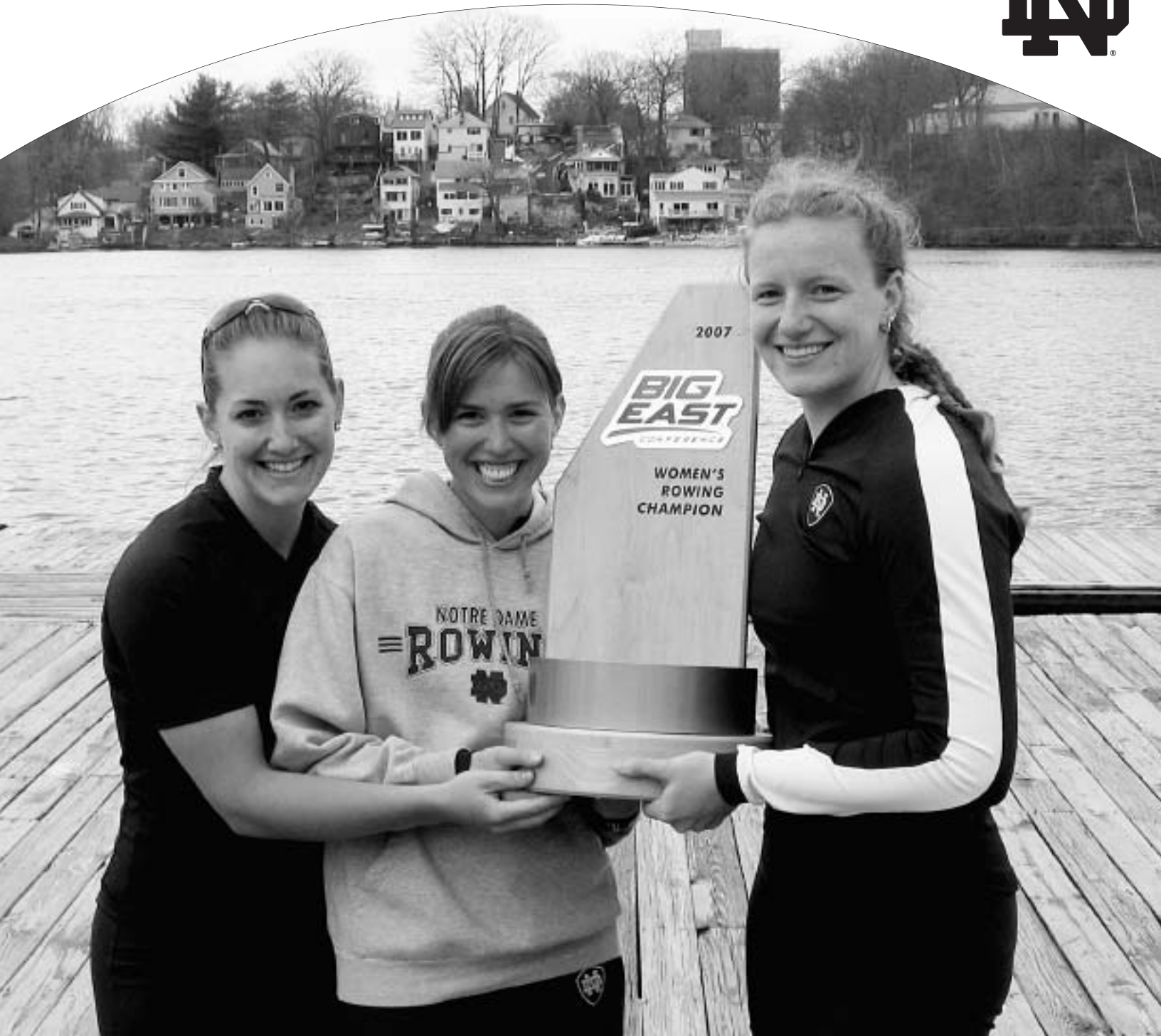


# NOTRE DAME **SEASON IN REVIEW**
