

# NOTRE DAME SEASON IN REVIEW



*Catrina Thompson shared the team-lead with 29 singles' victories and teamed with her twin sister, Christian, to go 22-7. The Thompsons were named All-Americans by the Intercollegiate Tennis Association (ITA) for the second straight season. The duo finished the season 10th in the final ITA national doubles rankings after ascending to #1 earlier in the spring.*
