2017 STUDENT FOOTBALL TICKET POLICY

- Do NOT wait until the last minute to login and access your online application and purchase your student booklet.
- For continuing students, the online student purchase process is your opportunity to purchase student tickets for the 2017 football season.

Eligibility:

- In order to purchase football student tickets, you must be enrolled as a full-time, degree-seeking student and taking classes on the main South Bend campus during the entire Fall 2017 academic term.
- Current eligibility lists are based on the 2017 Spring Semester continuing student reports from the Office of the Registrar.

Ticket Application:

- You are coded in the ticket office system based on your 2017 Spring Semester status provided by the Office of the Registrar.
 - o Spring 2017 Junior = Fall 2017 Senior
 - o Spring 2017 Sophomore = Fall 2017 Junior
 - o Spring 2017 MBA/Law/Grad = Fall 2017 MBA/Law/Grad
 - o Spring 2017 Freshman = Fall 2017 Sophomore

Section Assignment:

- Sections are assigned based on your class year.
 - o 1st Senior
 - o 2nd Junior
 - o 3rd MBA/Law/Grad
 - o 4th Sophomore
 - o 5th Freshman

General Admission:

- Seating is general admission within the designated area for your class.
- Please see the student ticket FAQ's for more information on seating instructions.

Payment/Cost:

- Cost of student football tickets will not increase in 2017.
- Payment may be made with check or credit card (Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover)
- Notre Dame Student Season Tickets \$245.
- Saint Mary's Student Season Tickets \$320.

Students with Disabilities:

Ordering a ticket for your spouse/child:

- Students who wish to purchase two student tickets (student ticket and spouse/child ticket) MUST contact the ticket office to request a second online ticket application.
- Email the ticket office at tickets@nd.edu and include your name, ndID and the name of your spouse/child. Within 48 hours, the ticket office will make available a second application in your online student account.
- A copy of the marriage license/birth certificate is required in order to receive a second ticket. Spouse/child tickets are non-transferable. They are for the personal use of your spouse (or your child, 16 years of age or younger).

I am a continuing student, but.....

There are a limited number of students who are not eligible for student tickets for a variety of reasons....

- Football Players
- Marching Band
- Cheerleaders
- Students Traveling Abroad Fall 2017 Semester
- Other select student groups as designated

The ticket office will automatically refund students by late August if found that you are not eligible for ticket purchase or that your game day responsibilities prohibit you from using your student tickets.

Miscellaneous:

- First-year and transfer students will purchase their tickets in late Summer 2017.
