**ND History in Event:** Notre Dame has had three student-athletes qualify for this meet: diver Bob Ebel in 1975, swimmer Tim Kegelman in 2005 and diver Michael Bulfin in 2006. Ebel placed 77th off the three-meter board. Kegelman finished 37th in the 200-yard Fly (1:52.78) and 39th in the 200-yard IM (1:50.39). He was disqualified for an illegal turn in the 100-yard Fly. Bulfin placed 18th in the prelims of the 3-meter competition and 27th in the 1-meter prelims.
