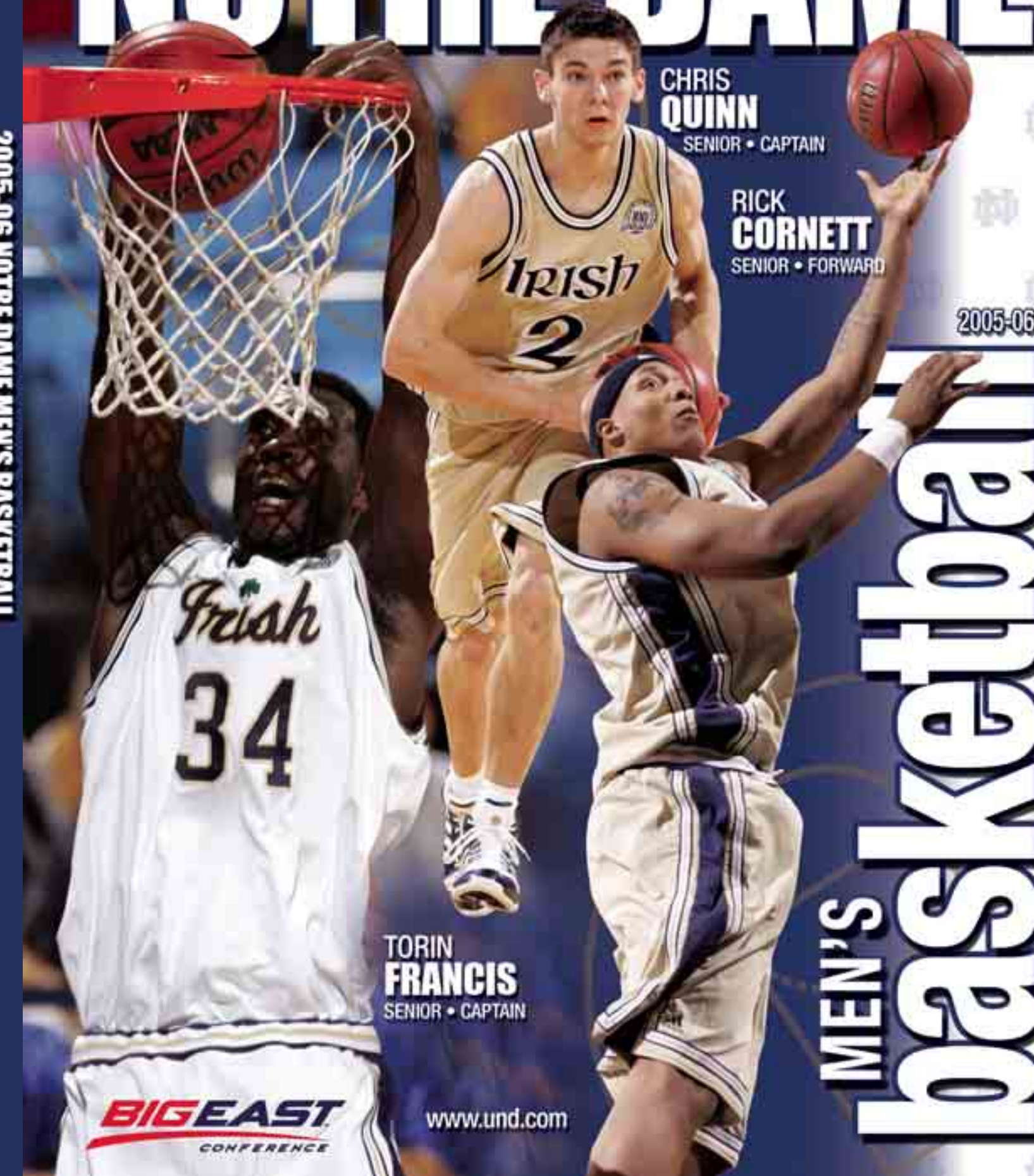

NOTRE DAME basketball

BY THE NUMBERS

- 1,565** Number of victories all-time
- 444** Wins for Notre Dame basketball teams at the Joyce Center since the inaugural season in 1968-69
- 116** Players over the last 43 years who have earned their degrees at Notre Dame (100%) after entering the University on a basketball scholarship and exhausting their eligibility
- 100** Seasons of basketball played at Notre Dame
- 36** Postseason appearances made by Notre Dame teams (27 NCAA Tournaments, nine National Invitation Tournaments) since 1953
- 27** Number of times Irish teams have played in the NCAA Tournament — a total that ranks ninth all-time
- 19** Number of players who have earned consensus All-America honors (second all-time)
- 17** Record number of games televised nationally during the 2004-05 season
- 11** Number of BIG EAST conference games won during 2000-01 campaign, when Notre Dame captured the BIG EAST West Division title en route to its first-ever league regular-season title with an 11-5 record
- 10** Seasons Notre Dame has played as a member of the BIG EAST Conference since its inaugural campaign in 1995-96
- 9** All-time Notre Dame victories against top-ranked teams, second only to UCLA's 10
- 6** Players who have earned Academic All-America honors on 10 occasions
- 4** Overtimes it took Notre Dame to beat Georgetown, 116-111, on February 9, 2002, in the longest game in BIG EAST history
- 3** Former Notre Dame basketball players who have earned roster spots on the United States Olympic basketball team — Vince Boryla (1948), Adrian Dantley (1976) and Bill Hanzlik (1980)
- 1** Notre Dame is the only Division I-A program to rank in the top 25 in all-time winning percentage in both basketball and football
