# Home Cross Country Meets

## Notre Dame Invitational

The 51st running of the Notre Dame Invitational, one of the nation's oldest and largest intercollegiate cross country meets, is scheduled for Sept. 29, 2006, at the University of Notre Dame Golf Course. The Invitational was started by former Irish head coach Alex Wilson in 1956 and regularly features runners from approximately 60 schools around the country. A 5,000-meter women's race was added in 1987 to the current men's event (lengthened from four to five miles in 1968).

## National Catholic Championship

For the 27th consecutive year, Notre Dame will play host to the National Catholic Cross Country Championship — Sept. 15, 2006, at the University of Notre Dame Golf Course. The meet was conceived by current Irish head men's cross country coach Joe Piane and began in the fall of 1980. It features teams from prominent Catholic institutions throughout the United States.

The Notre Dame men are out to claim their 18th team title (and 16th in the past 19 years), while the Irish women's team will seek to claim its 13th title in 15 years.
