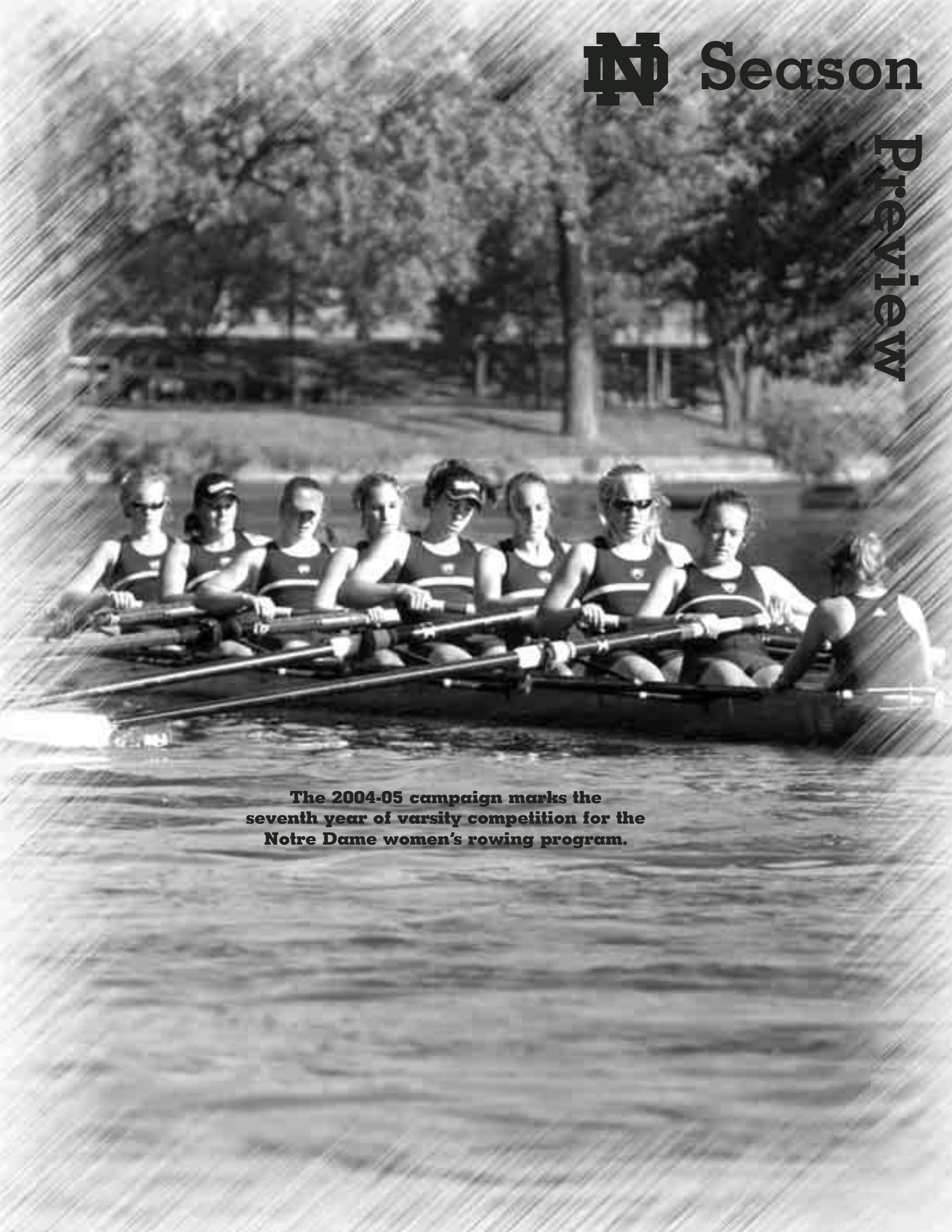

The 2004-05 campaign marks the seventh year of varsity competition for the Notre Dame women's rowing program.

New Challenges and Goals Await Notre Dame In 2004-05 Following Program's Most Successful Campaign

Coming off the most successful season in the program's six-year history, Notre Dame will look to build on the momentum it gained from the success it experienced a year ago.

In 2003-04, the Irish captured their first-ever BIG EAST Rowing Challenge title while its varsity eight boat earned an 11th-place finish at the NCAA Championships after earning an at-large berth for the second time in school history.

Over the course of six seasons of varsity competition, consistency has been the trademark of the Notre Dame program under eighth-year head coach Martin Stone. Each of the last four years, the Irish have earned a national ranking at the end of the season and gained the respect of the collegiate rowing community.

Stone points to the success of the past four years as a key to the growth of the Irish program.

"We have made great strides over the past four years," Stone says. "We've gone from not being ranked to being in the poll on an annual basis. I believe that we have made gains on the schools that got started before us. Every year we've gotten better and performed at a higher level."

One of the challenges for Notre Dame this season will be replacing three key members from last year's varsity eight boat —first team All-American Natalie Ladine, Alice Bartek, a second-team all-Central Region honoree and Danielle Protasewich. Their experience and leadership a year ago were instrumental in driving the Irish to their second-ever appearance in the NCAAAs. Early on in the season, the Irish coaching staff may experiment with a couple of different varsity eight lineups.

"We lost some very good people out of that boat last season," Stone says. "They were vocal leaders. There certainly will be competition for

positions in all of our boats this year and it's going to be wide open as to who will be in the lineup. It's my philosophy that competition matters if we are going to be compete."

The Irish will once again be challenged by one of the nation's toughest schedule that will hopefully lead to a first-ever berth as a team in the 12-team NCAA Championship field. Over the past three seasons, Notre Dame has faced top-20 competition on a weekly basis. This season, Stone's team will face some of the top teams in the country — Tennessee, Michigan State, Michigan, Harvard and Yale. Notre Dame will

host Cincinnati in mid-April and also will row against Indiana and Purdue.

Notre Dame is slated to once again travel to San Diego, Calif., for the San Diego Crew Classic. The Irish will look to defend their title at the BIG EAST Rowing Challenge in last April. The South/Central Regional Championships in Oak Ridge, Tenn., will once again be the team's most important competition of the season with an NCAA bid on the line. The NCAA Championships return to Sacramento, Calif., in 2005.

"I think that there are four races on our schedule that are going to be very key for us — the San Diego Crew Classic, the regatta against Harvard and Yale, the BIG EAST Championships and the Central Regional," Stone says. "The schedule we have gone up against the past couple of years, has certainly made us better and helped us become faster and more competitive. I believe that the teams we will go up against this year will help us become better from week-to-week."

Senior captain Maureen Gibbons will be the coxswain for the Irish varsity eight again this season. Also returning from that crew that rowed in the NCAAs a year ago, are junior Megan Boyle, seniors Katie Chenoweth and Rachel Polinski and junior Melissa Felker. Boyle could be doubtful for the spring after undergoing knee surgery in December.

Throughout all of last season, Notre Dame received steady performances from its second varsity eight and varsity four boats with both earning gold medals at the BIG EAST Rowing Challenge. These crews will once again be important to the team's success, especially as the Irish vie for a berth in the team competition.

In addition to Gibbons, senior Meredith Thornburgh will serve as a co-captain. She is an experienced rower who was a member of the Notre Dame's second varsity four crew a year ago. She is expected to be part of the second varsity eight boat this season.

The Irish senior class will look to make contributions throughout the season. Caitlin Rackish will lend her experience as the coxswain for the second varsity eight boats, while Tricia Hale, Shannon Mohan and Kati Sedun are likely to race with the fours. With the experience of these three, along with sophomore coxswain Maria Romano, Notre Dame's varsity four boat should come up with strong results every time it is on the water.

"It's important for us to get leadership from our senior and junior classes," Stone says. "They've invested a lot in this program and continue to strive to help us reach our team goal of qualifying as a team for the NCAA championships."

Notre Dame will get contributions from many members of its junior class. Andrea Doud was a key member of the Irish varsity four boat a year

ago. After gaining valuable experience last season, the coaching staff will count on her to continue her development as she moves into the varsity eight. Pamela Jefson joined Doud in the varsity four boat a year ago and is expected to be among the top rowers in either the first or second varsity four crews.

Danielle Steady also returns after making significant contributions a year ago as a member of Notre Dame's successful second varsity eight boat.

Sarah Palandech, a three-year member of the team is expected to be among those challenging for a position in the varsity eight. Although she has not rowed each of the last two springs, Palandech emerged as one of the team's strongest rowers coming out of fall competition and during winter preseason training.

When you look at the roster, the Notre Dame's sophomore class stands out because of its depth and the contributions it made as a whole last year with several individuals having key roles at both the varsity and novice levels. In most cases, all those that contributed a year ago will figure prominently in the lineup this season after gaining considerable experience a year ago.

Youth will be on the side of the Irish with the returning experience of this year's sophomore class.

Jessica Guzik had an excellent rookie outing as she rowed with the second varsity eight. With the experience she gained a year ago, look for her to move up into the varsity eight this season.

Several members of Notre Dame's novice eight in the spring of '04 are expected to be among the top rowers in 2005. Shannon Cassel enjoyed a strong freshman year rowing with the novice eight last season, as did coxswain Maria Romano, Sarah Kate Hafner, Ariel Klingaman, Alyssa Close, Danielle Potts and Sarah Shaw. Ashley St. Pierre rowed primarily with the second varsity eight and varsity four crews.

Stone and his coaching staff enjoyed a stellar recruiting season as seven rowers with considerable prep experience have been added to the Irish roster. Many consider it to be one of the top classes in the country and certainly the best in Stone's tenure at Notre Dame.

Highlighting the class is Amanda Polk, a member of the United States Rowing Junior National Team that competed in August of '04 FISA Senior and Junior World Rowing Championships in Banyoles, Spain. Polk rowed the junior women's eight that earned a seventh-place finish overall in the event. The other members of the recruiting class include: Brittany Burnham, Casey Fairbanks, Anika Jedry, Allison Marsh, Lindsay McQuaid and Mary Quinn.

Many of the newcomers are expected to make significant contributions and could find themselves rowing with the top crews.

"Our freshmen bring considerable racing experience into this season," Stone says. "From a standpoint of experience, we have some freshmen who have raced in more races than some of our seniors. While we are young, I like the enthusiasm of our team. Since the start of practice everyone has been willing to work hard."

Stone and his coaching staff will once again point to the Central Region Championships in May as an event that determines the team's ultimate goal of earning a berth in the NCAA Championships. Notre Dame also will be vying for its second straight BIG EAST crown.

"Our focus from day one has been to earn a team berth in the NCAAs," Stone says. "We've once again put together a schedule in which we face the top crews in the country on a weekly basis. The Central region is once again very competitive and strong and how we do at the championships will determine where we are at the end of the season."

"It's going to be challenging for us with a young team, but also fun and very exciting."

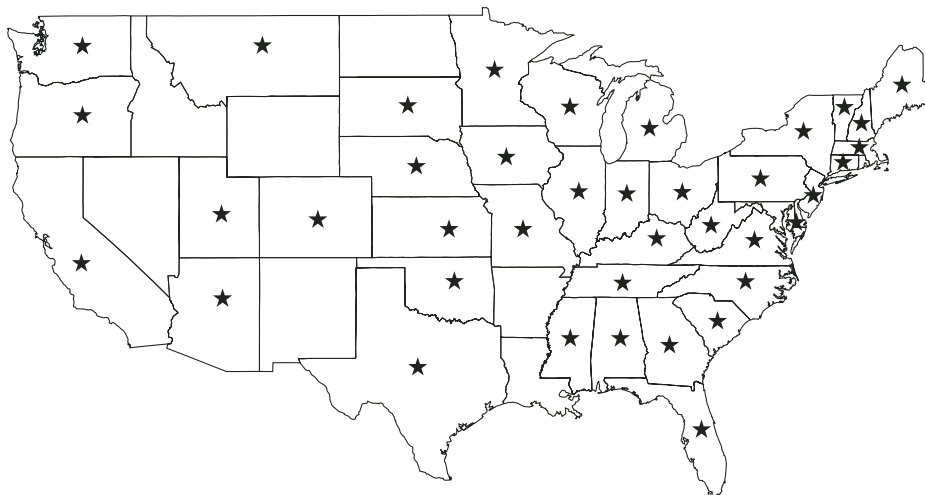
