

Thank You for Registering for the Notre Dame Boys Basketball Camp!

We hope summer camp will be a memorable and exciting experience for you! The information in this packet is very important, so please read it thoroughly and complete the enclosed forms.

What Every Camper Should Know

- Camp Dates:**
- ♣ Boys Basketball, Session 1; June 24 – 28 (Sunday – Thursday)
 - ♣ Boys Basketball, Session 2; July 29 – August 2 (Sunday – Thursday)

- Registration:**
- ♣ Tent in D6 parking lot (behind Security/Human Resources building).

Week 1: 2:00 – 3:30 PM, June 24

Week 2: 2:00 – 3:30 PM, July 29

- Directions:**
- ♣ Notre Dame is located on the outskirts of South Bend, Indiana, approximately 90 miles east of Chicago on the Indiana Toll Road (80/90), Exit 77.
 - ♣ Proceed through Exit 77 toll plaza; turn right onto SR 933/Business 31 South at traffic light.
 - ♣ Follow 933/31 south through two sets of traffic lights.
 - ♣ Turn left (east) on Dorr Road immediately after the WNDU TV/Radio station sign. This drive pulls into the D6 parking lot.

- ♣ Parents are invited to attend league playoffs on the morning of the last day, and any session during the week.

- ♣ **When picking up campers for departure, please PARK IN LOT D6. Specific instructions for departure will be given at Registration.**

- Early Arrivals:**
- ♣ Saturday afternoon arrivals will be considered by the camp director at an **additional \$50.00** charge per camper.
 - ♣ **If approved, a \$50.00 check must be mailed immediately to the camp office.**

- Non-Boarders:**
- ♣ Non-Boarders should register with all other campers.
 - ♣ Non-Boarders should be dropped off at 8:00 AM and picked up at 9:45 PM At the Dorm each day.

If you need to get a message to a camper, please call this number between 8:30 AM and 5:00 PM (Chicago time April – October), Monday – Thursday, and the message will be given to the camp director. Voice Mail will be checked in the evenings.

Housing:

- ♣ The Notre Dame Basketball Camp will be residing on campus in one of the Undergraduate residence halls.
- ♣ Please note that maintenance takes place in the dorms throughout the summer months. Thank you for your patience and understanding.

Health & Safety:

- ♣ A University athletic trainer will be on duty each day during hours of scheduled camp activity.
- ♣ University Health Services facilities or the local hospital will be available 24 hours a day.
- ♣ Camp staff are always on duty in the dorms while the campers are there.
- ♣ University Security stations a monitor in each residence hall utilized by the summer sports camps between 11:00 PM and 7:00 AM.
- ♣ All meals are prepared under the direction of the University dietician and served in the University North Dining Hall.
- ♣ Drugs, alcoholic beverages and cigarettes are strictly forbidden and constitute, along with general misconduct, grounds for immediate dismissal from camp without a refund.
- ♣ The University reserves the right to dismiss anyone displaying unacceptable behavior. Decisions made by the camp director are final.
- ♣ Any damage to the residence halls will be billed to the parents of the campers who have been the cause of the damage or to the parents of the campers who are assigned to the particular room where the damage occurred.

Hotels:

- ♣ For those parents who are planning to stay in the area during camp, rooms may be available at the Alumni Family Hall, located on Notre Dame’s campus. For additional information, please call **219-631-6000**.

Cancellations:

- ♣ If you must cancel, please do so early so that we can notify those on the waiting list.
- ♣ If you cancel, and do so **prior to 2 weeks before** the start of camp, you will receive a refund less a **\$50.00** per session administrative fee. Otherwise, you will receive a refund less a **\$100.00** per session administrative fee.
- ♣ **No refunds will be issued for any reason once a camp session has commenced!**

Camp Bank:

- ♣ The Notre Dame Boys Basketball Camp will provide a camp bank. The bank will hold cash and travelers checks. Plane, train and bus tickets should also be left with the bank.
- ♣ No valuable items should be left in the camper’s room as keys will not be issued to campers.

First Meal:

- ♣ *Please note that the first camp meal will be dinner on Sunday night.*

Last Meal:

- ♣ *Please note the last camp meal will be breakfast on Thursday.*

Checklist of Things to Bring

Below is a suggested list of clothes, equipment and personal items. We recommend that you **do not** bring unnecessary clothes or expensive cameras, radios, TV's, watches or other valuable items that could get lost. **Refrigerators, hot plates, and hot pots are not allowed.** Packages of food that cannot be sealed should not be brought to camp. Notre Dame is not responsible for any personal items brought to camp. Please label everything you bring. All items will be the responsibility of the individual camper. **Notre Dame is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or forgotten items.**

Note: In the past, each camper was furnished with fresh bed linens and towels upon arrival, **however, this is no longer the case** and each camper is now responsible for bringing those items. Additionally, the residence hall is not air-conditioned. We strongly recommend that campers bring **small, portable fans !**
