Georgia - Tuesday, September 5th
 - Miami (OH) - Monday, September 25th
 - USC - Monday, October 16th
 - NC State - Monday, October 23rd
 - Wake Forest - Monday, October 30th
 - Navy – Monday, November 13th
- Students are allowed to bring four (4) valid Notre Dame IDs per student.
- You MUST present the following 3 items in order to exchange your ticket (ALL 3 ITEMS ARE REQUIRED! NO EXCEPTIONS!):

- o (1) Valid Notre Dame Student ID
 - o (2) The first and last name of the person using your exchange ticket at the game.
 - o (3) Payment - Cash or Credit Card (Visa, MasterCard, AMEX, or Discover)
- Cost is the difference between the student discount and a full priced ticket, depending on the game.

Provide the appropriate information to the person using your non-student ticket

- Provide your guest with their game ticket AND the exchange ticket directions for admission.
- Your guest MUST enter the stadium at Gate E.
- Note: When you exchange a game ticket in your student account, your student ticket is VOID for that particular game and cannot be used.
