Series Notes: Notre Dame vs. Oklahoma

- ◆ Oklahoma won the only prior game between the schools, downing the Irish, 57-54, on Dec. 30, 1986, in the first round of the *Seattle Times* Husky Classic. The game was played the season before **Muffet McGraw** took over as Notre Dame's head coach.
- ◆ The Irish are 6-9 (.400) all-time against current Big 12 Conference schools, including a 3-2 (.600) record in NCAA Championship play. Notre Dame last played a Big 12 school on Nov, 14, 2004, defeating Nebraska, 73-57 in the second round of the Preseason WNIT at the Joyce Center.
 - ✓ Tuesday will mark the fifth time Notre Dame has played a Big 12 school in the second round of the NCAA Championship, with the Irish going 3-1 in their previous four such outings.
 - ✓ Tuesday also will be the fifth anniversary of Notre Dame's 59-53 win at third-seeded Kansas State in the second round of the 2003 NCAA Championship, which sent the Irish to the fifth of their six Sweet 16 appearances to date.
- ◆ Senior guard **Charel Allen** was a finalist for the 2007 USA Basketball U21 World Championship Team which won the gold medal with an 8-0 record in Moscow, Russia. Oklahoma's **Courtney Paris** was a member of that squad, as was Purdue's **Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton**.
- ◆ Irish head coach **Muffet McGraw** and Oklahoma head coach **Sherri Coale** both currently serve on the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) Board of Directors. Coale is the group's president, while McGraw serves as the body's Division I Legislative Chair.

Other Tidbits About The Irish In The NCAA Championship

- ◆ The Irish are 24-13 (.649) all-time in the NCAA Championship, and with Sunday's victory over SMU, they now have won at least once in 12 of their last 13 appearances (only loss: 78-61 vs. Boston College in 2006 at West Lafayette, Ind.).
- ◆ Notre Dame has participated in every NCAA Championship since they joined the BIG EAST Conference prior to the 1995-96 season.
- ◆ The Irish have made the NCAA Sweet 16 six times in the past 11 seasons, with their most recent visit coming in 2004 (55-49 loss to top-seeded Penn State in Hartford).
- ◆ Notre Dame has reached the NCAA Women's Final Four twice (1997 and 2001), going on to win the national championship in 2001.

Fun Facts About Our Program

- ◆ Notre Dame has had nine All-Americans in program history, with current senior guard **Charel Allen** being the most recent honoree (2007 - WBCA honorable mention).
- ◆ 12 Irish players have earned all-BIG EAST recognition a total of 26 times during the program's 13-year conference membership. Three current players are among that group — senior guard **Charel Allen** (first team in 2007 & 2008), sophomore guard **Ashley Barlow** (honorable mention in 2008) and junior guard **Lindsay Schrader** (honorable mention in 2008).
 - ✓ Allen is the sixth two-time first-team all-BIG EAST selection in school history, joining **Katryna Gaither** (1996-97), **Beth Morgan** (1996-97), **Ruth Riley** (1999-01), **Jacqueline Batteast** (2004-05) and **Megan Duffy** (2005-06).
- ◆ Notre Dame leads the BIG EAST with five players named to the conference's All-Freshman Team in the past two seasons.
 - ✓ Current sophomores **Ashley Barlow**, **Melissa Lechlitrer** and **Erica Williamson** made last year's squad, while current freshmen **Brittany Mallory** and **Devereaux Peters** collected the hardware this season.

Notre Dame Head Coach Muffet McGraw

- ◆ has a record of 473-187 (.717) in her 21st season as Notre Dame's head coach.

- ◆ has a record of 561-228 (.711) in 26 seasons as a collegiate head coach (first five at Lehigh).
- ◆ has guided Notre Dame to all 15 of its NCAA Tournament appearances, including its current string of 13 in a row.
- ◆ ranks among the top 20 on the NCAA's all-time wins and winning percentage lists.
- ◆ named 2001 consensus National Coach of the Year, and has been a finalist for Naismith National Coach of the Year four times.
- ◆ has been named conference Coach of the Year four times in four different conferences (East Coast - 1983; North Star - 1988; Midwestern Collegiate - 1991; BIG EAST - 2001).

Noting Sunday's Win Over SMU

- ◆ Notre Dame's 75 points vs. SMU are the most for the Irish in an NCAA tournament game since March 30, 2001, when they defeated Connecticut, 90-75 at the Final Four in St. Louis.
- ◆ Notre Dame improves to 14-3 (.824) all-time in the NCAA tournament as the higher seed.
- ◆ The Irish had 49 rebounds, their fifth-highest total in an NCAA tournament game and highest since March 17, 2001, when they had a program-best 62 boards in a first-round win over Alcorn State at the Joyce Center.
- ◆ Notre Dame's season-high +23 rebound margin (49-26) also was its highest in NCAA tournament action since that 2001 win over Alcorn State (+28, 62-34).
- ◆ Notre Dame had two players notch double-doubles in the same game for the second time this season (also Feb. 16 at Syracuse — **Charel Allen** with 22 points/12 rebounds and **Erica Williamson** with 14 points/11 rebounds).
- ◆ **Ashley Barlow** and **Charel Allen** are the first Irish players to record a double-double in an NCAA tournament game since March 27, 2004, when **Jacqueline Batteast** tallied 22 points and 12 rebounds in a 55-49 loss to top-seeded Penn State in the East Regional semifinals at Hartford, Conn.
- ◆ Notre Dame had four double-digit scorers in an NCAA tournament game for the first time since March 21, 2004, when it pulled off a similar feat in a 69-65 overtime win over 12th-seeded Southwest Missouri State at the Joyce Center.
- ◆ The Irish had four or more double-figure scorers for the 17th time this season, rising to 16-1 in those games.
- ◆ Notre Dame jumps to 21-1 this season when leading at halftime.
- ◆ The Irish caused at least 20 opponent turnovers for the 20th time this season.
- ◆ Notre Dame wore its alternate home uniforms (white/green) for the second time this season and first since Jan. 5 vs. Tennessee. Since the alternate togs debuted last year, the Irish are 3-2 in them (wins last year vs. Purdue and Louisville; loss vs. Rutgers).
- ◆ **Ashley Barlow** scored 20 points on 7-for-11 shooting and grabbed a career-high 12 rebounds to record her third double-double of the season (and fourth of her career). She also finished with a game-high four steals. In two games in Mackey Arena this season (Barlow also played at Purdue on Dec. 8), she scored 42 points, grabbed 15 rebounds, shot 13-for-13 from the free-throw line, and swiped nine steals.
- ◆ **Charel Allen** finished with 14 points and 11 rebounds to earn her second double-double of the season (and fifth of her career).
- ◆ **Becca Bruszewski** scored a career-high 16 points, three more than her previous best set on Nov. 21 at Central Michigan.

G Charel Allen (Sr.; Monessen, Pa.)

First Team All-BIG EAST

- ◆ Ranks eighth on school's all-time scoring list (1,515 points); first women's basketball player in school history (and third player male or female) to record 1,000 points, 500 rebounds, 200 assists and 200 steals in her career.

G Ashley Barlow (So.; Indianapolis, Ind.)

Honorable Mention All-BIG EAST

- ◆ Family has strong athletic pedigree (cousin Ken played at ND from 1982-86 under Digger Phelps; brother David was guard at IUPUI from 2003-07; great-uncle Robert Jewell in Indiana Basketball Hall of Fame and teammate of Oscar Robertson's brother Bailey on 1951 Crispus Attucks HS team that made Indiana state semis; uncle Ron was fullback at Kansas State (1963-64) and selected by NY Jets in '65 AFL Draft).

G Tulyah Gaines (Sr.; North Las Vegas, Nev.)

- ◆ Enjoys playing the drums in her spare time, and takes lessons once a week from Billy Nicks, a Notre Dame adjunct professor and former drummer for Junior Walker and the All-Stars.
- ◆ Comes from musical family, with mother Pha (*pronounced Fay*) offering a stirring rendition of the National Anthem on Senior Day (March 1) at Joyce Center.

G Brittany Mallory (Fr.; Baltimore, Md.)

BIG EAST All-Freshman Team

- ◆ Nicknamed "Chip" after humorous encounter with chipmunk shortly after arriving on Notre Dame campus last summer.
- ◆ Also was two-time honorable mention All-America lacrosse midfielder at McDonogh School (Owings Mills, Md.).

G Lindsay Schrader (Jr.; Bartlett, Ill.)

Honorable Mention All-BIG EAST

- ◆ 2005 Illinois Miss Basketball and McDonald's All-American; former AAU teammate of Tennessee's Candace Parker.
- ◆ Scored career-high 29 points against Boston College in NCAA tournament debut (2006) at Purdue's Mackey Arena.

C Erica Williamson (So.; Charlotte, N.C.)

- ◆ Born in Manila, Philippines; family lived overseas until she was 7 (father worked in Eastman Kodak's international division).
- ◆ Won state title as junior at Honeoye Falls-Lima HS in Rochester, N.Y., then repeated feat as senior at Charlotte's South Mecklenburg HS (family moved after father took job with Bank of America).
