The University of Notre Dame Skating Academy Learn to Skate program runs a skating program open to skaters with physical, visual, or hearing disabilities the opportunity to learn how to skate. This program allows the opportunity for participants to increase their physical fitness, socialize with peers, and increase their self-confidence through sports.

All of our Adaptive Skating sessions are on Sundays from 12:30-1:00 pm. Each session runs for 5-weeks. The cost for the 5-week program is \$48. The cost of the program includes a one on one lesson and skate rental. In addition to the class fee, all participants must register as a Learn to Skate USA member.
