

NOTRE DAME IRISH RECORDS



Austin Carr, who played for the Irish from 1968-71, still stands atop Notre Dame's career scoring list with 2,650 career points. He still ranks as the most prolific scorer in NCAA basketball tournament history with a 41.3 career scoring average in seven NCAA games. His 34.6 career scoring average ranks first all-time at Notre Dame and second all-time in NCAA history.
